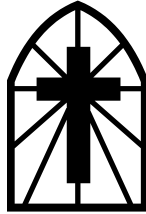

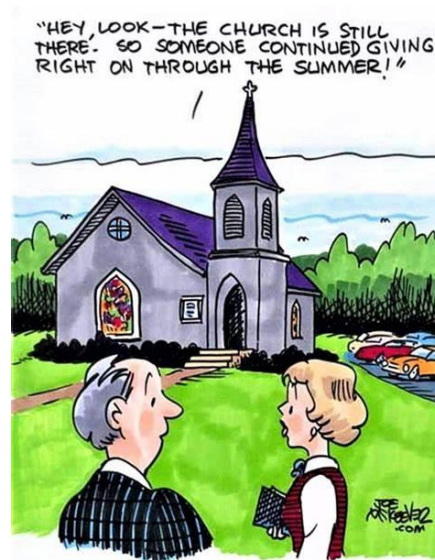

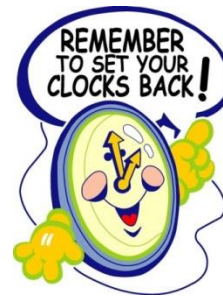

All Saints Day is a day we remember all the saints who have gone on before us. We commemorate those we have lost as well as the Christians who have lived before us and testified to their Christian faith.





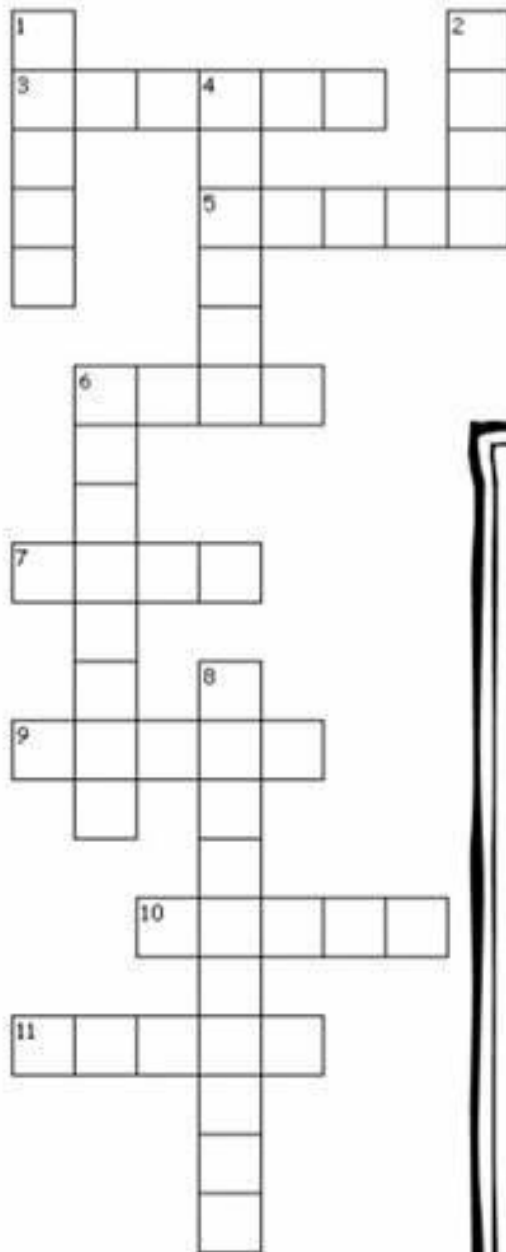
