A Prayer for the Children of Israel Walk with the Lord



To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of **Jesus Christ** (Philp. 2:10) we

speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children Israel. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that Christ might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so

that Our Children (is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (is. 5:24). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ* of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43). Peace to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26), and love with faith, from God the Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ*. Grace be with all those who love our *Lord Jesus Christ* in sincerity (Eph. 6:23-24)!

Lord, who may abide in Your tabernacle? Who may dwell in Your holy hill? He who walks uprightly, and works righteousness, and speaks the truth in their heart (Ps. 15:1-2). As a fellow worker in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we lift up Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with Our Children (Is. 61:9) (1 Thess. 5:28). Blessed be the Lord, because He hears the voice of our supplications (Ps. 28:6)! In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of Christ (1 Pet. 1:19), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will ponder the path of their feet, and let all their ways be established. They shall not turn to the right or the left; let Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) remove their feet from evil (Prov. 4:26-27). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) walk in the light of the Lord (ls. 2:5) as children of light (Eph. 5:8), as <u>Jesus</u> is in the light (1 John 1:7); and living light will flood their path (John 8:12). Let them and all their loved ones receive Christ Jesus the Lord, and walk in Him, rooted and built up in Him, and established in the faith (Col. 2:6-7). According to the measure of Christ's gift (Eph. 4:7), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that He who treads the high places of the earth, the Lord God of hosts is His name (Amos 4:13), will put His Spirit within Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) and cause them and their people (Ps. 148:14) to walk in His statutes, keep His judgments and do them (Ezek. 36:27). Let them make one sound to be heard in praising and thanking the Lord: for He is good, for His mercy endures forever (2 Chr. 5:13)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), a quickening spirit (1 Cor.15:45), may the God of all grace (1 Pet. 5:10) create in Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family member's (Acts 13:26) clean hearts and renew steadfast spirits within them and their people (Ps. 148:14) (Ps. 51:10). According to the multitude of His tender mercies (Ps. 51:1) may the Lord their God give to Our Children (Is. 61:9) one heart, and put a new Spirit within them, and take the stony heart out of their flesh, and give them and their people (Ps. 148:14) a heart of flesh (Ezek. 11:19). Let them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) walk by faith (2 Cor. 5:7) in newness of life (Rom. 6:4); and not walk in craftiness nor handle the word of God deceitfully, but by manifestation of the truth (2 Cor. 4:2). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) will walk before God in truth (2 John 1:4), with all their heart and with all their soul (1 Kin. 2:4). Surely goodness and mercy shall follow them all the days of their life (Ps. 23:6). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the true Light (John 1:9), let them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) walk properly, as in the day, not in revelry and drunkenness, not in lewdness and lust, not in strife and envy (Rom. 13:13) but in peace and equity (Mat. 2:6), wisely walking in their integrity (Prov. 28:26), keeping sound wisdom and discretion; so there will be life to their souls and

grace to their necks (Prov. 3:21-22). Let thanksgiving abound to the glory of God (2 Cor. 4:15)! Praise the glory of His grace (Eph. 1:6); to Him be glory forever and ever (Gal. 1:4-5)!

Our Children (Is. 61:9) are washed, they are sanctified, they are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), our advocate with the Father (1 John 2:1), now may the God of patience and comfort (Rom. 15:5) cause Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) to walk by the rivers of waters, in a straight way in which they shall not stumble, for He is a Father to them (Jer. 31:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk safely in their way, and their feet will not stumble (Prov. 3:23). Though Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may walk in the midst of trouble (Ps. 138:7), we ask in the name of Jesus *Christ* (John 16:23), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), that God will revive Our Children (Is. 61:9); He will stretch out His hand against the wrath of their enemies, with His right hand He will save them (Ps. 138:7). He will show them and their people (Ps. 148:14) the path of life; in His presence they will receive the fullness of joy; at His right hand they will receive pleasures forevermore (Ps. 16:11). He has given them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the shield of His salvation; His right hand shall hold them up, His gentleness shall make them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) great (Ps. 18:35). May God, our faithful God (Deut. 7:9), enlarge their path so that their feet will not slip (2 sam. 22:36-37). When the Chief Shepherd appears, Our Children (Is. 61:9) will receive the crown of glory that does not fade away (1 Pet. 5:4). Now to our God and Father be glory forever and ever (Phil. 4:20)! For You, O God, are our glory and joy (1 Thess. 2:20)!

Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) cling to His testimonies; and run in the way of His commandments, for He shall enlarge their hearts (Ps. 119:31-32). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), in the name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23), to those who are sanctified in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (1 Cor. 1:2), that the God of gods and the Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome (Deut. 10:17), will give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) understanding (Ps. 119:34), and make them and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk in the path of His commandments (Ps. 119:35), incline their hearts to His testimonies (Ps. 119:36), establish His word to His servants (Our Children (Is. 61:9)) (Ps. 119:38). His word is a lamp to their feet and a light to their path (Ps. 119:105). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who became for them wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), the God of truth, who is without injustice (Deut. 32:4), guards the paths of justice, and preserves the way of His saints (Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family). Our Children

(Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will understand righteousness and justice, equity and every good path (Prov. 2:8-9). For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth comes knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). He is a shield to them and their people (Ps. 148:14). He guards the paths of justice, and preserves their way (Prov. 2:6-9). Let wisdom enter their hearts, knowledge be pleasant to their souls, discretion will preserve them and their people (Ps. 148:14) and deliver them and their family (Acts 13:26) from the way of evil (Prov. 2:10-12). The God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) make their path like the shining sun, that shines ever brighter unto the perfect day (Prov. 4:18). Let the sea roar, and all its fullness; let the field rejoice, and all that is in it. Then the trees of the woods shall rejoice before the Lord, for He is coming to judge the earth. Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever (1 Chr. 16:32-34)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), through whom are all things, and through whom we live (1 Cor. 8:6), may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) walk prudently (Eccl. 5:1), circumspectly (Eph. 5:15), uprightly (Ps. 15:1-2), righteously (Is. 33:15-16), in a perfect way (Ps. 101:6), undefiled in the way (Ps. 119:1), in integrity of heart and in uprightness (1 Kin. 9:4) (Prov. 10:9), walking orderly and keeping the law (Acts 21:24), walking before the Lord (Ps. 116-9), and walking humbly with their God (Mic. 6:8). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk in wisdom toward those who are outside and walk properly and redeem the time (Col. 4:5, 1 Thess. 4:12). God, their God forever and ever; their guide even to death (Ps. 48:14), help Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk within their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with a perfect heart (Ps. 101:2). According to all that the Lord has bestowed on Our Children (Is. 61:9), and the great goodness toward their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), which He has bestowed on them (ls. 63:7), in the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), He is **Christ**, the chosen of God (Luke 23:35), let them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam, 6:21) walk before God and be blameless (Gen. 17:1), finding grace in His sight (Ex. 33:13), walking in His ways (Ps. 128:1) on the Highway of Holiness (ls. 35:8), being holy in all of their conduct (1 Pet. 1:15), and keeping away from the paths of the destroyer (Ps. 17:4). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will not walk according to the flesh but according to the Spirit (Rom. 8:1). Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever (1 Tim. 1:17)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), their high tower (Ps. 144:2), may the Lord keep Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in His Presence (Ps. 140:13), their entire family walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31), walking righteously (ls. 33:15). O righteous Father (John 17:25), according to the gift of the grace of God (Eph. 3:7), let Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) live in the spirit, walk in the Spirit (Gal. 5:25) and bear the fruits of the Spirit, which is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Gal. 5:22-23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that the love of God be perfected in them (1 John 2:5) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) walk in love (Eph. 5:2), and unity, of the same rule, of the same mind (Phil. 3:16), having fellowship (1 John 1:7) with wise men and women (Prov. 13:20), and walking worthy of God who calls them into His own kingdom and glory (1 Thess. 2:12). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), a sure foundation (ls. 28:16), may the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10) direct their steps (Jer. 10:23) and as the Lord has called Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), so let them walk (1 Cor. 7:17). Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy; giving thanks to the Father who has gualified them and their people (Ps. 148:14) to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light (Col. 1:10-12). Arise; shine; for their light has come! The glory of the Lord is risen upon Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Is. 60:1). Your mercy, O Lord, is in the heavens, and Your faithfulness reaches to the clouds. Your righteousness is like the great mountains; Your judgments are a great deep; O Lord, You preserve man and beast. How precious is Your loving kindness, O God! Therefore, Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall put their trust under the shadow of Your wings. They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house, and You give them drink from the river of Your pleasures. For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light they see light. Oh, continue Your loving kindness to those who know You, and Your righteousness to the upright in heart (Ps. 36:5-10)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), in whom new creation avails (Gal. 6:15), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) God, our God forever and ever (Ps. 48:14), who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him (Dan. 9:4), will instruct Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children and all of their family (Acts 13:26) and teach them in the way they should go; He will guide them and their family (Acts 13:26) with His eye (Ps. 32:8), directing their every step (Prov. 16:9). May the Lord God teach them and their people (Ps. 148:14) in the way of wisdom and lead them in right paths (Prov. 4:11). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) take firm hold of His instruction and do not let go (Prov. 4:13). May they and their people (Ps. 148:14) follow Jesus, and not walk in darkness, but have the light of life (John 8:12). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord will lead Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) in His righteousness, make their way straight (Ps. 5:7-8), lead them and their people (Ps. 148:14) in a smooth path (Ps. 27:11), arm them and their people (Ps. 148:14) with strength and make their way perfect (Ps. 18:32), and make the darkness light before them and their family (Acts 13:26) and the crooked places straight (Is. 42:16-16), and make a road in the wilderness and rivers in the desert (ls. 43:19). When they and their family (Acts 13:26) walk through the fire, they shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch them. For the Lord, their God, the Holy One of Israel is with them (Is. 43:2-3) and with their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) the Lord the God of recompense (Jer. 51:56) will break the bands of their yoke and make them and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk upright (Lev. 26:13), at liberty (Ps. 119:45). For the Lord God is a sun and shield; the Lord will give grace and glory; no good thing will He withhold from those who walk uprightly. O Lord of hosts, blessed is the man who trusts in You (Ps. 84:12)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the door to salvation (John 10:9), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the God of our salvation (Ps. 18:46) to deliver their souls from death, their eyes from tears, and their feet from falling that they will walk before the Lord in the land of the living (Ps. 116:8-9). Let Him teach Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the good way in which they should walk; and give rain on their land which He has given to them (1 Kin. 8:36) and their family (Acts 13:26). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk in His ways, keep His statutes and His commandments, so that He will lengthen their days (1 Kin. 3:14), prolong their days in the land which they shall possess (Deut. 5:33), and give them rain in its season, and their land shall yield its produce, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit (Lev. 26:3-4). May the Lord guide Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) in justice and teach them His way (Ps. 25:9), for their steps are ordered by the Lord and He delights in their way (Ps. 37:23). May He cause them and their family (Acts 13:26) to hear His loving kindness in the morning; and cause them to know the way in which they should walk (Ps. 143:8). Let God teach them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to do His will; lead Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) in the land of uprightness (Ps. 143:10), bring their souls out of trouble (Ps. 6:3-4, 32:7) and preserve their way

