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Biblical Keys to receiving every blessing God has for you.

Introduction

If you are like most people, you've noticed hundreds of books, teachings and videos claiming to have "the answer". So why listen to me? Maybe because I've been miraculously healed not once, but twice of life-threatening illnesses and God showed me something during those times, that might help you.

Some years ago, I was diagnosed with throat cancer. But without taking any medication, having any procedures or surgeries I was COMPLETELY miraculously healed within days of the diagnosis and I never had another issue with it.

A few years later I was given about 2 weeks to live. I walked out without any medication, procedures or surgeries and I woke up the next morning COMPLETELY and miraculously healed.

Maybe, just maybe, God showed me something in the Bible that allowed me to receive those miraculous healings. Something that most people are missing.

What I am going to share is not just something I read in a book that someone else wrote (and they probably read in someone else's book) or heard on an audio. I believe God gave me understanding of Scriptures that allowed me to be miraculously healed, and I want to share that with you.

Jeremiah 29:11 NIV

- ***"For I know the plans I have for you," declares the Lord, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.***

About me

I was raised and attended the local church at the end of our block until I started high school, at which time I stopped going. But some years later a girl I was dating (that later became my wife) and her family had a profound effect on my life.

Her father was a true man of God, not a superficial Christian. He believed everything the Bible said. The Fruit of the Spirit flowed through Him. He had been personally healed and delivered from multiple situations and the church they attended (the church I was saved at) repeatedly had people miraculously healed of both minor and serious illnesses.

I believed and accepted the promises and blessings of God (including healing) were real and meant for EVERY child of God.

I believed what the Bible said in Psalms 102:2-3

Psalms 102:2-3 NIV

- ²*Praise the Lord, my soul, and forget not all his benefits* ³**WHO FORGIVES ALL YOUR SINS AND HEALS ALL YOUR DISEASES.**

I accepted from the day of my Salvation that God absolutely “forgives ALL my sins” AND “heals ALL my diseases”. I didn’t understand how so many churches would ignore the second half of that verse. I mean it’s in the same verse, the same sentence. How can you accept and believe the first half of the verse and deny the truth of the second half? It’s the same God, isn’t it?

I want to encourage you, this is NOT about my opinion. It is NOT about my personal views. It’s about the promises and blessings the Scriptures state in the Bible. Scriptures that can change your life forever.

Let's get started

What stops God's promises and blessings (including healing) from manifesting in your life?
What gives satan a stronghold to interfere, delay and even block God's promises and blessings from manifesting?

First, it's not just about faith, because the Bible states, all we need is faith the size of a mustard seed. It's also about doubt and unbelief!

Matthew 17:19-20 KJV

- *19 Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out? 20 **And Jesus said unto them, Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you.***

The Bible clearly shows doubt or unbelief will render your faith powerless and ineffective. Doubt or unbelief can stop you (and anyone you're praying for) from receiving any blessings from God.

Do you question whether a little doubt can make such a difference? Read on to see how blunt the Bible is about that.

Following is one of the boldest, bluntest and unfortunately one of the most ignored verses in the Bible. But it should be a wakeup call to all of us.

James 1:6-7

- *6 But when you ask, you must **believe and not DOUBT**, because the one who DOUBTS is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. 7 **That person should not expect to receive ANYTHING from the Lord.***

How much clearer can the Bible get? It literally says "That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord". This explains why MOST Christians are not receiving or seeing their blessings, healings, and God's promises manifest in their lives!!!!!!

There are 2 kinds of doubt

The First type of doubt:

You can have doubt if all the scriptures are absolutely 100% true. There could be doubt if the men who wrote the books of the Bible are just giving their personal views or opinions on things, and that could cause doubt if all the Scriptures are really true.

The Bible states the words written in the Bible were the Inspired words of God who gave them to the men He selected.

2 Timothy 3:16 KJV

- ***All scripture is given by inspiration of God...***

The Bible states in 2 Peter that God spoke the words to the authors and prophets to be written in the Scriptures through the Holy Spirit as the Spirit inspired them.

