I. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Shekhar Foundation proposes the development of a **600-crore INR** world-class, 200-bed Multi specialty **Hospital, research center & Trauma Center** strategically located at **Pachal Village, Rajapur Taluka, Maharashtra**, on the **Mumbai-Goa Highway (NH66)**. The facility will cater to rural and highway trauma emergencies while integrating holistic, modern, and international medical education and healthcare services. The land (5 acres) is already acquired. Funding is required to commence construction and infrastructure development.

II. VISION & OBJECTIVES

Vision:

"To offer accessible, advanced, and compassionate healthcare services, with a focus on trauma care and integrative medicine, while fostering world-class medical education and research."

Core Objectives:

To provide **state-of-the-art trauma and emergency services** for road accident victims on Mumbai-Bengaluru and Mumbai-Goa highways.

To establish a **200-bed modern hospital** equipped with **MRI, CT Scan, PET Scan, Cath Lab, Dialysis Unit**, and ICUs.

To set up an **air ambulance service** for faster rescue and emergency transport.

To integrate **modern allopathy** with **holistic wellness therapies** (Ayurveda, Light & Music Therapy, Meditation).

To build an **education hub** with:

Medical College

Nursing College

Dental College

Paramedical Institute

To create **doctor residences, international guest bungalows, and hostel facilities** for students.

To establish a **cancer care zone** with a patient-centric palliative and integrative care approach.
