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
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# BARCELONA LAWS & CANNABIS

Members need to be 18 years or older to join and are required to sign up as members with proof of ID.

## Was Gaudi Lit?



### 1.0 SCOPE

This document outlines the use of Bio-stimulants over the use of pesticides or fungicides on medicinal products meant for human consumption (In 2001 Holland banned the use of Fungicides on all food crops as the products produced were no fit for human consumption due to the remaining remnants of the fungicides still present within the final product). These formulas and techniques will be used in conjunction with the Master Feeding Program as part of the proposed \*Regulatory Strategy Document\*. It should be read in conjunction with TGD documents 1-5.



#### 2.0 WHAT IS AN ORGANIC BIO-STIMULANT? AND WHAT DO THEY DO?

Bio-stimulants allow the plant to take up more water and fertiliser, the more efficiently a plant can take up water and fertiliser. The more chemical reactions the plant can achieve, the higher the brix (sap sugar content). This is our main goal to produce high brix plants, full of stored energy, that can be released into bursts of fruit and flowers and be used as energy to fight off pests, diseases and pathogens without the need of pesticides or fungicides.

#### 3.0 WHY USE NPK RAW NUTRITION?

NPK nutrients are isolated into their purest form, and is almost a completely organic range, allowing the nutritional needs of the plant to be met with a fully controllable, instantly adjustable, fully water soluble, expert feeding programme. Feeding programs should and will evolve and change as the plants needs and requirements change, usually inline with the different phases during the photoperiod. Nutrient manufacturers provide a baseline guide based upon their set-ups. The feeding programme should be adjusted in line with your plants personal requirements, not necessarily to the exact composition and PPM shown in the manufacturer feed programme. Only the NPK RAW range allows for such a fluid, instantly changeable feeding programme. He even interviewed the German scientist that invented and developed the Bio-Stimulants. However, due to 10 years of research and development to create the recipe, that it was a closely guarded secret and he couldn't just share this information freely.

Harley returned to the USA and began digging into advanced plant nutrition, microbiology, organic-chemistry, bio-chemistry, just looking for clues. vascular system, the bio-stimulants will also act as enzymes and catalysts for complex chemical processes within the plant.



### 4.0 SECRET 1 - BRIX & INCREASING BRIX LEVELS

### Building up the Brix for Healthier, Insect-Proof, Disease, Pathogen/Mold Resistant, Nutrient-Dense Crops.

Brix is a unit of measurement to assess any dissolved solids in plant (fruit and vegetable) juices. These solids include amino acids, proteins, minerals, vitamins, and the sugars: fructose and sucrose. It is important to know the brix level (°Bx) of fruits and vegetables to determine and plan soil management practices. It also helps gardeners enhance the soil while determining whether they should increase the organic matter and soil nutrient ratios.

### Brix may also be known as plant sap analysis.

The higher the brix level in fruits and vegetables, the healthier the plant is. Plants with a high brix level tend to taste better and can be stored for longer periods of time. In fact, high-brix fruits and vegetables do not rot as easily. High-brix plants have been known to produce seeds that germinate quicker, while resisting both frost and heat damage. The best organic farmers often boast about growing nutrient-dense, high-brix plants. But brix is still a foreign concept to many indoor growers. Brix is a measurement of the sugar content in the sap, expressed as a percentage. Generally speaking, the higher the brix, the healthier the plant.

Furthermore, there is a direct proportional relationship between brix and the quality of the finished produce. High-brix plants are healthier, tastier and higher in nutrients than low-brix plants, and brix offers an objective measurement of how well your plants are doing. So if you want to consistently grow the best of the best, taking regular brix readings will help you reach your goal.

Brix measurements are taken with the aid of a brix refractometer. The more sugars and dissolved solids in a sap sample, the more the mixture bends the light that passes through it. A brix refractometer reads how much the light bends (refracts), and displays the results as a percentage of sugars in the sap. Take a leaf sample, roll it into a ball and squeeze a couple of drops onto the glass slide of the refractometer. Then look through the hand-held device towards a light source, and read the brix number on a graduated scale. If you want an even more accurate measurement, digital refractometers are also available.

