

Power Out Cooking

Ways to cook without electricity

	Dutch Oven	Description: A cast-iron pot with a lid, allows for baking, boiling, and slow cooking over an open flame or charcoal. Advantages: Durable, versatile, and excellent for cooking stews, bread, and roasts.
	Portable Gas Stove	Description: A small, single- or double-burner stove powered by butane or propane canisters. Advantages: Easy to use, compact, and provides instant heat for quick meals.
	Charcoal Stove	Description: A simple stove using charcoal briquettes for consistent, long-lasting heat. Advantages: Great for grilling and boiling water, with widely available fuel sources.
	Liquid Fuel Stove	Description: A compact stove that runs on liquid fuels such as white gas or kerosene. Advantages: Works in extreme conditions and provides a reliable, adjustable flame.
	Thermos Cooking	Description: A method where boiling water and ingredients are sealed in an insulated thermos to slow-cook over time. Advantages: Requires minimal fuel, retains nutrients, and is ideal for soups, grains, and beans.
	Propane BBQ	Description: A backyard grill powered by propane, allowing for grilling, baking, and even indirect heat cooking. Advantages: Easy to control heat, widely available propane, and large cooking surface.
	Wood Burning Stove	Description: A traditional stove that uses wood as fuel, providing consistent heat for cooking and heating. Advantages: Dual-purpose for cooking and home heating, works with a variety of wood types.
	Fireplace	Description: A built-in or standalone fireplace that can be used for open-flame cooking or heating food. Advantages: Provides warmth and a cooking source, ideal for roasting or boiling with the right cookware.
	Camping stove	These come in many sizes and brands with fuel type that vary as well. From butane, propane, charcoal,
	Open fire pit	This would require to keep some firewood around and have a stand or tripod to hang or set pots on
	Rocket Stove	These are relatively inexpensive on amazon starting around \$40 would also require some smaller firewood stored for when the power is out