2 Peter 1:20-21 NIV

- ***²⁰ Above all, you must understand that **no prophecy of Scripture came about by the prophet's own interpretation of things.** ²¹ For prophecy never had its origin in the human will, but prophets, though human, **spoke from God as they were carried along by the Holy Spirit*****

The second type of doubt:

You can have doubt if God's promises and blessings absolutely and positively apply to you. Do you truly without a doubt expect everyone of God's promises and blessings to manifest in your life? Understand, doubt and unbelief will render your faith powerless and ineffective. The GOOD news is You already have the resources, authority and power to put all feelings of doubt out of your mind and heart. We will cover Scriptures to address this over the next few pages.

Do you have doubts? Most Christian's first reaction is an absolute NO. But do you?

Do YOU absolutely, positively believe you (or the person you're praying for) WILL receive God's promises, healing, blessing, etc or are you not sure at times? Saying or even thinking "I hope", is not "faith", it is DOUBT. So PLEASE, ask God to reveal any areas in your heart or mind where you might have "some" doubt.

Most Christians believe it is impossible to live a life without any doubt. That's true "in the flesh", in their own strengths and abilities. That explains why most people have doubt, they are relying on their own abilities to overcome it. You must walk by the Spirit and be empowered by allowing His Fruit to manifest in you and through you.

How do we eliminate doubt?

The Bible is clear on the benefits of walking by the Spirit. But you have to be truly walking by the Holy Spirit and not just going through the motions. It is then and only then that you will have the ability of enforcing the authority and power of the Holy Spirit living in you.

If we are not truly walking by the Holy Spirit, then you are outside the protective umbrella of God. You have stepped out, wandered off on your own, you are then relying on your own physical, emotional, and mental strengths to fight satan and resist the temptation to sin. Do you realize that's something Jesus didn't even attempt to do in the flesh. It was only AFTER being baptized and receiving the power and authority of the Holy Spirit that He was led into the wilderness to be tempted by satan.

Matthew 3:16-17 and Matthew 4:1 NIV

These are the last verses of chapter 3 and the first verse in chapter 4. They are connected verses

- **16** *As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on him. 17* *And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased."* **Matthew 4:1** ***Then Jesus was led by the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted by the devil.***

What does it mean to walk by the Holy Spirit?

It means you must have a relationship with the Holy Spirit that will guide your steps and thoughts without having to even think about it. It's having a relationship that allows the Holy Spirit to manifest His authority, power and Fruit in you and through you. But most Christians have been wrongly convinced they are controlled by a sin nature. That belief has put up an invisible wall, a stronghold of guilt, insecurity, anxiety, unworthiness, etc in their mind that most Christians have not been able to break through or remove. Even after accepting Jesus and accepting God's Grace for the forgiveness of their sins, that feeling of unworthiness still exist in most Christians minds. It is by far one of the most powerful

strongholds satan has on people. If there is any amount of guilt, shame, insecurity or feeling of unworthiness, it will make it very difficult and probably impossible to truly accept the truth that you are worthy of receiving everyone of God's promises and blessings. Please also examine any overconfidence you might have. Overconfidence is very often a compensation for insecurity about something.

Following are some examples of Scriptures that are often misunderstood and create strongholds of doubt or unbelief in a person that could make a person wonder if they are really worthy to receive God's promises and blessings.

Romans 3:23 NIV

- **23** *for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,*

That verse is often taken out of context. It's to explain both Jews and Gentiles have sinned and have all fallen short of the glory of God and we all need the righteousness of God (which is His Holy Spirit to rescue and free us from the sin nature of the flesh). Let's look at the verses right before it and after it and see how it changes things.

Romans 3:20, 22-24 NIV

- ²⁰ *Therefore no one will be declared righteous in God's sight by the works of the law....*
- ²² *This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe. **There is no difference between Jew and Gentile,** ²³ **for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God,** ²⁴ **and all are justified freely by his grace through the redemption that came by Christ Jesus.***

1 John chapter 3 bluntly tells us we are **EXPTECTED** to stop sinning when we receive the Holy Spirit living in us. Verse 6 bluntly says "NO ONE who lives in Him keeps on sinning."