### The more efficiently your plants take up water and nutrients, the higher the brix.


Since organic biostimulants improve the uptake of minerals, the judicious use of additives such as amino acids, humic and fulvic acids, and seaweed extracts can help improve brix. The proper balance of minerals in the nutrient solution can also have a positive effect, particularly the potassium-to-nitrate ratio. Here are some suggestions for improving the brix of your favorite crops.

### **Increase the Potassium** to Nitrate Ratio

Potassium is a catalyst for carbohydrate metabolism, helping to increase brix. A grower has three choices for increasing the potassium-to-nitrate ratio: lower the nitrates, increase the potassium or do a little of both. Once you find the sweet spot, no pun intended, the brix should start to improve. Taking a brix measurement is standard operating procedure for hydroponic crop advisors in Europe. For example, if a leaf sample in a hydroponic tomato greenhouse shows low brix, often the first thing the consultant will recommend is raising the potassium-to-nitrate ratio until the brix reaches the target level. That way, nutrient problems can be avoided before the first signs of deficiency appear. Once visual nutrient deficiencies appear, the plant is already suffering and may not ever be able to reach its true genetic potential. Taking brix readings and making adjustments will help prevent problems before they happen.




Excessive nitrates burn carbohydrates and reduce brix. In fact, nearly 30% of the energy of photosynthesis is used just to assimilate the nitrates. So to ensure high brix, don't give plants more nitrates than they need. Excessive nitrates produce large cells within cell walls, making them a target for pests and diseases. And since the sugars are burned to produce more top growth, root growth can become restricted and fruit and flower production can be delayed. A brix refractometer can show the signs of excess nitrates before it's too late.





### 5.0 SECRET INGREDIENTS 1 - DISEASE, MOLD & PATHOGEN RESISTANCE



#### **Use Amino Acid Blends**

1. Amino Acids immobilise the Calcium into the plant cells to react with pectin acid and produce pectin. Mold spores are unable to assimilate and become systemic.

**Natural Disease, Pathogen & Mold Resistance** - Amino acids are intermediate chelators, improving the uptake of minerals. In particular, amino acids immobilise and improve the uptake of calcium by the plant. Two particular Amino Acids: \*Glutamic acid and \*Glycine, stimulate root cells to open up calcium ion channels, allowing calcium to be taken up 1000x faster than simple osmosis.

The calcium ions are taken up and react with Pectic Acid in the plant cells to make Pectin; the glue that cements the cell walls together. So now instead of water in the interstitial space (when getting more calcium uptake) we now have Pectin.

Now, when a mold spore lands on the leaf, it wants to send out a germination tube (especially powdery mildew), the water on the surface of the leaf do not allow the germination of the mold, it needs to access the internal water content in the interstitial space, then it germinates, becomes systemic and starts to spread throughout the plants. If more calcium uptake is achieved, by the time the germination tube penetrates the cells and gets to the water, the mold cell has dehydrated and died.



It doesn't kill the fungus, it is not a fungicide. It prevents the fungus from getting established, becoming systemic, spreading throughout and destroying the crop.



# 2. Amino Acids strengthen the stems and vascular system of the plant, allowing water and minerals to be taken up more efficiently. The more efficiently water and minerals are taken up, the higher the quality of the plant, its fruits, and flowers.

The Amino Acids we will use are created in natures kitchen, and are called L-Amino Acids, they have a left handed orientation and are produced through Enzymatic Hydrolysis of Proteins. They are digestive enzymes that break down proteins into their building blocks - the Amino Acids. They then keep their left handed orientation which is the biologically active form of Amino Acids. Right handed Amino Acids are not biologically active

Amino acids are intermediate Chelators; Chela means; Claw. A Chelate is an organic molecule that attaches to a mineral ion like a claw, it hold it tightly enough so it doesn't get locked-up with other minerals, but loosely enough that it is available to the plant on demand. 



