RULES:

- 1 – It is the responsibility of every exhibitor to read ALL rules and regulations and abide.
- 2 – All articles (unless otherwise stated) competing in Class 20 must be the production of the person making the entry. All articles must have been completed since July 2025, unless the article has never been entered in competition at Fenelon Fair in which case the article must have been completed since July 2024. Quilts may show at two consecutive Fenelon Fairs and therefore must have been completed since July 2024.
- 3 – All Exhibits must be in place for judging in the building by 12:00 noon on Friday, Please secure entry tickets with safety pins. NO STRAIGHT PINS.
- 4 - Exhibits must be delivered to the north door of the main building either on THURSDAY from 6:00 pm to 8:00 pm, OR FRIDAY from 8:00 am to 12: Noon. All exhibits must be received no later than 12 Noon on Friday and must remain on display until 4:00 pm Sunday. (Building will close at 3:30 pm Sunday, and will re-open for picking up of exhibits at 4:00 pm)
- 5 – Judges reserve the right to disqualify any article deemed to be NOT THE WORK OF THE EXHIBITOR, SOILED ITEMS, DEFACED OR OLD WORK. No prizes to be given if deemed so by the Judge. Directors are also authorized to not accept any of the above.
- 6 – Judges decisions are final.
- 7 – **SAMPLES OF MATERIALS USED MUST BE INCLUDED *(S.A) WHERE NOTED or the article WILL be disqualified.**
- 8 – All identifying marks must be covered.
- 9 – Please make a copy of your entry form. You will be required to present this copy to retrieve your items.

QUILTS – Hand or Machine

Rules:

- 1 - GRAND CHAMPION & RESERVE GRAND CHAMPION are judged from all first and second prize ELIGIBLE quilts. All quilts will be judged in their respective classes first.
- 2 – All Quilts must have been completed since July 2024 (ie: may show at two consecutive Fenelon Fairs)
- 3 – Entries must be made and hand quilted solely by the exhibitor, unless otherwise specified.
- 4 – **NEW 2026:** Entries must be a **minimum of 280"**, measured on the perimeter, (smaller quilts will not be eligible to proceed to the next level of competition)
- 5 – All Quilts entered must have **material samples attached**.
- 6 – All identifiable marks must be covered.
- 7 – All Quilts continuing on to the next level of competition will be required to be named.
- 8 – If using a commercial pattern, the name of the pattern designer must be included on the tag to satisfy legal copyright issues.

Crib Quilt size is not to exceed 180" perimeter.

Crib Quilt size is not to exceed 180" perimeter.