1 John 3:6-10 NIV

- ⁶ **No one who lives in him (God) keeps on sinning.** *No one who continues to sin has either seen him or known him. ⁷Dear children, do not let anyone lead you astray. The one who does what is right is righteous, just as he is righteous. ⁸The one who does what is sinful is of the devil, because the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the devil's work. ⁹**No one who is born of God will continue to sin, because God's seed remains in them;** they cannot go on sinning, because they have been born of God. ¹⁰**This is how we know who the children of God are and who the children of the devil are:** Anyone who*

does not do what is right is not God's child, nor is anyone who does not love their brother and sister.

Following is another example of verses being taught that make Christians believe they are controlled and subjected to a living a life of a sin nature. That can definitely instill wrong thoughts of guilt, insecurity and a feeling of unworthiness in receiving God's promises and blessings.

In Romans chapter 7 Paul is clearly describing the essence of the flesh having a sin nature. A nature that you cannot defeat "on your own".

Romans 7:15-18 NIV

- *¹⁵ I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. ¹⁶ And if I do what I do not want to do, I agree that the law is good. ¹⁷ As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. ¹⁸ For I know that good itself does not dwell in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out*

If we look at what Paul said just a few verses prior to that, it paints a clearer picture of how we have been released from living a life of sin through the Holy Spirit.

Romans 7:5 NIV

- *⁵ For when we were in the realm of the flesh, the sinful passions aroused by the law were at work in us, so that we bore fruit for death. ⁶ But **now, by dying to what once bound us, we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit, and not in the old way of the written code.***

As true Christians we are set free from the chains and bondage of sin, guilt and condemnation and empowered by the Holy Spirit.

Additional verses from Romans chapter 8 boldly tells us there is NO condemnation or guilt who walk with the Spirit.

Romans 8:1-5 KJV

- *¹ There is therefore now **no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.** ² For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus **hath made me free** from the law of sin and death. ³ For what the law could not do, **in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:** ⁴ in order*

*that the righteous requirement of the law might be fully met in us, **who do not live according to the flesh but according to the Spirit.** ⁵ Those who live according to the flesh have their minds set on what the flesh desires; **but those who live in accordance with the Spirit have their minds set on what the Spirit desires.***

Romans 6 various scriptures tell us the old self with the sinful nature is dead and if we allow the Holy Spirit to lead us we will no longer allow the sin nature to control our lives.
NIV

- *6 For we know that **our old self was crucified with him** (when we accepted Jesus) so that **the body ruled by sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves to sin.** **7 because anyone who has died (to sin) has been set free from sin.***
- *11 In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin but alive to God in Christ Jesus.*
- *14 For sin shall no longer be your master....*
- *18 You have been set free from sin....*

We need to sincerely repent for our past sins and fully accept God's grace of His unconditional forgiveness when we accept Jesus as our Savior. If you don't think you were truly sincere when you repented and it was more of an oops sorry God, my bad, then do it right now. Repent for all sins you can think of and accept God's Grace and set yourself free, once and for all.

Can walking by the Spirit really empower you to resist sin?

Galatians 5 shows the benefits of truly walking by the Spirit. The power of the Holy Spirit manifesting His supernatural Fruit in us and through us and the freedom from being controlled by a sin nature, we are no longer controlled by a "sin nature".

Galatians 5:16-26 NIV

- ***16 So I say, walk by the Spirit (have a relationship with God where it becomes your way of life) and you will NOT gratify the desires of the flesh.** **17** For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want. **18** But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. **19** The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; **20** idolatry and witchcraft;*

*hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, (unforgiveness), dissensions [disagreements], factions [that promote heresies – beliefs that go against the Bible], **21** and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. **22** But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, **23** gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law (walking by the Spirit covers the law). **24** Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its **passions and desires.** **25** Since we live by the Spirit, let us keep in step with the Spirit.*

Does having the Holy Spirit living in you really change you spiritually (if you allow Him)?

2 Corinthians 5:17 NIV

- *Therefore if any man be in Christ, **he is a new creature: old things are passed away; behold, all things are become new.***

When you become saved you are a NEW creature, a NEW creation in Jesus, a NEW man/woman (not physically, but spiritually). Do you understand what that means? Our physical shape or demeanor doesn't change, our intelligence level doesn't change.