Granja La Pallaresa - Serving excellent breakfasts and snacks since 1947, they are known for their classic thick cup of drinking chocolate ('a la tassa') and the version with unsweetened whipped cream on top ('suizo'). We enjoyed the traditional hot chocolate with churros. Though churros are always a favorite with hot chocolate, locals also enjoy the ensaimadas - there is even a plaque outside on the wall that commemorates the eating of ensaimadas at this establishment.

Granja Dulcinea - Established in 1941, this is the oldest xocolaterie on the street. Besides the famous hot chocolate and churros they serve an assortment of pastries and coffee.

Petritxol Cafe - another famous shop for xocolata desfeta and churros! It boasts a modern decor and all things chocolate. So whether you're a seasoned traveller looking for a new adventure or you're simply looking to explore the sights and sounds of Barcelona, there's no better place to start than Carrer de Petritxol. TERPENES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE UNIQUE AROMAS AND FLAVORS OF THESE PLANTS AND ARE ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR MANY OF THE HEALTH BENEFITS THAT HUMANS RECEIVE FROM CONSUMING THEM. 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# CASE STUDY 2, Harley Smith; Brix Levels

I discovered the relationship between amino acids and brix when growing romaine lettuce one summer in an outdoor NFT system. I had just purchased my first brix refractometer, and I was taking brix tests on everything I could get my hands on and comparing the readings with brix charts. Brix charts indicate quality, either low, medium or premium quality, depending on how high the brix is. After I started using amino acids in my nutrient solution, the brix in the leaf tissue of my lettuce was off the charts.

In fact; the brix level was so far above premium quality that statistically I would have to create a new category for it. Every store and every restaurant that tasted the produce bought it at 20% above premium cost.

We also went through three hard frosts without losing a single leaf. I found out later that for every 1% increase in brix, there is a half-degree lower freezing temperature.

The improved calcium uptake provided by the amino acid blend resulted in the following results:

- 1. Higher brix
- 2. Better flavours
- 3. Longer shelf life
- 4. Higher sales prices
- 5. Were the absolute best of the best in quality, on the market

If you can achieve a brix level of 12% or higher, sucking insects won't even recognise the plant as a food source



## USE SEAWEED EXTRACTS - KELP

# Benefits of Kelp

Kelp contains over 62 beneficial trace elements and micronutrients from the sea, including; copper (Cu), iron, (Fe), manganese (Mn), & zinc (Zn), These elements activate enzymes, and, if just one enzyme is turned on, one single molecule can perform 1000 chemical reactions per second in the plant.

Seaweed extracts also have a positive effect on brix. Seaweed extracts include mannitol, a natural sugar that chelates micronutrients (a micronutrient is one of seven essential secondary nutrients that plants require to maintain productive growth. Micronutrients include chlorine (Cl), molybdenum (Mo), copper (Cu), iron (Fe), manganese (Mn), zinc (Zn), and boron (B). Plants require all of these nutrients in small amounts, however, they are less essential than macronutrients, or primary nutrients, nitrogen (N), phosphorus (P), and potassium (K), and makes them more available to the plant).

Seaweed extracts are also loaded with natural plant growth hormones that stimulate cell division. When used at the root zone, seaweed extracts stimulate cell division of root cells, resulting in more lateral root growth and greater root mass. Improved root growth creates more surface area for the uptake of water and minerals, further improving the brix of the plant. Seaweed extracts are synergistic with other organic bio-stimulants, so using a combination of additives is better than using any single additive alone.


## Seaweed And Plants

The many benefits of seaweed extracts have been known to growers for thousands of years, but only in modern times have their active ingredients been identified. Seaweed extracts are rich in natural plant growth hormones and beneficial trace elements, and they are a component of most bio-stimulant products found on the market today.

