DC Transitional Services Rebuilding Community Outreach Initiative

Are you or someone you know facing barriers that hinder you or them due to abuse; addictions, an arrest, or jail/prison . Does it seem like you or someone you know can not REBUILD your or their life. Then this outreach program is for you. The community is welcome to join in. Share a story or life event or present an opportunity to help someone else RE+ Build life after an abusive relationship, an addiction, prison or jail, conviction, or an arrest.

At DCTS the staff and volunteers believe everyone deserves a Sec2ND Chance in life to Re+ Build Connections

Transitioning from an abusive situation, prison or jail to freedom can be challenging for some. Many are looked upon as "coward, stupid, crazy, ex-con, convict, jailbird, felon or other derogatory names. Often because of a conviction, one is discriminated against by checking a box on an application that asks "Have you ever been convicted of a felony, etc." Many live behind a wall because of stigma. Therefore those that are trying to RE-Build their life have or are still enduring institutional stigmatization. As well as systemic and lead the charge of unfairness, equality,
