## Peace



Both riches and honor come from You, O God, and You reign over all. In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all. Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your glorious name (1 Chr. 29:12-13). Our Father in heaven,

hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11), we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, our fortress (Ps. 18:2), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

Hear us, O Lord, for Your lovingkindness is good; Turn to us according to the multitude of Your tender mercies (Ps. 69:16). To you and your entire family, the saints and faithful brethren in *Christ:* Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the *Lord* **Jesus Christ.** We give thanks to the God and Father of our **Lord Jesus Christ**, praying for you (Col. 1:2-3); giving thanks because of the hope which is laid up for you in heaven (Col. 1:5). The Lord make His face shine upon you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and be gracious to you and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); the Lord lift up His countenance upon you, and give you peace. The Lord put His name on you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and bless you (Num. 6:25-27) and your family (Acts 13:26). Peace be to you and all of your people (Ps. 148:14), peace to your house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21), and peace to all that you have (1 Sam. 25:6), peace on every side and all around you (1 Kin. 4:24) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Peace be within your walls, prosperity within your house (Ps. 122:7), for God has strengthened the bars of your gates; He has blessed you and your children. He makes peace in your borders (Ps. 147:13-14). You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places (ls. 32:18). The Lord's kindness shall not depart from you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), nor shall His covenant of

peace be removed (Is. 54:10). You and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall enter into peace; you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall rest in your beds, each one of you walking in your uprightness (Is. 57:2). The Lord will bring you and your people (Ps. 148:14) health and healing; He will heal you and yours and reveal to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the abundance of peace and truth (Jer. 33:6). It shall come to pass in that day (Is. 10:27) that the Lord of Hosts (Jer. 32:18) shall break Satan's yoke from your neck and burst your bonds (Jer. 30:8); for the chastisement for your peace was upon Him and by His stripes you and yours are healed (Is. 53:5). His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, of the increase of His peace there will be no end (Is. 9:6-7). Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest (Luke 19:38)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who is great to the ends of the earth (Mic. 5:4), you shall dwell in the land that the Lord has given you, your children and your children's children forever. The Lord will make a covenant of peace with you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and it shall be an everlasting covenant with you and your family (Acts 13:26); He will establish you and your people (Ps. 148:14) and multiply you, and He will set His sanctuary in your midst forevermore (Ezek. 37:25-27). The Lord will fight for you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and you shall hold your peace (Ex. 14:14). He will give peace in your land, and none will make you or your family (Acts 13:26) afraid; He will rid the land of evil beasts, and the sword will not go through your land (Lev. 26:6). He shall give to you and your family (Acts 13:26) His covenant of peace; and it shall be to you and your descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) after you a covenant of an everlasting priesthood (Num. 25:12-13). Upon your house there shall be peace forever from the Lord (1 Kin. 2:33). Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory (Is. 6:3)! His praise endures forever (Ps. 111:10)! The Lord God is our Father; our Redeemer from Everlasting is His name (Is. 63:16). There is none holy like the Lord, for there is none besides Him, nor is there any rock like our God (1 Sam. 2:2). Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:36)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), from the rising of the sun, even to its going down, His name shall be great among the nations (Mal. 1:11); therefore, let the peace of God rule in your hearts and be thankful (Col. 3:15). For it pleased the Father that in <u>Jesus</u> all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross. And you who once was alienated and an enemy in your mind by wicked works, yet He

has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present you holy, and blameless, and irreproachable in His sight (Col. 1:19-22). May you continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast (Col. 1:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:2). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will flee youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart (2 Tim. 2:22); that you will pursue peace with all men, and holiness (Heb. 12:14). Grace and peace be multiplied to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in the knowledge of God and of *Jesus* our Lord. (2 Pet. 1:2).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), for at the name of <u>Jesus</u> every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and of those under the earth, and every tongue should confess that **Jesus Christ** is Lord, to the glory of God the Father (Phil. 2:10-11); therefore, in **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) now may the God of hope fill you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) acquaint yourself with Jesus Christ and be at peace; thereby good will comes to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Let you receive instruction from God's mouth and lay up His words in your heart so that you will be built up; you and your family (Acts 13:26) will remove iniquity far from your house (Job 22:21-23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) will not forget His law, but let your hearts keep His commands; for length of days and long life and peace will be added to you. Let not mercy and truth forsake you; bind them around your neck, write them on the tablet of your heart, so you will find favor and high esteem in the sight of God and man (Prov. 3:1-4). Let you be complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with you (2) Cor. 13:11). Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and your land will yield its increase. Righteousness will go before Him and shall make His footsteps your pathway (Ps. 85:12-13). May the Lord make a covenant of peace with you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and cause wild beasts to cease from the land; and you and your family (Acts 13:26) will dwell safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods (Ezek. 34:25). Through the tender mercy of our God, with which the Dayspring (the dawn of the morning) from on high visited you; to give light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide your feet into

