Beta Psi Sorors participate in online webinars



Beta Psi FIL members participated in the annual event






Beta Psi exercises their right to vote

Beta Psi Chapter had three students participate in this years Evelyn D. Wilkey National Essay Contest. We even had one participant submit an essay from our Facebook promotion!


