

Manly Greens July Newsletter


Dear,

It's another busy month on Council, with Council progressing several important motions, including resolving to put its first draft of the proposed Conservation Zones for the new LEP on exhibition in September. I'll share a link to that in my September update when it goes live. The exhibition will show the proposed changes to our current environmental zones, the methodology for how the proposed maps were prepared, and give opportunity for feedback.

Other important resolutions included leasing the disused Manly Bowling Club site to Manly Warringah Gymnastics Club, and engaging an architect for the first stages of redesigning the Manly Surf Lifesaving Club.

Council unanimously resolved to support my joint motion with Councillors De Luca, Sprott, Robins, and Bingham to support Sydney WorldPride themed activities on the Northern Beaches! Did you know that the LARGEST festival since the 2000 Olympics will be happening in Sydney in February-March next year! With over 78,000 visitors expected to come to Sydney for LGBTIQIA+ themed events, including all the usual Mardi Gras events, conferences, parties, and other activities.

It's a great opportunity to create pride themed events and activations close to home, and to invite visitors onto the Northern Beaches to see the sights and visit our local businesses.

conserve Northern Beaches Bushland


I spoke at a community meeting about the approval of a Development Delivery Plan which intends to investigate the redevelopment of ~220ha of bushland on the Northern Beaches in suburbs including Belrose and Frenchs Forest.

We launched a community petition to the NSW Legislative Assembly calling for the approval to be reversed, and alternatives to be explored, such as paying the owners to lease or purchase the land for National Park, a land swap, or compensation.

Thanks to Save the Northern Beaches Bushland for getting the ball rolling on the campaign. A town hall event and further activities to educate and mobilise the community are planned.


