
IOTA PROJECTS AND PROGRAMS Founder's Day 2020




Epsilon Omicron Charter Day Celebration

Polichic Juneteenth Weekend Census Event






Beta Psi participated in the PoliChic Juneteenth Weekend Census phone bank event.


