### RULES:

- 1 – Exhibit must be live flowers only unless otherwise specified
- 2 – Flowers must be grown and cared for by the exhibitor.
- 3 – Exhibits must be delivered to the north door of the main building either on THURSDAY from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm, OR FRIDAY from 8:00 am to 12: Noon. All exhibits must be received no later than 12 Noon on Friday and must remain on display until 4:00 pm Sunday. (Building will close at 3:30 pm Sunday, and will re-open for picking up of exhibits at 4:00 pm)
- 4 – No Cannabis plants or stems, leaves, flowers, buds or seeds of Cannabis plants will be permitted as specimens or as part of any decorative entry.

| 12 – Sweet Peas – Perennial (5 sprays) – any colour                             | 29 – Potted Geranium – 1 plant in bloom             |
| 13 – Daylily – stem in Bloom  | 30 – Ivy Geranium – 1 plant in bloom - potted       |
| 14 – Marigolds (3 blooms) greater than 2”                                       | 31 – Foliage Plant – not listed – named if possible |
| 15 – Marigolds (5 blooms) 2” or less  | 32 – Unusual House Plant – named if possible        |
| 16 – Petunias – single (3 sprays) any colour                                    | 33 – Fern – any variety                             |
| 17 – Petunias – ruffled (3 sprays) any colour                                   | 34 – My Best Flowering Plant– named if possible     |