The best seaweed extracts come from the brown seaweed \*Ascophyllum nodosum\*, harvested from mineral-rich waters such as those found near Norway and Nova Scotia. \*Ascophyllum nodosum\* grows in the tidal zone and is subject to extremes in temperature, flooding, drought, salt stress, and high levels of solar radiation and ultraviolet light. The seaweed extracts from these regions are very high in Auxins, Cytokinins, Gibberellins and plant protection agents.











# What are Auxins, Cytokinins, and Gibberellins?

Seaweed extracts have high levels of natural plant growth hormones, especially auxins, cytokinins and gibberellins. Hormones are very small signal molecules that help steer the growth and development of the plant. Hormones are usually produced in one part of the plant and transferred to another part of the plant to initiate physiological changes. For example, auxins are produced in the leaves of plants, then transferred to the roots and growing tips. Cytokinins, on the other hand, are produced in the roots and transferred to the leaves and growing tips. The balances between hormone levels determine their affects on plant development.

ROOTS AUXINS

Indole-3-acetic acid (IAA)

Auxins are best known for their positive effect on rooting, and synthetic auxins are usually found in rooting powders and cloning gels. Only a small amount of auxins are needed to initiate root growth. Too much auxin, especially when applied to growing roots, can actually have the opposite affect and restrict root growth! Seaweed extracts contain small amounts of natural auxins and indoles that help stimulate rooting, which, when combined with cytokinins, result in the production of greater root mass. Greater root mass provides better uptake of water and minerals and a healthier, more stress-resistant plant.

FOLIAGE CYTOKININS

Cytokinins: At molecular level cytokinins play a huge role in sending biological signals to the plant, which determine the growth and

development of cell division. Produced in the roots, seeds and fruits, travelling upwards towards the xylem, to promote lateral growth and to slow down the symptoms of ageing and keeps the plant's leaves green for longer time. As well as performing mitosis, the development of chloroplast, root cell tissue, the structure of branching and leaf

formation. The way the cytokinin works is by binding itself to a protein receptor within the cell membrane, which will then be attached to a phosphate group in the cytosol. The protein will then activate once moved into the nucleus, where it binds to the genes of the plant which will dictate what direction of growth will commence. They stimulate rapid cell division and the production of new cell walls. Cytokinins work in conjunction with other plant hormones. If, for example, cytokinins are applied during root formation, the cytokinins will stimulate the division of more root cells. If cytokinins are applied during the vegetative growth stage, the plants will grow faster with stronger cell walls. And if cytokinins are applied just prior to fruiting and flowering, more lateral buds will develop for better overall fruit and flower production.

The cytokinins in seaweed extracts also have a beneficial effect on mother plants, especially when used as a foliar spray. When applied to plant tissues, cytokinins draw nutrients into the tissue, while stimulating more lateral plant growth. More lateral buds mean stockier plants with more candidates for healthy clones.

### SEEDS GIBBERILLINS

Gibberellins are what determine stem elongation as well as flower and fruit development. Sometimes used as a way of nursing old stubborn seeds, gibberellins can stimulate dormant seeds by producing an enzyme that will supply the seed with some nutrient energy, (seaweed extracts are sometimes used to soak seeds before planting) The gibberellins stimulate the dormant seeds to produce enzymes that break down the stored starches into energy molecules needed for respiration. This energy is then transferred into the roots then upwards to the growing tips. As with everything too much of these three hormones can in fact inhibit plant development. Providing too much auxin can restrict and stunt root growth, too much gibberellin can in fact reduce germination rates in seeds and excess amounts of cytokinin can burn plant leaf tissue.

• NOTE: When using seaweed extracts, it is very important to follow the dosage and application directions carefully. Seaweed extracts can be applied as a foliar spray or as an additive to the nutrient formula, but foliar application seems to be the most efficient. Just remember not to use it as a foliar spray on flowers. Also, be careful not to use too much! Hormones are very powerful, even in small amounts, and using too much will have the opposite effect on the plants. Too much auxin restricts root growth, too much gibberellin reduces germination rates, and too much cytokinin can burn leaves. Moderation is the key!



