The HBCU4Life #CAP Book Scholarship is sponsored by the ladies of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® Tau Nu Omega Chapter of South Bronx, New York. The book scholarship is a onetime payment designed to provide \$250.00 to offset the cost of college expenses related to academics. Book Scholarship recipients will be able to purchase required books for the classes they are enrolled in for the fall of 2022. The scholarship is awarded to two high school seniors accepted to a four year college or university.

To qualify for the HBCU4Life #CAP Book Scholarship, applicants must show proof of the following:

- Resident of the South Bronx, New York
- Of African descent (i.e. African-American, Caribbean, Caribbean-American, Latino, etc.)
- Minimum GPA of 2.50
- Attending an accredited College or University fall of 2022 (Acceptance Letter)

Applications will be evaluated based on the following criteria:

- Academic Performance, Minimum GPA 2.50
- Extra-curricular activities and/or work experience
- Community Service

The selection of applicants will be based on the following:

• Submission of completed application with statement of how student will benefit from being awarded a onetime \$250 book scholarship.

Applications will be reviewed by the HBCU4Life #CAP Committee who will determine the Book Scholarship recipients.