You are changed Spiritually; the Bible calls it a transformation. It's like a caterpillar transforming into a butterfly. You should go through a transformation spiritually when you receive the Holy Spirit. The problem is most Christians don't complete that transformation because they don't understand it, they don't allow it. They continue to live by their own common sense, abilities, skills, and intelligence. They try to be a better person projecting their own form of love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, gentleness and self-control.

The Biblical truth is you become a human being empowered by the Holy Spirit, empowered to resist sin and filled with the Holy Spirit's supernatural Fruit of: love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faith, gentleness and self-control. I want to stress the Bible is NOT talking about your own character or nature, it is talking about the supernatural Fruit of the Spirit. Do not be misled by the teachings that say the Fruit of the Spirit is something you can practice and develop. If you have to practice it, then it's from you using your own abilities and skills and NOT the Holy Spirit (and that is a dangerous road to go down). You can't develop it! It is something that you allow to flow and manifest through you.

You have the power and authority to defeat all doubt and unbelief controlling you.

Remember you are a new creation in Christ. You are FREE of the sin nature and can, should and are expected to live by the Holy Spirit which has authority over and defeats the sin nature. But most Christians don't understand or accept that. So they are left powerless to go through life as satan's punching bag. The chains have been removed. The prison cell door has been open. It is up to you to accept your freedom and start living your new life.

It is imperative you realize the Holy Spirit lives in true believers EVERY second of the day.

2 Corinthians 6:19 NIV

- *¹⁹Do you not know that **your bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, who is in you, whom you have received from God? You are not your own; ²⁰you were bought at a price (through Jesus crucifixion). Therefore honor God with your bodies.***

The Holy Spirit doesn't come and go from one Christian to another as He feels like it. The Bible boldly shows the Holy Spirit lives in EVERY true believer 24 hours a day to empower them, and manifest His Fruit of the Spirit in them and through them. But are you experiencing that? If not isn't it time to start accepting what God has for you?

- How can satan possibly win when you have that power living in you?
- How can satan possibly win when the Holy Spirit gives you the authority to ENFORCE the victory of the cross on any and all attacks by satan?
- How can anyone convince you that you are not worthy of EVERYONE of God's promises, blessings, and miracles (including healing) when His Spirit is living in you?

Do you understand the SAME Spirit that created the Universe and rose Jesus from the dead lives in you!

- *¹¹And **if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, he who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of his Spirit who lives in you.***

Jesus made that promise to all believers filled with the Holy Spirit.

God has given us His Spirit so YOU, me and every born again Believer can continue Jesus ministry on Earth as a minister of his New Covenant.

.2 Corinthians 3:6 NIV

- ***⁶He has made us competent (capable) as ministers (servants) of a new covenant—not of the letter but of the Spirit; for the letter kills, but the Spirit gives life.***

The word minister in that verse does not only mean pastors, evangelists, missionaries, etc, it means being a “servant” of the New Covenant.

You have been empowered beyond what most people can imagine. But you will never see that manifest if you have doubts.

John 14:12-17 NIV

- ***¹²Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father. ¹³And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. ¹⁴You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it. ¹⁵“If you love me, keep my commands. ¹⁶And I will ask the Father, and he will give you another advocate (the Holy Spirit) to help you and be WITH YOU FOREVER — ¹⁷the Spirit of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.***

God has guaranteed you that He will send His Holy Spirit to live in you, me and every other born again Christian to empower us with the authority to resist sin and enforce God’s will on Earth.

The following verses are Jesus last words before ascending into Heaven. Please think about this, He could have said anything, but these words are what He felt were the most important to leave with His Disciples and ALL mankind. They give an example of the power and authority the Holy Spirit will manifest through true born again believers if they understand and allow Him to manifest in them and through them.

