Dear Parents,

We are excited about starting Summer Camp. We will be doing things a little different this summer, but we are going to try our best to keep all our fun activities that the children look forward too. We have new policies and procedures (see COVID-19 attachment) but for the most part we were already taking these precautions to keep everyone healthy so it should not be too hard for us.

Our week will consist of water play, ice cream, snowballs, arts and crafts, music, outside play, and FUN!!! We will still get ice cream once week but instead of walking, for now, I will pick it up and the kids will eat it at school. We will also get snowballs once a week, the snowball truck parks out front and the snowball man has no contact with anyone, he stays inside the truck and hands the cups of ice to me, and then I add the syrup from the outside of the truck. We will have water play 3 days a week but unfortunately for now this will only be for the older kids. (I will let you know if your child will be participating). Once we get into phase 2, these rules may change and we may have the other children participate in water play. We will also have Funday Friday (see attached for a schedule of events).

The state has approved that we can take nature walks so the non-vehicular excursion form needs to be filled out and we will also have this on file if and when we start to walk to Baskin Robbins.

In order for things to run smoothly on Monday June 1<sup>st</sup>, we will have a drop off on **Thursday May 28 between 9-12**, so that you may drop off the following items. Your child may not start camp until I have received all paperwork.

- a new application for each child
- Water Activity Authorization Form
- Non-Vehicular Excursion Form
- authorization for Topical products (only for those in diapers)
- an extra set of clothes, this must include shirt, shorts, underwear, and socks. The clothes need to be placed in a Ziploc bag labeled with your child's name.
- Summer Fee \$100 per child
- Tuition can be paid on Monday morning

Unfortunately, we will not be able to allow anyone to eat breakfast at school. Please be sure to feed your child(ren) at home before arriving at school.

If your child is bringing a blanket for nap, the blanket must be small enough to be folded and fit in their cubby. The blankets will also be sent home every Friday so that you can wash them and return them on Monday.

All children must wear their uniforms each day. Uniforms consists of Khaki shorts, navy shirts, socks, and Velcro tennis shoes. If your child comes in any other type of shoes, they will not be allowed to stay at school.

For those children that will be participating in water play, they need to come to school dressed in their bathing suits with sunscreen applied (we do not apply sunscreen) and bring their uniform and a towel to school.

Do not forget everyone must arrive at school no later than 9:30, unfortunately if you arrive at 9:31, your child will not be allowed to attend for the day. Here is our schedule for the week:
