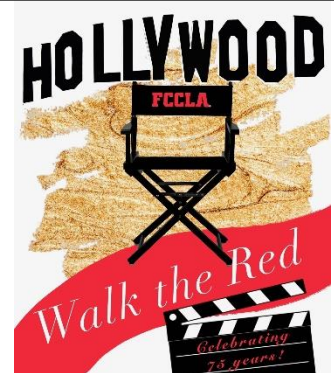


National FCCLA Theme for the 2021 NLC