the way of peace (Luke 1:78). In His name, Jesus Christ, in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that the God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and the places all around you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) a blessing; may He cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing (Ezek. 34:26). Your land shall be quiet, and peaceful, for the Lord will give peace and quietness, rest from all your enemies all around (1 Chr. 22:9). The God of peace (Rom. 16:20), the Great, the Mighty God, whose name is the Lord of Hosts (Jer. 32:18), will crush Satan under your feet (Rom. 16:20). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) will wait on the Lord, and keep His way, and He shall exalt you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to inherit the land (Ps. 37:34) and you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall delight yourselves in the abundance of peace (Ps. 37:11). You shall know that your house is in peace; also, that your descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) shall be many, and your offspring like the grass of the earth. You shall come to the grave at a full age, as a sheaf of grain ripens in its season (Job 5:24-26). You shall be gathered to your grave in peace and your eyes shall not see all the calamity of the earth (2 Kin. 22:20). The Lord will deliver you and your people (Ps. 148:14) from this present evil age (Gal. 1:4). You and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall flourish like a palm tree, you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. For you are planted in the house of the Lord and you shall flourish in the courts of your God. You shall still bear fruit in old age; you shall be fresh and flourishing, to declare that the Lord is upright; he is your rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him (Ps. 92:12-15). You shall go to the Father in peace; you shall be buried at a good old age (Gen. 15:15). Now the God of peace be with you (Rom. 15:33) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Surely, the Lord your God has shown you His glory and His greatness (Deut. 5:24)! He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the ash heap, to set them among princes and make them inherit the throne of glory. For the pillars of the earth are the Lord's, and He has set the world upon them (1 Sam. 2:8).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), according to the Way (Acts 24:14), the Lord has redeemed your soul in peace from the battle which was against you (Ps. 55:18). He has lovingly delivered your soul from the pit of corruption, for He has cast all your sins behind His back (Is. 38:17) and you are a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17). Having been justified by faith, you have peace with God through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 5:1). Let you take hold of His strength, that you shall make peace with God. May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) all come to the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and He shall cause you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to

take root; you shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit (Is. 27:5-6). May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of **Jesus Christ:** Grace to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and peace be multiplied (1 Pet. 1:2)! In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), in Him all things exist (Col. 1:17), therefore let you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) receive the wisdom that is from above which is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. May the fruit of righteousness be sown in peace by you (James 3:17-18) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Let you be a person of understanding (Prov. 11:12), counselor of peace, with joy (Prov. 12:20) and gladness in your heart (Ps. 4:7), being among the peaceable and the faithful (2 sam. 20:19) loving truth and peace (Zech. 8:19), a peacemaker (Matt. 5:9). May the God of peace who brought up our *Lord Jesus* from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make you complete in every good work to do His will, working in you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) what is well pleasing in His sight, through *Jesus Christ*, to whom be glory forever and ever (Heb. 13:20-21). Glory, honor, and peace to you and your people (Ps. 148:14), everyone who works what is good (Rom. 2:10). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will not quarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition to God (2 Tim. 2:24-25), subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men (Titus 3:1-2). May the Lord God establish peace for you, for He has also done all your works in you (ls. 26:12). In **Jesus** you shall have peace. In the world you will have tribulations; but be of good cheer for through Jesus you shall overcome (John 16:33) and yield the peaceable fruit of righteousness (Heb. 12:11). You shall have righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit and serve Christ in these things and be acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:17-18). The kingdom of God has come near to you (Luke 10-9)! The work of your righteousness will be peace, and the effect of your righteousness, quietness and assurance forever (ls. 32:17). Let you keep your mind on the Lord, also trust in him and the Lord will keep you in perfect peace (ls. 26:3). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that your ways will please the

Lord and he will make even your enemies to be at peace with you (Prov. 16:7) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Peace to your house, peace will rest upon it (Luke 10:5-6). God, the Holy One, His glory covers the heavens, and the earth is full of His praise (Hab. 3:3).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the firstborn of all creation (Col. 1:15), the Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:18) you the peace of **Jesus** and let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27). In the name of Jesus (John 16:23) because His judgment is righteous (John 5:30) let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless (2 Pet. 3:14). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and yours will depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it (Ps. 34:14); let you and your family (Acts 13:26) pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another (Rom. 14:19). As much as depends on you, live peaceably with all men (Rom. 12:18): being spiritually minded, receiving life and peace (Rom. 8:6); being edified, walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit; being multiplied (Acts 9:31). May the Lord of peace Himself give you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) peace always in every way. The Lord be with you (2 Thess. 3:16) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your request be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through *Christ* Jesus (Phil. 4:6-7). Go in peace; and the God of Israel grant you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the petitions which you have asked of Him (1 Sam. 1:17) and guide your feet into the way of peace (Luke 1:79). Grace, mercy, love and peace be with you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) from God the Father and from the **Lord Jesus Christ**, the Son of the Father, in truth and love (2 John 1:3). Let us hear, and let us take it to heart, to give glory to His name (Mal. 2:2)

In the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), for by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers (Col. 1:16); in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will fear the Lord your God as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. The Lord shall come down like rain upon the mown grass, like showers that water the earth. You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall flourish, and have an abundance of peace, until the moon is no more (Ps. 72:5-7). The thoughts the Lord thinks towards you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give you and yours a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), for God is the author of peace (1 Cor. 14:33).

The Lord has seen your ways; and will heal you; He will also lead you and your family (Acts 13:26) and restore comforts to you. Peace, peace to him who is far off and to him who is near. Peace to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) says the Lord (Is. 57:18-19). All your children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of your children. In righteousness you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) shall be established; you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall be far from oppression, you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you (Is. 54:13-14) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). You and yours shall laugh at destruction and famine, and you shall not be afraid of the beasts of the earth (Job 5:22). For the Lord has set you and your people (Ps. 148:14) apart for Himself (Ps. 4:3). You shall walk in the wisdom (Col. 4:5) of the Lord on the path of peace (Prov. 3:17). You shall speak the truth and give judgment in your gates for truth, justice, and peace (Zech. 8:16). Your peace is like a river and your righteousness like the waves of the sea (Is. 48:18). May the presence of the Lord be with you on your way (Judg. 18:6). Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward you (Luke 2:14) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21)! For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the Sea (Hab. 2:14).

As God's elect (Rom. 8:33), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, King eternal, immortal, invisible (1 Tim. 1:17), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is the last Adam, a quickening spirit (1 Cor.15:45), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Let us praise the name of God with a song and let us magnify Him with thanksgiving (Ps. 69:30)!

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all

generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
