May we continue to EXemplify EXcellence, while we are Building on Our Legacy.



"Finding the Cure Starts with Identifying the Cause"

November is National Diabetes Awareness Month.

The designation is intended to increase public understanding of the disease, including its prevalence, screening and prevention, treatment options, and resources for the more than 29 million men, women, and children in the United States affected by the disease.

Did you know that according to the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), diabetes is the sixth leading cause of death in the United States?

Did You Know?

There are at least three types of diabetes: type 1, type 2, and gestational diabetes.* Type 1 diabetes, previously known as juvenile diabetes, accounts for about 5 to 10 percent of diabetics and is a chronic condition in which the pancreas produces little or no insulin, a hormone needed to allow sugar (glucose) to enter cells and produce energy.
