John 20.19-22 19 When it was evening on that day, the first day of the week, and the doors of the house where the disciples had met were locked for fear, Jesus came and stood among them and said, "Peace be with you." 20 After he said this, he showed them his hands and his side. Then the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. 21 Jesus said to them again, "Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you." 22 When he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit.

The disciples have locked themselves in a room as they are afraid. They don't know what to think, what to do. They had just witnessed Jesus death, his body is missing and some say he has risen. Together they try to re-group and process what unknown future might bring. But Jesus finds his way into that locked room and greats them with words of peace. Peace be with you!

The word peace in the Bible often means the opposite of how we've come to understand it culturally. Often when we hear the word "peace", we think of the absence of conflict, such as when there are peace talks between warring nations. However, in the Bible when we hear the word peace used, it generally communicates the promise of God's presence with us in the midst of conflict, struggle, fear and doubt.

When Jesus shows up in that locked room with the disciples, he meets them amidst their fears and uncertainties and he greets them with those four simple words: PEACE BE WITH YOU. As we make our way forward together as a community in Christ called to be Christ in community, that is my hope and prayer for you as well. May Christ's peace and presence dwell richly within you. May you know the comfort of Christ's abiding presence today, tomorrow, and in the days to come. May the peace that passes all understanding be with you all!

New Outreach Collection for May During the month of May Holy Spirit will be collecting donations for the Mothers' Home for the first time. This is a residential shelter that provides a safe haven for vulnerable pregnant women in crisis. It was founded in 1991 and is located in Darby in the empty convent of the Blessed Virgin Mary campus. It provides shelter for up to 28 women during their pregnancy and the first six months after their babies are born. The young women participate in free daily classes on life skills, nutrition, parenting, labor and delivery, early infant care, housing, fertility awareness, and budgeting. Women of all races, religions, and ethnicity are welcome. There is also a Sharing Space open to the community where low income families can get clothing and other baby items. The Mothers' Home goal is to provide a safe shelter that encourages a healthy environment for the life of the baby, the life of the mother, and their future life as
