Start Times

Each dog will be assigned a start time according to their first event for the day. You may arrive 30 mins before your ring time but no earlier.

Once you have run your last run please pack up and leave so numbers stay down.

Park around the back of the building.

If you do not wish to, or can not for medical reasons, wear a mask, please do not register for this trial.

Masks must be worn at all times except when running.

General Information – (Limited Entry Trial)

This is an Agility Association of Canada (AAC) sanctioned trial that will be held under AAC rules and regulations. Note that the Outback Agility Trials Organizing Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry. There shall be no refunds for acts of God, inclement weather, missed runs, entries withdrawn after the closing date, if a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal, or in the event the dog is absent on the day of the trial. However, refunds will be given to a competitor whose bitch comes into season or whose dog is injured, provided that the trial secretary (animals6humans1@gmail.com) is informed prior to the trial date and a certificate from a veterinarian is provided at that time, All refunds are at the discretion of the owner of Out Back and may be subject to a \$25 administrative fee.

FEO runs are allowed. Indicate them in the entry form.

<u>Title Trial:</u> Dogs will be divided into 4 height groups in 4 divisions: Regular, Special, Veteran and Double Drop Veteran.

Masters Standard is open to dogs that have an AADC title; Masters Games are open to dogs who have 3 corresponding

Advanced Games qualifying scores (Q's) in the same game under 2 different judges. Advanced Standard is open to dogs that have an ADC title; Advanced Games are open to dogs who have 2 corresponding Starters Games Q's. Starters Standard is open to dogs that do not have an ADC title. Starters Games are open to dogs who have not earned two Q's in that Starters Game. Team Relay and Steeplechase are open to all levels. Note that move-ups will be allowed during the trial, provided space and time allow.

Obstacles: All obstacles conform to AAC specifications. Obstacles include A-frame, Dog Walk, See-Saw, Weave Poles, Table, Flexible Tunnels, Self-Healing Tire Jump, Ascending Spread Jump, Wall Jump, Broad Jump, Double Bar Jump, and Single Bar Jumps, . All contacts are rubberized. An electronic timing system will be used. There will be no table at this trial.

<u>Facilities</u>: The trial will be held indoors on dirt .You must **keep your dog on leash at all times when not in the ring.** This

include anywhere on the property. . Jonny hutt's available. Bring your own seating, drinking water and dog crates. For this trial please crate out of your car.

<u>Dog Aggression</u>: All dogs must be kept in an X-pen, crate, in your car, or on leash when not in the ring (this includes the grounds

and parking lot). In order to avoid incidents of dog aggression towards other dogs and/or people, please give all dogs lots of room and be

aware of your dog's behavior at all times. Any dog engaging in aggressive behaviour at any time will be required to leave

the grounds. In such cases, NO refunds will be issued. If your dog needs space we will provide you with a yellow bandana. Please be aware

of the yellow banadanas when on the property and give these dogs even more space.

Ring Etiquette: If you are not entered in a specific event, you are NOT permitted in the ring during the walk-through. If you are entered in an event and you are coaching others (or being coached by others), please show consideration for the rest of the competitors by doing your coaching OUTSIDE the ring and do not block other competitors, or hold strategy discussions in the ring during the walk through. Thank you for showing respect for all competitors.

Leashes, collars and food are not allowed in the ring at any time. Nonaudible toys in good condition are allowed in the ring only during FEO

runs and may be thrown up to 10 feet. For this trial you may bring your leash/collar in the ring and either drop it before approaching the startline or Put it in your pocket.

Awards: (please advise the Scorekeeper if your dog achieves a Title or Award of Merit at the Trial)

Please tell the scorekeeper verbally if you achieved a title so she can prepare your ribbon.

- Qualifying Rosettes for all event qualifiers
- Ribbons minimum awarded for 1st through 4th place, in each of Mini & Open
- Title Rosette for any dog achieving an AAC title at the trial

Evening Trials: For evening trials competitors **must** arrive in time for registration even if not running in the first event as they may be called upon to volunteer for the event. All competitors will be required to volunteer at some point during the evening. Only with the cooperation of all involved can such an event run smoothly. Everyone must also stay to the end to help fill any open volunteer spots
