I became involved with Interfaith of the Woodlands as soon as we opened Truluck's in Hughes Landing. Our WHY at Truluck's is to "Make Good Things Happen for Other People" and they seemed like a great organization to become involved with upon landing in the community. That relationship quickly blossomed. We hosted VIP Events in our private dining rooms, sponsored galas and fundraisers and donated food to their pantry. There are so many ways to be involved at Interfaith from volunteering at their Veggie Village or Hand Me Up Shop or volunteering on any of their fundraising committees. The relationships made at Interfaith led me to other non-profits in our community. Community Assistance Center is a great resource for residents of Montgomery County, providing housing, community education and disaster relief. Both Interfaith and Community Assistance Center work closely together to serve our community and would not be able to do so without the many wonderful volunteers who give of themselves to make this area a better place to live.

There are two other organizations in Montgomery County that I feet a strong connection to, and those would be YES to YOUTH and HOPE The Will Herndon Research Fund. This stems from having a child of my own and wanting every child to have the same love, health and opportunity that I want for her. YES to YOUTH provides a safe and nurturing home where abased, battered, see-trafficked, homeless, and ast-sik youth begin healing from the past and become empowered for the future. Becoming involved in this organization will change your life for the better. Pre-covid we would cook at the shelter for the kids once a month and it was so rewarding. Volunteers are still needed to drop off meals to the shelter until their new cottage construction is complete. They also have a wonderful Ladies Night Out Fundraiser coming up in May, which is a great way to donate or get involved.

Last but certainly not least is HOPE. Butter disease is a fatal neurodegenerative disorder that takes away childhood, and then takes away the child. Precious Will has been fighting this disease since 2009 at the age of 6. The Herndon's are determined to find a treatment and cure to save Will and other children fighting this disease. There are so many ways to get involved with this organization. Join a fundraising committee, attend an event (HOPE on the Green is this Springf), but most of all raise awareness and share Will's story. "Where there is a WILL there is a way!"





I learned about a cancer survivorship center from a couple of friends that had started volunteering there. Canopy is a beautiful place, on the campus of Memorial Hermann, that provides a welcoming and nurturing haven for cancer survivors. There is so much that I love about it! Whether you're a 10 year survivor or newly diagnosed and you will find something there to support you in your journey.

All services are free and there are about 55 programs for men, women and children. Everything from art therapy to support groups and it doesn't matter where you received treatment. During the pandemic, Canopy has pivoted to Zoom programs in some cases but, we are slowly coming back, in a safe way with masking, social distancing and sanitizing in place.

We run on philanthropic dollars and donations primarily and are so grateful to our donors.

I've witnessed friendships formed and many lives enriched during my time as a volunteer at Canopy.

What a year this has been not only for all of us personally but for our non-profits. I am incredibly honored to be a part of Chelsea Photography's spotlight on our non-profit organizations in our community. The challenges this past year were felt across all organizations, from not being able to have volunteers, not having in-person events, and not being able to raise funds in a manner we were used to. Even through these challenges, with a community that needed more hype than ever, we pressed on and served.

I moved to the area in 2007 to work for Woodforest National Bank. One of the first things a great mentor told me was, 'you must get involved'. That is exactly what I did! My first event was to volunteer with The Montgomery County American Heart Association for the Heart Ball and was quickly amazed at how this community comes together to support an organization. Fast forward twelve years later and I now serve as the Chairman of the Board.

The American Heart Association is committed to driving equitable health impact in Montgomery County through three key priority areas: hypertension, nutrition security, and women's health. Here are the reasons why the AHA is focusing on these priorities: 32.70% of adults in Montgomery County have been told they have hypertension, 16.1% of residents in Montgomery County are predicted to have faced food insecurity in 2020, and Cardio Vascular Disease is the number 1 killer of women in the U.S and is the leading cause of maternal deaths in the U.S. 1 in 3 women are dying of cardiovascular disease. These statistics are the reason I continue to stay involved in AHA. We are making a difference.

This past year the AHA focused on education and what we can do to be the difference. The AHA partnered with Texas Children's Hospitals, Lone Star Family Health Center, Interfaith Community Clinic, CHI Baylor St. Luke's, Memorial Hermann, and Houston Methodist in enrolling in Target BP Initiatives with the American Medical Association. The AHA partnered with Meals on Wheels Montgomery County and The Montgomery County Food Bank on ways to work on Nutrition Security. An important highlight was when Meals on Wheels Montgomery County began cooking Heart Healthy Meals for their clients, and the clients loved them! For Women's Health we are building powerful partnerships with community organizations and WIC Centers to bring Blood Pressure Resources for Women. All this work is being done right here in Montgomery County, but all this work takes money and people to make it happen. I urge you to reach out to these organizations and find out how you can help. Every dollar and every hour make a difference in our community. Please see the below websites to find out how to get involved and give!
