



Beta Psi sorors participated in viewing this historic event






TOYS U CAN'T RETURN - HIGH HOPES SERIES


Beta Psi members participated in the Diversity in the Workplace


Beta Psi shared information about its members

BLACK WOMEN IN THE CONTEXT OF CIVIL RIGHTS


Beta Psi members participated in this online event

Beta Psi conducted its Induction Ceremony








Beta Psi members celebrates Women's History Month
