RULES:

- 1 – All entries must be the work of the Exhibitor, and completed since last year's Fair.
- 2 – Each exhibitor may make only one entry in each section.
- 3 – Where possible entries should be ready to hang. (wire, string, fishing line etc.)
- 4 – All identifying marks must be covered.
- 5 – All possible care will be taken of Artwork, but no responsibility can be assumed by the Fenelon Agricultural Society for loss or damage.
- 6 – Exhibits must be delivered to the north door of the main building either on THURSDAY from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm, OR FRIDAY from 8:00 am to 12: Noon. All exhibits must be received no later than 12 Noon on Friday and must remain on display until 4:00 pm Sunday. (Building will close at 3:30 pm Sunday, and will re-open for picking up of exhibits at 4:00 pm)
- 7 – Only original art is accepted. No reproductions.
- 8 – Art pieces may not be larger than 24" x 36"