# SECRET INGREDIENTS 2 -HUMIC & FULVIC ACID

Humic and fulvic acids are also intermediate chelators, helping plants take up important trace elements. Since trace elements activate enzymes in the plant, the plant is able to do more chemical reactions per second, resulting in higher brix. Iron uptake is especially important. In nature, humic and fulvic acids hold onto iron ions like a claw and make them more available to the plant. Iron is a catalyst for chlorophyll synthesis, the green pigment in plants that actually manufactures sugars during photosynthesis.

In fact, if iron availability is at optimal levels, plant genes will be activated to produce more chloroplasts to hold the extra chlorophyll, turning the plant into a more efficient sugar-making machine. The result? Higher brix. Fulvic acid can be used as a foliar spray.

The Humid Acid are large molecules that will literally form a bridge between the clay particles and the minerals, making it easier for the plant to take them up.

The Fulvic Acid are smaller more biologically active molecules that transport the iron and other trace elements through the cell membranes, and release them inside the cell where they are needed the most. The carbon skeletons can then be metabolized by the plant. For best results, use a natural surfactant such as yucca extracts when using fulvic acid as a foliar feed. The surfactant prevents water from beading up on the waxy leaf surfaces, so the foliar spray spreads out in a thin film for better absorption by the leaf. Better absorption of iron results in higher brix.

Both Humic and Fulvic Acid buffer PH levels, both acidic and alkaline buffering properties, resulting in improved nutrient uptake and in particular iron.

# THE 10 YEAR STUDY SECRET FORMULA BIO-STIMULANT

Virginia Tech did a 10 year study on Bio-Stimulants, and they found that a 5:2 ratio of Humic Acid to Kelp, worked 50% better than either product alone. They also discovered it improved the plants natural tolerance to stress, it stimulates the plant to make 50% more of a natural Plant Protection Agent called Superoxide Dismutase; an enzyme that alternately catalyses the dismutation of the superoxide radical in ordinary molecular oxygen and hydrogen peroxide. Superoxide is produced as a by-product of oxygen metabolism and, if not regulated, causes many types of cell damage. It practically sponges-up free-radicals, when a plant is under stress, sometimes it cannot keep up with free-radicals and those free-radicals attack the cell membranes, the chloroplast membranes (photosynthesis), the mitochondrial membrane (cell power plant, energy, grow, reproduce).



### 1.1: The Microbial Powerhouse

Compost teas owe their efficacy to the diverse microbial communities they harbor. These microbial populations not only enrich the nutrient content of the soil but also establish symbiotic relationships with cannabis plants, enhancing their immune system and nutrient uptake abilities.

# Section 2: Building the Perfect Compost Tea

2.1: Creating compost teas: starts with selecting high-quality ingredients that lay the foundation for a thriving microbial community. Organic matter, such as well-rotted compost and worm castings, forms the backbone of the tea and provides essential nutrients. These ingredients should be free from contaminants and rich in diverse microbial populations. To ensure a healthy teaalways use a high-quality compost. Choose organic compost that comprises a balanced mix of green (nitrogen-rich) and brown (carbon-rich) materials. These include kitchen scraps, yard waste, and aged







Water quality is crucial when preparing compost teas. Chlorinated or heavily treated water may negatively impact microbial activity. Whenever possible, use dechlorinated water or, better yet, collected rainwater to maintain a thriving microbial population.

# 2.3: Aerating for Optimal Oxygenation

Oxygenation is key in promoting Aeration. This is a critical step in compost tea production, as it ensures the proper development and growth of aerobic microorganisms. Oxygenation of the tea stimulates beneficial aerobic bacteria, fungi, and protozoa while suppressing harmful anaerobic pathogens. To achieve this, a reliable air pump and appropriate diffuser should be utilized for consistent oxygenation.

Proper aeration ensures oxygen is supplied to the tea solution during the steeping process. Use an aquarium pump or compost tea brewer to create and maintain oxygen levels of 6-8 ppm.

