ET Virtual Black Owned Business Crawl







On April 27, 2020, Epsilon Tau Chapter Soror Periete Todd received confirmation that she had tested positive for the Covid Coronavirus, Covid-19. Soror Todd shared her story with the chapter by posting a video that described her symptoms and her wish to spread awareness about the Coronavirus.

"I was very meticulous about washing my hands with soap, wearing a mask, wiping items down with Clorox and I still got it."

What type of symptoms did you experience?

On April 22, I felt my body was stiff, a little bit of sneezing, no sore throat, no difficulty breathing, none of the initial symptoms described. I tried to get up the next day and my body was so stiff, that prompted me to go and get tested. There is a new list of symptoms, I had diarrhea, headaches and a backache where your lungs are located.

Were you deemed an essential employee for work?

Yes, I was doing both reporting to work and working from home.

What places had you been going to daily?

Home, work, grocery store, my father's house as I was one of his caregivers.

Did you have to go to the hospital?

No, thankfully I did not.

How are you feeling now?

I'm improving. I do daily breathing treatments and take prescribed medicines. I really want to raise awareness about this virus. As they are reopening businesses be very careful, people are walking around asymptomatic.
