

## Ultimate Golf Experience Jr. & College Prep Golf Tour 2022 High School Golf Invitational Student-Athlete College Scholarship Min. Criteria

The Ultimate Golf Experience Jr. & College Prep Golf Tour (UGE) will award a college scholarship to one Boy and one Girl graduating high school senior (Grad Class 2023) that <u>participates</u> in the 2022 UGE High School Golf Invitational September 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and meets the following student-athlete scholarship criteria. We invite all eligible applicants to apply, based upon the minimum eligibility requirements listed below. The application deadline is <u>September 18. 2022 @ 5:00 pm</u>. ## MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY REQIREMENTS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. You must be a graduating senior (Class of 2023) from a high school located in Florida and a golf participant in the UGE HS Golf Invitational on September 23<sup>rd</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup>, 2022.
- 2. You must apply for admission to, and attend, a college / university for the fall semester 2023.
- 3. The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 (unweighted), or 3.5 weighted cumulative grade point average in high school and a minimum SAT score of 1100.
- 4. The applicant must maintain a minimum 2.5 grade point average at college / university during the Fall 2023 Semester. You will be required to submit to the Ultimate Golf Experience, at the end of your college fall semester, a copy of your college transcript showing the courses taken, grades, and grade point average. Students must maintain full time college status.
- 5. The selection criteria for awarding the scholarship will be based upon academic achievement, financial need, extra-curricular activities participated in during your high school years, and the applicant's one-page essay.
- 6. The applicant or their guidance counselor must submit a complete UGE Student-Athlete College Scholarship Application with a school transcript on or before September 18, 2022 at 5:00 pm by one (1) of the following methods: 1) via U.S. mail to the Ultimate Golf Experience, 730 Old Quarry Rd, Bradenton, FL 34212, 2) via email attachment <a href="mailto:btveith@UltimateGolfExp.net">btveith@UltimateGolfExp.net</a>. UGE is not responsible for mail or email that is sent by the applicant but not delivered to UGE by the deadline. You may follow-up via text to confirm receipt.
- 7. If requested, the applicant must make themselves available for a brief remote teleconference or in-person interview with the Ultimate Golf Experience Scholarship Committee.
- 8. The scholarship committee plans to award a \$500 scholarship to the most qualified high school boy and girl golfer applicant that meets the minimum criteria as described in this document. The \$500 scholarship will be paid directly to the scholarship recipients' college to be applied towards their tuition, room, and/or board after recipients' fall semester 2023 and upon submission of the information identified in the minimum criteria above.