# 2.4: Timing the Brewing Process: Brewing Time and Temperature

The duration of brewing and the temperature at which the compost tea is prepared influences microbial activity and population dynamics. Optimal brewing times and temperature ranges can vary depending on the desired microbial community and targeted plant outcomes. Generally, a brewing duration of 24 hours at temperatures 20-25°C (68-77°F) between promotes the growth of beneficial organisms while minimizing the proliferation of harmful pathogens. Beware of over-brewing, as this may lead to the proliferation of harmful microorganisms. If it starts to stink then you've gone too far and it needs to be thrown out. Once you're ready to use it, your tea needs to be used within four hours so that the active microorganisms won't start to die.

# Section 3: Straining and Application Techniques

Once the compost tea brewing process is complete, it is crucial to strain out any sediment or large particles before application. This helps prevent clogging of sprayers and ensures an even distribution of microbes onto cannabis plants. Multiple filtration methods such as cheesecloth, fine mesh, or microbe screens can be employed for effective straining.

## 3.1 Application Rate and Timing

Applying compost teas to cannabis plants at the right time and in appropriate quantities maximizes their benefits. Factors like plant's growth stage, susceptibility to disease, and environmental conditions need to be considered. As a general guideline, applying compost teas during early morning hours or late afternoon, when leaf surfaces are dry and temperatures are moderate, is optimal.


### 3.2 Soil Drench Application:

One method of applying compost tea is through soil drenching. Dilute the brewed compost tea with water in a 1:4 ratio before applying it near the base of the cannabis plants. The highly beneficial microbial communities present in the tea will colonize the soil, benefiting root health and nutrient uptake.

Dilute the compost tea in a 1:10 ratio with water and evenly spray the solution, focusing on the underside of the leaves. By understanding the scientific foundations behind each step of compost tea production, growers can harness their full potential for sustainable and high-quality cannabis cultivation.



# Basic Compost Tea Recipe for Boosting Plant Growth

All compost teas follow the same basic recipe.

### Ingredients and Supplies

Non-chlorinated water (use rainwater, or allow tap water to sit for over 24 hours)

1-2 cups of inoculant (either worm castings or compost)

¼ − ½ cup of food source for bacteria or fungi

5 gallon bucket

Bacteria need simple sugars and proteins, and usually one of the easiest sources is unsulphured molasses. Fungi need more complex sugars, with common sources including fish hydrolysate (essentially ground up fish), kelp/seaweed, and humic acid.

Many people create a mixture of both molasses and fungi food to create a good balance of nourishment for both fungi and bacteria, and it may come down to what you have readily available.

If you want to avoid purchasing chemical products like humic acid, a great recipe includes:

# Easy DIY Compost Tea Recipe

Non-chlorinated tap water (enough to fill a 5-gallon pail) 2 cups fully finished organic compost (it should smell nice!) 1 tablespoon unsulfured blackstrap molasses

1 tablespoon liquid kelp fertilizer (or soak kelp meal in water) 1 teaspoon liquid fish fertilizer

### 4.0 COOKING PROCEDURE

SANITISE: Sanitise the candy moulds and any apparatus that will come into contact with food preparation or ingredients. Check all items to be used for integrity, in particular any glass items for cracks or chips. If a chip is found afterwards that you didn't check before the procedure, this chip could be in the candies and the entire batch would need to be destroyed.

# TERRA WEIGHT CONTAINERS:

Weigh any containers to be used and write its weight on the side for future reference.

## WEIGH ALL INGREDIENTS:

Weigh out all the ingredients you will need and label clearly using the above codes to avoid any errors.

