Low Income Home Energy Program information in California

All funding is offered on a first come, first served basis. However, as indicated, the Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program will focus on senior citizens, the disabled, and families with young children in California first as they are most at risk. After that more “traditional” families may receive cash grants from LIHEAP. Dial 1-866-675-6623 for more information or applications.

Homeowner Assistance Program

This program allows a once-a-year payment from the State of California to eligible individuals.

The maximum amount of assistance that a homeowner in California may receive is \$472.60. You must be 62 years of age or older, disabled, blind, and also meet income thresholds in order to receive aid. 800.338.0505

St. Vincent de Paul

Administers a number of social services and assistance programs for San Diego.

Housing Authority of the County of San Diego - They administer several rental assistance programs, including the section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program. This will in effect ensure that qualified low income individuals and families do not pay more than thirty percent of their income towards housing costs. They also provide state rental and information on public housing programs. Call (858) 694-4801. You must live or work in an unincorporated area of San Diego County, or in Chula Vista, Coronado, Del Mar, El Cajon, Escondido, Imperial Beach, La Mesa, Lemon Grove, Poway, San Marcos, Santee, Solana Beach, or Vista. If you live outside of these areas, there are 5 other Housing Authorities in San Diego County. Contact the one for the city you live in.

St. Vincent de Paul Village, Fr. Joe's Village, San Diego - Dial 619.233.8500. No matter your race, religion, or background, St. Vincent DePaul may be able to provide assistance. Many local churches and parishes are part of this charity organization, and a number of financial assistance and counseling programs are offered. Some money for paying rent and other housing expenses is often distributed to the low income, unemployed and needy in the San Diego California area.

Salvation Army - San Diego. If you are in danger of losing your home or are facing eviction, the San Diego Salvation Army may have limited funds for paying rent. (619) 239-1106

County of San Diego, Health and Human Services Agency

Community Action Partnership (Community Action Partnership of San Diego County). For referrals to programs. call them at (800) 227-0997. They can provide qualified individuals with money for paying rent, prevention an eviction from their apartment, and even vouchers that can be used to pay for a motel or hotel room for a period of time.

Housing and Community Development, County of San Diego, runs the federal government funded Section 8 housing rental assistance program, and it is currently offered to qualified families and individuals. The local version of the San Diego Homeless Prevention and Rapid Re-Housing Program is offered by **North County Lifeline INC.** (Vista, CA (760) 726-4900), City of Oceanside (phone (760) 435-3380), Community Resource Center in Encinitas (dial (760) 753-8300). This low income housing program offers housing and rent assistance for families and individuals. Get assistance with rental expenses and utility bill assistance. Services are currently available for low-income families who are homeless or at risk of becoming homeless. Other components of the resource include rental assistance, credit counseling , housing relocation, and stabilization services including landlord/tenant mediation, security or utility deposits, moving cost assistance, and case management.
