

Epsilon Chi Membership Mixer March 22, 2019 honor the too-often neglected accomplishments of black Americans in every area of endeavor throughout our history." As we remember people and events during Black History Month, let's not forget to reflect on the 90 years of service of lota Phi Lambda Sorority, Inc. and that our sorority is a part of black history.

The turn of the 20th century was a tumultuous time for the United States. Within a few years of the start of World War I, there was the Great Migration of Blacks from the South to the Northern cities seeking greater opportunities and a more tolerant society.

These changes underscored the need for Blacks to learn new skills. These skills would hopefully ensure a better way of life for Blacks that had migrated northward.

Lola Mercedes Parker, a graduate of Chicago Business College, was one of the great visionaries of this time. She realized that Black women who were discriminated against on the basis of both race and gender needed to not only improve their existing skills but also motivate and inspire other women to achieve the highest level of proficiency in their chosen professions.

Joining together with Ethel T. Edwards, Mildred G. Hardin, Harriet M. Robinson, Ophelia Harrison, Burdette Trigg and Marjorie Tyndall, Lola M. Parker founded lota Phi Lambda Sorority on June 1, 1929 to carry out these objectives. As the organization grew, Mrs. Parker soon began to realize her dream of an organization that would encourage, nurture and promote the ideals of higher education, increased business acumen and a standard of professionalism for Black women.

In 1935, as the sorority's National President, Lola Mercedes Parker was instrumental in lota Phi Lambda Sorority being present when Dr. Mary McLeod Bethune held the historic first meeting of the National Council of Negro Women on December 5, 1935, in Harlem. Iota Phi Lambda Sorority, Inc. was one of three sororities present, along with representation from other national organizations.

Epsilon Chi Chapter, let's keep in mind that we are making history also. 90 years from now, Sorors will be remembering our contributions to the Katy/West Houston communities.




SORORS SPOTLIGHTS