Mark 16:15-20 NIV

- ***¹⁵He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. ¹⁶Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. ¹⁷And these signs will accompany those who believe:***

*In my name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; ¹⁸they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well.” ¹⁹After the Lord Jesus had spoken to them, he was taken up into heaven and he sat at the right hand of God. ²⁰Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, **and the Lord worked with them and confirmed his word by the signs that accompanied it.***

The Strongs Concordance says the word “signs” in verse 20 means, supernatural, miracles.

And there is more.....

God has a special calling and Spiritual gifts for each one of us, and that includes YOU!

You must defeat the sinful stronghold of doubt about God’s promises and blessings and about your worthiness as a child of God to receive them. Then the Holy Spirit can manifest your blessings in your life.

Romans 11:29 NIV

- ²⁹ *for God’s gifts and his call are irrevocable.*

The verse boldly states God’s gifts and call are IRREVOCABLE, they are a promise from a God that cannot and will not lie.

Numbers 23:19 NIV

- ¹⁹ ***God is not human, that he should lie, not a human being, that he should change his mind. Does he speak and then not act? Does he promise and not fulfill?***

Now consider your position as a true child of God, an heir with Jesus to everything God has, the competent and qualified minister of God’s New Covenant on Earth, and a temple in which the Holy Spirit of God lives to manifest His supernatural Fruit through.

- Have you accepted as a child of God, as a Spirit filled believer that you are absolutely worthy of every one of God’s promises and blessings?
- Have you accepted that every word of the Bible was written by men that God divinely anointed and imparted the words in their hearts and minds He wanted written?

About my Healings

Now let me explain what I did the evening I received the news of cancer in my throat and only then again some years later when I was diagnosed with having about 2 weeks to live. You will see how much doubt and unbelief played or didn't play a role at that time.

On both occasions when I was facing life threatening illnesses I invited "specific" people over to pray with me and my wife. I want to stress I did NOT invite just anyone. Because I knew most of the Christians I knew, including pastors, ministers, deacons and elders did NOT absolutely believe God wants everyone of His children healed until they reach the promised age of life stated in the Bible. They believed it depended on what God's will was and as humans we could not possibly know God's will (which is not true as stated in Romans 12:2) so they always ended their prayers with "if it be thy will". That's not faith, that is doubt. Remember James 1:6-7 "the one that doubts should NOT expect to receive anything from God". I didn't want anyone with any doubt or unbelief around me at that time.

Some people were upset and even angry they were not invited after they found out I was healed. But this was not a coffee and donut monthly Bible study with some quick prayers fellowship thing. It was potentially life or death, MINE! I wasn't concerned about someone's feelings being hurt at that time.

Both those evenings at my house, there was NO begging God to heal me, there was NO pleading with God to heal me. There was God's children using the authority of the Holy Spirit living in us to take authority over the illness and rebuke it and declare, receive and accept I was healed.

In the Old Testament people were ambassadors for the sick to God pleading and begging God to heal them. But we live in a New Covenant through Jesus crucifixion and resurrection, and we are ministers of that New Covenant. We are now ambassadors for God to the sick. We are to use the power of the Holy Spirit living in us to take authority over the illness. If you look at any healing in the New Testament, there was NEVER a time where the Disciples begged God to heal the person. They took AUTHORITY over the illness, disease or physical infirmity.

We must rebuke and defeat any and all thoughts of doubt and unbelief. Doubt and unbelief will render a person's faith powerless and ineffective.

There are numerous examples of people NOT being healed in the Bible because of their unbelief and even the disciples were NOT able to to heal someone because of their own unbelief.

In Matthew chapter 17, a man brought his son to Jesus because His disciples could NOT heal him, Jesus immediately rebuked and cast out the demon and healed the boy. This next part is INCREDIBLY important. The disciples didn't make excuses and say maybe it wasn't God's will, or maybe God was teaching the boy a lesson, or maybe the parents had sinned, or maybe the boy was being punished. What they did was ask Jesus WHY couldn't they cast the demon out and heal the boy and Jesus said because of their UNBELIEF.