(Prov. 2:8) so they and their people (Ps. 148:14) may walk in the way of goodness, and keep to the paths of righteousness (Prov. 2:20). Let them greatly rejoice in the Lord, their souls shall be joyful in our God (Is. 61:10). Let them enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him; and bless His name (Ps. 100:4)!

As a chosen vessel of *Jesus Christ* (Acts 9;15), to bear His name, we pray (James 5:16), in the name of *Jesus* (John 16:23), King of the saints (Rev. 15:3), when Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk, their steps will not be hindered, and when they run, they will not stumble (Prov. 4:12) for they shall run and not weary, and they shall walk and not faint (Is. 40:31). For God is great, and He does wondrous things; He alone is God. Let Him teach Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) His way, that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will walk in His truth (Ps. 86:10-11); may the Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abounding in goodness and truth (Ex. 34:6) unite their hearts to fear His glorious and awesome name (Deut. 28:58, Ps. 86:11). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) Praise the Lord God, with all their hearts, and glorify His name forevermore! For great is His mercy toward them (Ps. 86:11-13) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21)!

As a fellow worker in *Christ*, in the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), He who searches the minds and hearts (Rev. 2:23), in His glorious and awesome name (Deut. 28:58) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will commit their way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth their righteousness as the light, and their justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:5-6). May the Lord send His angel with Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to prosper their way (Gen. 24:40). May the angel of God go before them and their people (Ps. 148:14), to keep them in the way and to bring them into the place which God has prepared for them (Ex. 23:20). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will walk worthy of the calling with which they are called, with all lowliness and gentleness, with longsuffering, bearing with one another in love, endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (Eph. 4:1-3). May God raise Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) up for Himself as faithful priests who shall do according to what is in His heart and in His mind. May the Lord build Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) a sure house, and may they and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk before Him anointed forever (1 sam. 2:35). For Our Children (ls. 61:9) are His workmanship, created in *Christ Jesus* for good works, which He prepared beforehand that they should walk in them (Eph. 2:10). May Our Children (Is. 61:9)

and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) walk before Him forever (1 Sam. 2:30). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) not defile their garments; and they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall walk with Him in white, for they are worthy (Rev. 3:4). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will rejoice and put their trust in God; let them and their people (Ps. 148:14) ever shout for joy (Ps. 5:11)! Blessed are Our Children (Is. 61:9)!. May they know the joyful sound for they walk in the light of His countenance. In His name they rejoice and in His righteousness they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are exalted. For He is the glory of their strength, and in His favor their horn is exalted. Their shield belongs to the Lord, the Holy One of Israel (Ps. 89:15-18). Lord God of Israel, there is no God in heaven above or on earth below like You, who keep Your covenant and mercy with Your servants who walk before You with all their hearts (1 Kin. 8:23). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we thank you Father (1 Thess. 5:18), that Your word does not return to you void but it shall accomplish what You please, and it shall prosper in the thing for which You send it (Is. 55:11).

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord* Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and

by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in Christ (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that **Christ** might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and *Christ* will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In Christ (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield belongs to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), a sure foundation (Is. 28:16) we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, to bear His name (Acts 9:15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty Psalms 89:34. God is watching over His word to perform it **Jerimiah. 1:12** and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it Isaiah 55:11. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word Joel 2:11! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms. 33:1.** It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls **Joel 2:32**. "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi. 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! For all people walk each in the name of their god, but we will walk in the name of the *Lord Jesus Christ* our God, the God Most-High, God, forever and ever (Mic. 4:5). Amen!

By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
