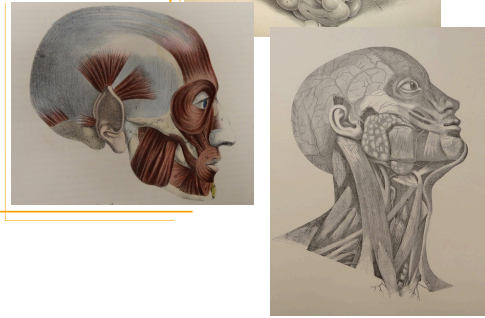
# MUSEUM OF MEDICAL HISTORY

## WHO WE ARE

We are one of the only medical museums in the state open on a regular basis. Sponsored by SSVMS, the oldest Medical Society in California dating back to 1868, it provides free admission, and guided group tours by appointment.

## WHAT WE DO

The museum provides approximately 2,000 square feet of exhibit space and features items such as a working Iron Lung, amputation kits from the Civil War, and the various treatments of the 1800's. In addition, it features exhibits on radiology, Chinese medicine, pharmacy, cardiology, infectious disease, dentistry, nursing, and more.



## WHO IS INVITED

We welcome school classes, 4th grade and above, and especially encourage high schools with classes related to science and medicine. You should allow a minimum of one hour for a class, and we provide docents, all of whom are retired physicians.

## MUSEUM HOURS

Currently open **Tuesday-Friday from 10 am to 4 pm**. Appointments are necessary for school tours as we want to be able to provide docent support. We are handicapped accessible, and onsite and street parking is available. A grant program is available to help defray the cost of bus transportation for schools within Sacramento, El Dorado and Yolo Counties.