Matthew 17:19-20 KJV

- ¹⁹ Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, Why could not we cast him out?
²⁰ And Jesus said unto them, **BECAUSE OF YOUR UNBELIEF...**

By the way, from the studies I did, I found about 40% of all healings in the Bible mention demons being cast out. I really believe the percentage is much higher than that, but not every healing specifically explains what happened. But even at about 40% the spiritual demonic implications shouldn't be and can't be ignored. PLEASE do not ignore it. This is not a game.

Another example of unbelief was when Jesus was going with Jairus to his house to pray for his sick daughter. One of Jairus servants met them in the town and said his daughter had already died. Jesus said just 5 words "Don't be afraid; just believe". How powerful is that? Have no fear, don't doubt, just believe. When Jesus got there the people were crying and wailing, Jesus told them the girl is only sleeping, and they laughed and mocked Jesus. **Jesus had all those people removed from the house. There was no place for people with unbelief or doubt there** and then Jesus brought the girl back to life.

Mark 5:35-42 NIV

- ³⁵ While Jesus was still speaking, some people came from the house of Jairus, the synagogue leader. "Your daughter is dead," they said. "Why bother the teacher anymore?" ³⁶ Overhearing what they said, Jesus told him, "**Don't be afraid; just believe.**" ³⁷ He did not let anyone follow him except Peter, James and John the brother of James. ³⁸ When they came to the home of the synagogue leader, Jesus saw a commotion, with people crying and wailing loudly. ³⁹ He went in and said to them, "Why all this commotion and wailing? The child is not dead but asleep." ⁴⁰ But they laughed at him. **After he put them all out,** he took the child's father and mother and the disciples who were with him, and went in where the child was. ⁴¹ He took her by the hand and said to her, "Talitha koum!" (which means "Little girl, I say to you, get up!"). ⁴² Immediately the girl stood up and began to walk around (she was twelve years old).

Doubt and unbelief are so strong even Jesus could NOT do many miracles in His own country.

Matthew 13:58 NIV

- ⁵⁸ *And he (Jesus) did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.*

Does that shock you? Do you wonder how is that possible? It's because God gave people FREE WILL to make their own decisions without pressure from God. Do you understand God has never forced anyone to accept Jesus as their Savior He has never forced anyone to accept the Bible as complete truth, and he has never forced anyone to accept His promises, blessings, gifts, calling or healing. If someone refuses to believe God or have doubt, then they have alienated themselves from His promises, blessings and healings.

Do Not forget James 1:6-7 - - ⁶ *But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and tossed by the wind. ⁷ That person should not expect to receive anything from the Lord.*

How do you transform from one who doubts, to one who walks BOLDY by the Holy Spirit?

A lot of Christians believe because God is Sovereign it is impossible for people to know His will. Romans 12:2 boldly states YOU can and you SHOULD know God's will, the perfect will of God, and you will AFTER you have been transformed by the renewing of your mind..

Romans 12:2 NIV

- **2** *And **BE NOT conformed** to this world: but **BE YE transformed** by the renewing of your mind, **that ye may prove (know, discern) what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect will of God.***

That verse is NOT a suggestion, "Be Not conformed" and "Be YE transformed" are commands. We are expected to complete the sanctification process of our transformation.

Ephesians chapter 5 reinforces the fact we should know and understand God's will.

Ephesians 5:17 NIV

- ¹⁷ *Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.*

Jesus crucifixion and resurrection created a New Covenant between God and you. A Covenant filled with miraculous promises and blessings (including healing) and he made you a competent and capable minister/servant of that Covenant.

Start Now

You MUST dwell and internalize the scriptures that assure you of the truths I've outlined. Start reading the verses and dwelling on them. Ask the Holy Spirit to allow them to penetrate your heart and mind.

I've purposely kept this teaching short and to the point, to make it easier and faster to read and comprehend. If time permits you can read it daily until the truths of the Scriptures have defeated any and all doubts you might have in God's promises, and blessings.

I strongly suggest taking the 15 or 20 minutes to read this teaching over and over again daily. It might take days, weeks or months. But, you WILL see your breakthrough and

YOU will walk in the authority and power of the Holy Spirit as promised in Galatians 5: 16-26 and

YOU will EXPECT and ACCEPT God's promises and blessings are meant for YOU, and your family, today, tomorrow and forever.
