Light



You, O Lord, are our shield, our glory and the One who lifts up our head. (Ps. 3:3). Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory (Is. 6:3)! Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In

the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, the Dayspring (the dawn of the morning) from on high (Luke 1:78), we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, He who is far above principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come (Eph. 1:21), in His almighty name we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

Hear our prayer, O Lord, give ear to our supplications! In Your faithfulness answer us, and in Your righteousness (Ps. 143:1). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), may you arise and shine; for your light has come and the glory of the Lord is risen upon you (Is. 60:1)! The Lord will arise over you and His glory will be seen upon you and your children (Is. 60:2). You shall see and become radiant, and your heart shall swell with joy, because the abundance of the sea shall be turned to you, the wealth of the Gentiles shall come to you (Is. 60:5). The Lord will be to you an everlasting light, and God will be your glory (Is. 60:19)! The Lord our God has called you in righteousness, and will hold your hand, and will keep you (Is. 42:6). Your light shall break forth like the morning, your healing shall spring forth speedily, and your righteousness shall go before you; the glory of the Lord shall be your rear guard (Is. 58:8). Your light shall dawn in the darkness, and your darkness shall be as the noonday. The Lord will guide you continually, and

satisfy your soul in drought, and strengthen your bones; you shall be like a watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail (Is. 58:10-11). Sing to the Lord, all the earth; proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day! Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all peoples! For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:23-25)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), as God's fellow worker (1 Cor. 3:9), in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) we ask the Lord the God of recompense (Jer. 51:56) that the Angel of God shall come between your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and the camp of the enemy (Satan) and be a cloud of darkness to the one but give light by night to you so that the enemy may not come near you or your house (Ex. 14:20). In Christ (John 15:4-5) we pray (James 5:16) that you will dwell in the secret place of the Most-High and you shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty (Ps. 91:1) and you shall have light in your dwellings (Ex. 10:23). For your house is with God and He has made with you an everlasting covenant, ordered in all things and secure. For the Lord is your salvation and He will make you and your family (Acts 13:26) increase (2 Sam. 23:5). You shall be like the light of the morning when the sun rises, a morning without clouds; like the tender grass springing out of the earth, by clear shining after rain (2 Sam. 23:4). As a fellow worker in **Christ** (Rom. 16:3) we pray (James 5:16) that God will watch over you, His lamp will shine upon your head and you will walk through darkness by His light for the friendly counsel of God is over (Job 29:2-4) your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The Lord shall lift up the light of His countenance upon you and put gladness in your heart (Ps. 4:6-7). The Lord will bring you by a way you did not know; He will lead you in paths you have not known. He will make darkness light before you and crooked places straight. These things He will do for you, and not forsake you or your people (ls. 42:16). For the Lord is your light and your salvation. The Lord is the strength of your life (Ps. 27:1). You shall have light and gladness, joy and honor (Esth. 8:16) wisdom and might (Dan. 2:23). The Lord made the heavens. Honor and majesty are before Him; strength and gladness are in His place. Give to the Lord, O kindred of the peoples, offer the Lord glory and strength! Give to the Lord the glory due His name (1 Chr. 16:28-29); offer sacrifices of joy (Ps. 27:6), bring the sacrifice of praise to the house of the Lord (Jer. 33:11), and come before Him! Oh, worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness (1 Chr. 16:26-29)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the Son of the Highest (Luke 1:32), in <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4-5) we ask God, our faithful God (Deut. 7:9), that the Spirit of God be in you, light and

