Prayer of Jabez



Blessed be the God and Father of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Eph. 1:3). We will magnify His holy name! Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come.

Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, the chief cornerstone (Luke 20:17) we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, in him is life and life is the light of men (John 1:4), so in His name we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that <u>Christ</u> through us speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

By the will of God, according to the promise of life which is in *Christ Jesus*, to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21): Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and *Christ Jesus our Lord*. We thank God, whom we serve with a pure conscience, as we remember you in our prayers, night and day (2 Tim. 1:1-3). Hear us when we call, O God of our righteousness! Have mercy on us and hear our prayer (Ps. 4:1). In the name of **Jesus** Christ (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), the faithful witness (Rev. 1:5), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven (Math. 6:9), our God and our Rock (Deut. 32:4), let Him perfect what concerns you (Ps.138:8). His work is perfect (Deut. 32:4)! Your mercy, O Lord, endures forever; do not forsake the works of Your hands (Ps. 138:8). You, O Lord, are our shield, our glory and the One who lifts up our head (Ps. 3:3). Holy, holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory (Is. 6:3)! In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! From the rising of the sun to its going down the Lord's name is to be praised (Ps. 113:2-3); in Jesus' name we ask (John 16:23) God, our help and our deliverer (Ps. 40:17), to give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the desires of your heart (Ps. 37:4) and fulfill all your purpose (Ps. 20:4).

In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we call upon our Father God and we ask, Oh, that He would bless You and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) indeed, and enlarge your territory, that His Hand would be with you and your people (Ps. 148:14), and that He would keep you and your family (Acts 13:26) from evil, that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may not cause pain! May the Lord bless you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) indeed!

> Prayer of Jabez 1 Chr. 4:10

Let the Lord increase your greatness, and comfort you on every side (Ps. 71:21). May the Lord give you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) increase more and more, you and your children. May you be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 115:14-15). For unto us a Child is born, unto us a Son is given; and the government will be upon His shoulder. And His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, and Prince of Peace. Of the increase of His government and peace there will be no end (Is. 9:6-7). Our Lord, the Lord of hosts, is a crown of glory and a diadem of beauty (Is. 28:5). You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall blossom abundantly and rejoice, even with joy and singing when you see the glory of the Lord, the excellency of our God (Is. 35:2). Every valley shall be made straight, and the rough places smooth; the glory of the Lord shall be revealed (to you), and all flesh, you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall see it together; for the mouth of the Lord has spoken (Is. 40:4-5). You and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun (Is. 59:19). The Lord will be to you an everlasting light, and our God your glory (Is. 60:19).

As a disciple of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 8:31), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5)

by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our <u>Lord Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, God's Holy Servant (Acts 4:27), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is the crown of glory in the hand of God (Is. 62:3), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek You. Let us sing praises to the Lord, who dwells in Zion! Declare His deeds among the people (Ps. 9:10-11).

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
