Music In Bangsawan	12.15pm	12.45pm	This performance piece showcases one of the key features of the Bangsawan Artform. Songs from traditional Malay music will be played.
Table Activities	12.45pm	1.30pm	This segment will be a free and easy session where the audience can visit the booths located at the perimeter of the area. There will be booths by Opera Academy and puppetry by Karya Kulture.
Bangsawan di Udara	1.30pm	2.30pm	Bangsawan di Udara is a Stage Read presentation in which a group of teachers from MOE will be conducting a script reading session. The teachers will be reciting the script titled <i>ISKANDAR JAUHARI</i> for written by the late Bangsawan practitioner, Pak Hamid Ahmad. Similar to the concept of Bangsawan Radio, the actors will be reciting their script, accompanied by sound effects created by the sound technician.
Bangsawan Radio Workshop	2.30pm	3.30pm	The workshop will be conducted by Mr Nadiputra. The workshop will introduce the participants to techniques needed when acting in a Bangsawan radio performance. Mr Nadiputra will also share voicing techniques that helps in giving character to an actor's voice.
Jenaka Bangsawan	3.30pm	4.00pm	The tale revolves around Sultan Aminurrashid, who is suffering from a severe stomachache. The Sultan commands that Abu Nawas be summoned to cure his ailment. Upon Abu Nawas's arrival, he uses his wits to trick The Sultan by trapping wind in a magical bottle. Abu Nawas demonstrates not only his intelligence but also a deeper understanding of human nature and the importance of laughter and joy in life.
