## Talk



Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, the light of the world (John 8:12), we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family

(Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, His name is called Mighty God (Is. 9:6), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

Grace to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and peace from God our Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ*. We thank our God, making mention of you in our prayers, that the sharing of your faith may become effective by the acknowledgment of every good thing which is in you in *Christ Jesus* (Philem. 1:3-6). Hear our prayer, O God; give ear to the words of our mouth (Ps. 54:2). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of *Christ*, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) will capture all of your thoughts and all of your words and put them under the obedience of Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 10:5), who became for you and your people (Ps. 148:14) wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30). Let the Lord set a guard over your mouths; keep watch over the doors of your lips (Ps. 141:3), and the Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:18) your tongues to be of choice silver (Prov. 10:20). Let the God of your salvation (Ps. 25:5) help you guard your mouth and tongue and keep your souls from trouble (Prov. 21:23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) no corrupt communication will proceed out of your mouth (Eph. 4:29) that will defile your heart (Matt. 15:11), but what is good for necessary edification (Eph. 4:29). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), in whom new creation avails (Gal. 6:15), out of the abundance of your hearts let your mouth speak (Matt. 12:34) blessing (James 3:10) and life (Acts 5:20), speaking with tongues of men and of angels in love (1 Cor. 13:1). May you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) not be undone because you are people of unclean

lips (Is. 6:5). Let the seraphim of God touch your lips with live coal from the altar of God that your iniquity be taken away, and your sin purged (ls. 6:6-7). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), as the truth is in Him (Eph. 4:21), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of truth (Ps. 31:4, Deut. 32:4) to teach you and your family (Acts 13:26) to guard your mouth and preserve your life (Prov. 13:3), lest you sin with your tongues (Ps. 39:1). Let all evil speaking be put away from you and your people (Ps. 148:14) (Eph. 4:31), with flattering lips (Ps. 12:2), great swelling words (Jude 1:16), and the tongue that speaks proud things (Ps. 12:3). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will walk uprightly, work righteousness, speak truth in your hearts (Ps. 15:2), stir up love and good works (Heb. 10:24), exhorting one another (Heb. 10:25), not backbiting with your tongue, nor doing evil to your neighbors, nor taking up a reproach against your friends (Ps. 15:3). Instead you will be followers of God as dear children. And walk in love, as Christ also has loved you and given Himself for you, an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling aroma (Eph. 5:12). For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea (Hab. 2:14). God, the Holy One, His glory covers the heavens, and the earth is full of His praise (Hab. 3:3)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of all flesh (Jer. 32:27) to help you and your family (Acts 13:26) keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking deceit (Ps. 34:13). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) speak with truthful lips (Prov. 12:19) and a gentle (Prov. 25:15) wholesome tongue (Prov. 15:4), your words being gracious (Eccl. 10:12). Let your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt (Col. 4:6). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the bread of life (John 6:48), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father (Math. 6:9) that your heart will teach your mouth and add learning to your lips (Prov. 16:23). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) guard the doors of your mouth (Mic. 7:5, Ps. 141:3), and not be hasty in your words (Prov. 29:20), never speaking idle words (Matt. 12:36), always being wise (Prov. 13:20) in who you trust or put your confidence in (Mic. 7:5), being people of few words (Eccl. 5:3), giving thought to all of your answers (Prov. 15:28), never murmuring, complaining (Jude 1:16), disputing (Phil. 2:14-15), grumbling, or fault finding (Jude 1:16). For God, who commanded light to shine out of darkness, has shined in your heart, to give the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 3:6). The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth (John 1:14).

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the true Light (John 1:9), according to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father (Math. 6:9) to let your words be of wisdom and justice (Ps. 37:30), with stored up wisdom, knowledge, and understanding (Prov. 10:13-14). The Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:18) you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to have a learned well trained disciplined tongue (ls. 50:4), from the counsel of God (Ps. 16:7); the meditation of your heart bringing understanding (Ps. 49:3), and a mouth of wisdom which all your adversaries will not be able to contradict or resist (Luke 21:15). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We ask the Father of Lights (James 1:17) to open to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) a door for the word, to speak the mystery of *Christ* (Col. 4:3). May the Lord put His words in your mouth and cover you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with the shadow of His hand (Is. 51:16). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord be with your mouth and teach you and your people (Ps. 148:14) what you shall say (Ex. 4:12). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), for of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever (Rom. 11:36), abiding in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) the words of your mouth and the meditations of your heart will be acceptable in God's sight (Ps. 19:14). By your words you and yours will be justified (Matt. 12:37). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be satisfied from the fruit of your mouth; from the produce of your lips (Prov. 18:20). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), according to His loving kindness (Ps. 119:88), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of truth (Ps. 31:5, Deut. 32:4, Is. 65:16) to give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) a mouth of wisdom (Luke 21:15), and precious lips of knowledge (Prov. 20:15). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Lord of glory (James 2:1), the words from your mouth shall be deep waters; the wellspring of wisdom a flowing brook (Prov. 18:4). May your mouth be filled with laughter (Ps. 126-2) and joy (Prov. 15:23), your tongue with singing (Ps. 126-2), confessing that Jesus Christ Lord, giving glory to God the Father (Phil. 2:11). Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised. The Lord is high above all nations, and His glory above the heavens. Who is like the Lord our God, who dwells on high, who humbles Himself to behold the things that are in the heavens and in the earth (Ps. 113:2-6)? Praise the name of the Lord (Ps. 7:17)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), Himself being the chief cornerstone (Eph. 2:20), the Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:16) that you and yours will see the glory of God (Acts 7:55); and with all boldness you and your family (Acts 13:26) will speak His word (Acts 4:29), for it is not you that

speak but the Holy Spirit (Mark 13:11). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) go from strength to strength (Ps. 84:7); and walk in the fear of the Lord and the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31); serving *Christ* in these things; and are acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:18). According to all that the Lord has bestowed on you and your people (Ps. 148:14), and the great goodness toward your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam, 6:21), which He has bestowed on you according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (Is. 63:7), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the God of truth (Ps. 31:4, Deut. 32:4) meet you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and speak to you (Ex. 29:42); that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will hear what the Lord God will speak, for He will speak peace to you (Ps. 85:8-9) and your people (Ps. 148:14). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will obey His voice and do all that He speaks (Ex. 23:22). Let you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) speak His testimonies and not be ashamed (Ps. 119:46). Let your lips speak right things (Prov. 23:16) and your tongue speak of His word, for all of His commandments are righteousness (Ps. 119:172). May you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) praise His works, to all generations and declare His mighty acts (Ps. 145:4). Let you and your children speak of the might of His awesome acts and declare His greatness and utter the memory of His great goodness and sing of His righteousness (Ps. 145:6-7) for His tender mercies are over all His works (Ps. 145:9). May you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) bless the Lord your God and speak of the glory of His kingdom and talk of His power, to make known to your children and your children's children His mighty acts and the glorious majesty of His kingdom. His kingdom is an everlasting kingdom and His dominion endures throughout all generation. (Ps. 145:10-13). Let the Lord be magnified, who has pleasure in the prosperity (Ps. 35:27) of your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21)

Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our <u>Lord Jesus</u>.

<u>Christ</u> (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, the door to salvation (John 10:9), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
