Don't stay silent. It's time to speak up all month long. October is National Domestic Violence Awareness Month, which first began in 1981, by the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence as a Day of Unity to connect battered women's advocates across the country.

Domestic violence affects millions, both women and men, of every race, religion, culture and status. Since the Violence Against Women Act passed in 1994, we've come a long way. This landmark legislation, led by then Senator Joe Biden, combined new provisions that hold offenders accountable and provide programs and services for victims. State laws have reformed to address issues such as dating abuse in the workplace, stalking, employment discrimination and more.

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month

Breast Cancer Awareness Month is a yearly campaign that is intended to educate people about the importance of early screening, test and more. This campaign starts October 1st and ends on October 31st every year.

Breast cancer is a disease characterized by cells in the breast that become abnormal and multiply uncontrollably, forming a tumor. If left untreated, malignant cells may eventually spread beyond the original tumor to other parts of the body, a process called metastasis.




