Elected in November 2022, Sally Lieber represents the California State Board of Equalization's Second District. At her inaugural meeting in January 2023, Lieber was unanimously elected Vice Chair. Lieber represents 10 million constituents from as far north as Del Norte County to as far south as Ventura County. District 2 is home to the California redwoods, the wine industry in Napa County, the innovation capital of the world in the Bay Area, Silicon Valley, and the beautiful and breathtaking Pacific Coast.

Prior to her election to the Board of Equalization, Lieber served in both local and state offices, representing Silicon Valley. She served as a Councilmember and Mayor in Mountain View. Lieber was then elected to the California State Assembly, where she became only the third woman to hold the office of Speaker pro Tempore. Lieber was known throughout the State Capitol as someone who had the courage to take on tough progressive issues.

Among her signature issues in the State Assembly was a landmark increase in the State's minimum wage, a precedent setting bill to ban human trafficking and wage theft, and an increase in the scope of California's Assault Weapons Ban. She has continued this activism as a community leader.