understanding, revelation (Luke 2:32) and wisdom be found in you (Dan. 5:14). Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify God the Father in heaven (Matt. 5:16). Your light shall be like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal (Rev. 21:11). The Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:18) you to be a light to the world (Matt. 5:14), a burning and shining lamp (John 5:35): for you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. May you and your people walk as children of light (Eph. 5:8), walk in the light of the Lord (Is. 2:5). For it is God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in your hearts to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 4:6). You are children of light and people of the day. You are not of the night nor of darkness (1 Thess. 5:5). Even the night shall be light about you (Ps. 139:11). When you sit in darkness, the Lord will be a light to you (Mic. 7:8). For you are of a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of the darkness into His marvelous light (1 Pet. 2:9). In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23), His name alone is exalted (Ps. 148:13), in **Christ** (John 15:4-5) we ask that you be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and long suffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has qualified you to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light. For God has delivered you from the power of darkness and translated you into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom you have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins (Col. 1:9-14). O Lord, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth, you who set Your glory above the heavens (Ps. 8:1)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the appointed heir of all things (Heb. 1:2), may you commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:5-6). Oh, send out Your light and Your truth, O Lord! Let the light and truth of God Almighty lead you; let them bring you to His holy hill and to His tabernacle (Ps. 43:3). Abiding in <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4-5) we ask, in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who is the brightness of God's glory and the express image of His person (Heb. 1:3), that the Lord be your lamp; the Lord God enlighten your darkness (Ps. 18:28) with the light of life (John 8:12). For <u>Jesus Christ</u> has lovingly delivered your soul from the pit of corruption (Is. 38:17). He has redeemed your soul from going down to the Pit; you shall see the light (Job 33:28). For the Lord has delivered

your soul from death. He has delivered your feet from falling, that you may walk before God in the light of the living (Ps. 56:13). In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23), His name Immanuel (Is. 7:14), may you know the joyful sound (Ps. 89:15)! In Christ (John 15:4-5) we pray (James 5:16) that you will walk in the light of God's countenance (Ps. 44:3). You will love the Lord and hate evil. The Lord will preserve your soul and deliver you out of the hand of the wicked. Light is sown for you, and gladness for your upright heart (Ps. 97:10-12). You and your people will not be afraid of evil tidings; your heart is steadfast, trusting in the Lord. Your heart is established, you will not be afraid (Ps. 112:7-8), you will never be shaken (Ps. 112:6); for the word is a lamp to your feet and a light to your path (Ps. 119-105). In *Christ* (John 15:4-5) we pray (James 5:16) that our Father and God will open to you a door for the word to speak the mystery of *Christ* (Col. 4:3). May the entrance of His words give light to your soul and understanding to your mind (Ps. 119:130). In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23), THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS (Jer. 23:6), let the light of your eyes rejoice your heart (Prov. 15:30). The lamp of the body is the eye (Matt. 6:22). In the mighty (Luke 24:19) name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), thanks to the name of the Lord (Ps. 122:4), in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) we ask the Father (Math. 6:9) that your eyes be good, your whole body be full of light (Matt. 6:22); that God will open your eyes and turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of Satan to God (Acts 26:18); that you will cast off the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light (Rom. 13:12). In *Christ* (John 15:4-5) we pray (James 5:16) that you will follow *Jesus Christ* and not walk in darkness, but have the light of life (John 8:12), and that His light will guide your feet into the way of peace (Luke 1:79). May our Lord God guide you so you will walk in the light as **Jesus Christ** is in the light and have fellowship with other saints and the blood of **Jesus Christ** His Son will cleanse you from all sin (1 John 1:7). In *Christ* (John 15:4-5) we pray (James 5:16) that the love of God is poured out in your heart by the Holy Spirit who was given to you (Rom. 5:5); that the morning star rise in your heart (2 Pet. 1:19); that there is no cause for stumbling in you (1 John 2:10). You and your people are righteous; you are the branch of God's planting, the work of His hands, that He may be glorified (Is. 60:21). For Jesus Christ is the true Light which gives light to you (John 1:9). How precious is His loving kindness! May you put your trust under the shadow of His wings. And be abundantly satisfied with the fullness of your house. May you drink from the rivers of His pleasures. For with the Lord, is the fountain of life. Let you rest in His light (Ps. 36.7-9). Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all (1 Chr. 29:11)!

Glorified with Christ Jesus (Rom. 8:17), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus* Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers (Col. 1:16), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Let us worship and praise the Lord, for He is good, for His mercy endures forever. (2 Chr. 7:3)

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
