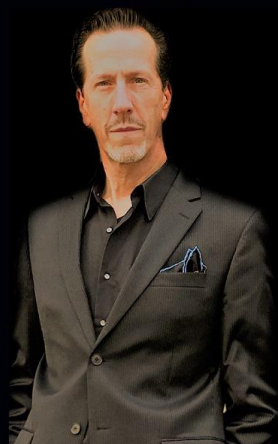

To reproduce the Chicago sound.....

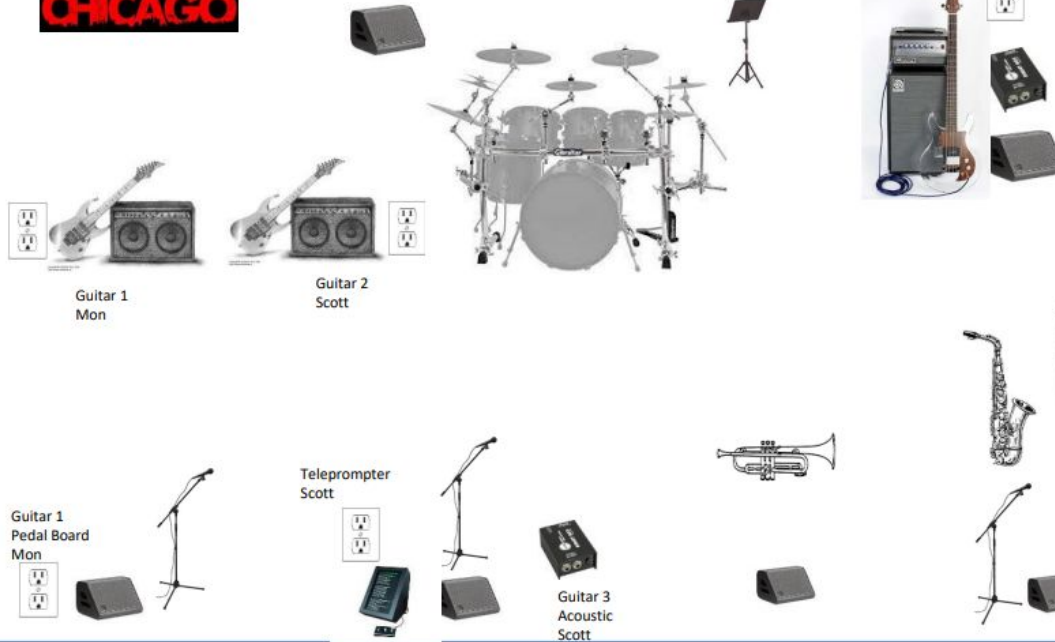
Horns and vocals are on top, then the rhythm section.

Kick should be snappy.

Keyboards are as prominent as rhythm guitars.

Trombone – Wireless > XLR

Sax – Wireless > XLR

Trumpet – Wireless > XLR

1 drummer

Guitar Amp#1 = Mesa Boogie Roadster 2 x 12 OR Fender Hot Rod Deville 212 III. At least 2 channels (dirty/clean).

Guitar Amp#2 = Fender Deluxe Reverb Amp

Keyboard Amp = Roland KC-600

Bass Amp = Markbass Tube 800 head and Markbass 4x10

Drums = 3 rack toms

**MIC'S (14)**

5 vocals

2 guitar amps

7 drum kit

**Mic STANDS (9)**

5 boom vox

2 short goose for 2 guitar amps

1 Kick drum

1 Overhead drums

**MUSIC STAND (1)** Manhasset style for the drummer

**DI's (4)**

1 for bass amp

1 for acoustic guitar

2 for single keyboard in stereo (or 1 stereo DI)