### MIX THE DRY INGREDIENTS:

Mix thoroughly the dry ingredients D1 + D2 + D3

ADD CORN SYRUP TO THE DRY INGREDIENTS: Mix the syrup lightly to form a lumpy batter. (D1 + D2 + D3) + W1

### ADD ROOM TEMPERATURE

WATER. Mix the water into the mixture and mix checking there are no dry lumps stuck tot he bottom of the mixing vessel. make sure all lumps are evenly distributed. Top up with a little extra water if needed. (D1 + D2 + D3 + W1) + W2
BLEND THE MIX: Blend the mixture gently for 3-5 minutes until there are no lumps or clumps and you have an even, consistent mixture

LET THE GELATINE MIXTURE BLOOM. Leave the gelatine mixture

to sit at room temperature for 20-30 minutes. After 20-30 minutes the mixture should have a nice apple sauce consistency.

# HEAT THE GELATIN MIXTURE

TO 120f. After the bloom period, microwave the mix for 1 minute on high and stir. Dispersing the heat throughout the mixture. Repeat this in 1 minute bursts until 120 f is achieved. (At the same time prepare and heat the oil mixture step 9b).

# 9b. PREPARE AND HEAT THE CANNABIS OIL TO 120F. Mix

18gram of PG or MCT with the cannabis oil using a heated stirrer and magnetic stirrer bar until 120 F temperature is achieved. Now the gelling mix and the cannabis oil mixture are both at 120 degrees Fahrenheit.

10. GELATIN 120F + PG/Oil MIX 120F + Potassium Sorbate. Mix the 120f gelatin mix with the 120f PG/ oil mix and the potassium Sorbate/ mold inhibitor and mix thoroughly for 5 minutes until is thoroughly mixed and is a consistent, even mixture. # 12. COOLING, CURING & STOR-

AGE. Place molds in protective dust-free shelving stack. The environment must be less then <45% Humidity and <75 degrees Fahrenheit.Leave the Gummies until are no longer tacky. This should be roughly 24 hours. Once the gummies are no longer tacky they can be packaged. Can be stored in a fridge but not a freezer. If this recipe followed exactly, product will have at least a 6 month shelf life.

# **USE B-VITAMINS**

B-Vitamins work at the cellular level, as an additive to many cloning gels and solutions and most commercial plant bio-stimulant products. Generally used to reduce effects of stress caused by drought, transplanting and heat.



Most commonly used during times of stress, especially when transplanting, but also great for cloning or general root development.

SYSTEMIC INDUCED RESISTANCE (ISR) One dose of Vitamin B1 to the roots stimulates ISR, it puts the plant on high alert. It sensitises the plant. If the plant becomes under attack, say from Powdery Mildew, the plants natural immune system will respond almost instantly. If the immune response is quicker, the recovery is quicker. Protect against pathogens at the leaves like powdery mildew, grey mould, and, root pathogens like root rot or Pythium,

Protects against stress and activates enzymes and is also present in kelp

Enzymes used in cellular metabolism to release energy for the plant are turned on by co-enzymes, usual B-Vitamin derivatives; B-1, B-2, B-3 and B-6 form co-enzymes. they activate and stimulate cellular metabolism. 

Sucking insects do not have a pancreas, not only does this mean that they are unable to digest sugars, it means that in fact, sugar is a poison to them and will actually kill them.

Ever wondered why insects don't eat the fruit or the flowers? The bearers of the seeds and the next generation of life for the tree or plant. It is no mistake the seeds are protected by a sugar rich barrier known as fruit, or, what we could technically call \*Brix Storage Cells\*. The flowers of a plant are also naturally high in brix content to prevent the sucking-insects feeding on them and allow only the non-invasive nectar feeding insects for pollen distribution.

Remember, plant growth is part of a complex system with many variables, so don't expect a magic bullet to increase your brix overnight. Instead, use your refractometer along with other management tools in your garden. Light levels, air flow, pH, electrical conductivity and nutrient balance all affect brix in one way or another, and continuous improvement is the goal. Start by testing the brix of your healthiest, most productive plants and using the reading as a gold standard. Then take small steps to see if you can raise the brix in subsequent crops. As your brix goes up, you will soon see the relationship between brix and the quality of the fruits and flowers.
