Horns and vocals on top, then rhythm section. Kick should be snappy. Drums should NOT be boomy and loud like a heavy rock band. Bass is dominant.

Guitar and Keys fill in, but are not the bulk of the sound. The rhythm section supports the horns and vocals.











INSTRUMENTS Drums – Kick, Snare, 2 toms, 1 floor tom, Overhead Bass – Amp > DI Keyboard – stereo mixer > 2XLR Guitar1 – Mic Guitar2 – Mic Guitar3 = Acoustic guitar > DI

Trombone – Wireless > XLR Sax – Wireless > XLR Trumpet – Wireless > XLR
