Matthew 10:37-42 (Summary and Explanation)

In this passage, Jesus continues instructing His disciples about the cost and rewards of following Him.

Verses 37-39: The Cost of Discipleship

"Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me..." Jesus is not telling people to stop loving their families. Rather, He teaches that loyalty to God must come before every other relationship. Following Christ may sometimes create conflict with family, and disciples must be willing to choose Him above all else.

"Whoever does not take up their cross and follow me is not worthy of me." Jesus is calling for self-denial, sacrifice, and complete commitment. In the first-century context, a cross symbolized suffering and even death. Discipleship is not merely belief; it is a willingness to surrender one's life to God's purposes.

The paradox in verse 39: "Whoever finds their life will lose it, and whoever loses their life for my sake will find it," means that those who live only for themselves ultimately lose what matters most, while those who surrender themselves to Christ discover true and eternal life.

Verses 40-42: Receiving Christ Through His Messengers

Jesus then speaks about welcoming His followers: "Whoever welcomes you welcomes me." Those who receive Christ's messengers are, in a sense, receiving Christ Himself and the One who sent Him.

The emphasis is that seemingly small acts of kindness done for God's people are noticed and valued by God. No act of faithful service is insignificant.

Devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus (Cont.)

The Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is a profound symbol of the core belief of Christianity: That Jesus Christ, the Son of God made man, loves each one of us immeasurably and without exception. Although pierced terribly by our sins, the Sacred Heart of Our Lord overflows with compassion and love for all mankind, even when that love is not reciprocated; therefore, devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is one of the most important devotions among Catholics.

It became popular following the apparitions of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, a Catholic nun from France, between the years of 1673 and 1675. This timing within history was important, as this devotion helped to counteract the heresy of Jansenism – a very rigid form of Catholicism throughout France at that time that focused more on the justice of God at the expense of His mercy. In short, Jansenism placed a certain emphasis on God’s selective salvation which in turn produced a general harshness and moral rigorism, denying God’s mercy to mankind.

The Church dedicates the entire month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus – a month which also hosts the great liturgical Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

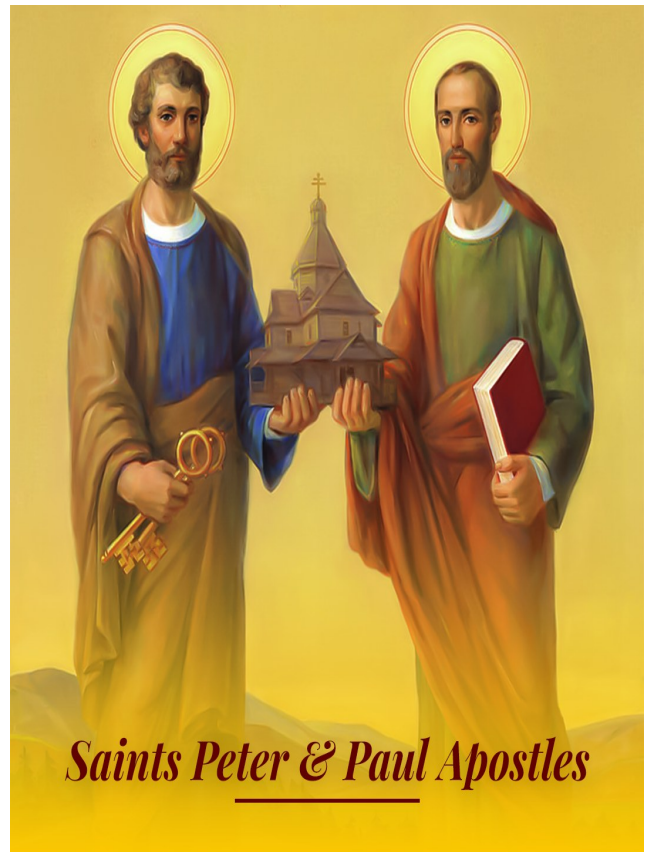
