Bring a water bottle with your name on it

Dancer checklist:

- No makeup needed
- Wear a regular leotard (not nude)
- Hair in a tight bun
- Wear tights (NOT the show tights)
- Have all needed dance shoes with you
- NO earrings or jewelry
- NO fingernail polish

Security

DROP OFF: All dancers should check in the Gymnasium entrance upon arrival.

PICK UP:

No dancers will be released at the black curtain after the show. Please go outside to the gym doors to be reunited with your dancer.

Thursday, 12/5

Full Cast Dress Rehearsal at Lancaster Mennonite School

3:30 p.m. Arrival time for ALL dancers

Parents who signed up to help backstage should plan to attend this rehearsal if possible.

Please eat dinner before arriving *Bring a water bottle with your name on it*

Enter through the GYMNASIUM doors. Do NOT enter from the theater doors.

Dancer checklist:

- **Bring your laundry basket**
- No Makeup THURSDAY NIGHT!
- HAIR = SHOW READY!
- **Wear a nude leotard**/wear tights (NOT the show tights)
- Have all needed dance shoes with you
- NO earrings or jewelry
- NO fingernail polish

9 pm Approx. pick-up time

Please meet your dancer at the gym doors, NOT the theater doors.

Prior to leaving LMH, please make sure your dancer has ALL personal belongings.

A Note About Make-Up

Please make sure your dancer applies ALL make-up BEFORE arriving at LMH on show days.

Please do not send lots of make-up with younger dancers - necessities only!

When little dancers have too many supplies, they tend to play with the makeup and accidentally damage costumes/miss their call to be onstage!



Other Helpful Hints

All items should have the dancer's name clearly marked - ON EVERYTHING!

Dancers should bring a beach towel or small blanket to sit on while waiting in the dressing room.

Have your dancer bring all of their belongings in a Laundry Basket.

Possible items for basket:

- Make-up remover pads
- hairspray/gel
- deodorant
- hairpins, brush
- Slippers or slip-on shoes
- sweatpants, sweater, t-shirt
- books, card games
- water bottle
- snacks (string cheese, pretzels, crackers, raw veggies, nothing greasy or messy, no juice or chocolate)

Do NOT bring:

- markers/paints, games or crafts with lots of pieces, or toys that make noise or have small parts.
- Valuables

We are not responsible for lost, stolen, or broken items.

Even if you feel like your dancer doesn't have enough stuff to warrant a basket, please send one! It serves as their personal "cubby" so their belongings don't get mixed up with others.

Costume Care

Please talk to your dancer about caring for their costumes and accessories. We have amazing backstage volunteers that will certainly help dancers as they make costume changes. Remind them to help put costumes back on hangers and accessories such as hats and hairpieces back into the correct bin.

This is helpful on many levels - costumes stay in good condition and it limits items getting misplaced.

Cover-Ups



It is essential for dancers to wear a nude leotard and tights at all times. Dancers also need some sort of "cover-up" to wear between shows: a robe, zip hoodie, and sweatpants. They will NOT be permitted to walk around in costumes or basic ballet gear between shows.

We are so excited to share such a special time with your dancers. They have put in a lot of time and energy, and so have you!
