 By reckoning my body dead to sin and alive to God (Romans 6:11).
 Complete later in the life to come (1 Corinthians 15:42-44, Philippians 3:21, 1 John 3:2).
 The promised resurrection. (Rom 8:22-24, 1 Cor 15:51-52, Phil 3:20-21, 1 Thess 4:15-18, Titus 2:13).
