A Prayer for the Children of the Nations Parenting

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of **Jesus Christ** (Philp. 2:10) we

speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children of the Nations. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of <u>Christ</u> (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that **Christ** might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the

wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a guiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that **Christ**, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

Mercy surround Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 32:10) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21)! Let them be glad in the Lord and rejoice, for they are righteous; let them shout for joy, all who are upright in heart! They trust in the Lord, and mercy surrounds Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 32:10-11) and their family (Acts 13:26). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ of Nazareth</u> (John 14:13,16:23), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a

lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), according to His loving kindness (Ps. 51:1) may our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) make Our Children (Is. 61:9) a parent after His own heart (Acts 13:22): merciful (Luke 6:36), faithful (Duet. 7:9), loving, kind (Jer. 31:3), good (Mic. 6:8) and just (Ps. 7:9). Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 sam, 6:21) shall be ever merciful and lend and their descendants shall be blessed (Ps. 37:26). They shall dwell in prosperity, and their descendants shall inherit the earth (Ps. 25:13). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 14:13,16:23), the chief cornerstone (Luke 20:17), may Our Children (Is. 61:9) leave an inheritance to their children's children (Prov. 13:22) rich in the fullness of God, grounded and rooted in the love (Eph. 3: 17,19) and the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 4:6), and both the wisdom and knowledge of God (Rom. 11:33). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) show forth His praise to all generations (Ps. 79:13), the remembrance of His name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Your name, O Lord, endures forever, Your fame, O Lord, throughout all generations (Ps. 135:13)! In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord will be their dwelling place for all generations (Ps. 90:1). O Lord, great and awesome God, who keeps His covenant and mercy with those who love Him (Dan. 9:4), make Our Children (Is. 61:9) an eternal excellence, a joy of many generations (ls. 60:15). So that men will say, "Surely there is a reward for the righteous; surely He is God who judges in the earth" (Ps. 58:11). For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! The Lord be magnified (Ps. 40:16)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), the true Light which gives light to every man who comes into the world (John 1:9), in <u>Christ</u> (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will walk in their integrity; and their children shall be blessed after them (Prov. 20:7). In <u>Christ</u> (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will walk in <u>Christ</u>, rooted and built up in Him and established in the faith (Col. 2:7). They shall train up their children in the way they should go, and when they are old their children will not depart from it (Prov. 22:6). Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall not labor in vain, nor bring forth children for trouble; for they shall be the descendants of the blessed of the Lord, and their offspring with them (Is. 65:23). We pray (James 5:16), in <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 14:13,16::23), that His Spirit who is upon Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and His words which He has put in their mouth, shall not depart from their mouth, nor from the mouth of their descendants, nor from the mouth of their descendants' descendants from this time forevermore (Is. 59:21). God, their refuge and strength (Ps. 46:1), help Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26)

lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word; that they and their children be doers of the word, and not hearers only (James 1:21-22). May the Lord Jesus Christ Himself, and his God and Father (Phil. 4:20), establish Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:16-17). May light so shine before our children, that their children will see their good works and glorify our Father in heaven (Matt. 5:16). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) be an example to their children in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity (1 Tim. 4:12), clothing themselves with compassion, tender heartiness, kindness, lowliness, meekness, humility, gentleness and patience (Col. 3:12). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) be kind, loving, patient, good, gentle, faithful, meek, humble (Gal. 5:22-23), tenderhearted, forgiving (Eph. 4:32) possessing selfcontrol (Gal. 5:22-23); giving wonderful counsel and excellent guidance (Is. 28:29); sure and steadfast (Ps. 51:10, Ps. 57:7), using the rod of authority (Ps. 89:32) to correct (Prov. 3:11-12) and to protect their offspring (Esth. 8:11); leading their family (Acts 13:26) down the path of righteousness and justice (Prov. 2:9), the Highway of Holiness (Is. 35:8), into the salvation of the Lord (Lam. 3:26). Sing to the Lord, all the earth; proclaim the good news of His salvation from day to day. Declare His glory among the nations, His wonders among all generations. For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:23-25)!

May the Lord our God be in the midst of their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Duet. 23:14) and may their marriage be holy (Duet. 23:14), producing godly offspring (Mal. 2:15). Their children shall be like olive plants all around their table thus shall they be blessed (Ps. 128:3-4). Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall provide for their own, those of their house (1 Tim. 5:8) and their nation (Math. 21:43). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall abound in grace (2 Cor. 9:8) to be a good providers (1 Tim. 5:8), providing spiritual guidance by training up their children in the way they should go (Prov. 22:6), as well as providing material comforts (1 Tim. 5:8). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will prosper in all things, have good health, as their souls prosper (3 John 2). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) love and delight in their children, correcting them (Prov. 3:12, Prov. 29:17), disciplining them promptly (Prov. 13:24); turning them away from all iniquity (Mal. 2:6) in love, patience, and self control (Gal. 5:22-23); and their children shall give delight to their soul (Prov. 29:17). The Lord, our God, He exercises loving kindness, judgment, and righteousness in the earth (Jer. 9:24). You, Lord, in the beginning laid the foundation of the earth, and the heavens are the work of Your hands; they will perish, but

You remain; and they will all grow old like a garment; like a cloak You will fold them up, and they will be changed. But You are the same, and Your years will not fail (Heb. 1:10-12). Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; a scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your Kingdom (Heb. 1:8). For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! Let God be magnified (Ps. 70:4)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), the author and finisher of our faith (Heb. 12:2), may Our Children (Is. 61:9) teach their children the word of the Lord (Lev. 10:11); they shall not hide the Word from their children, but tell the Word to generations to come, the praises of the Lord, and His strength and His wonderful works (Ps. 78:4), so that their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) may set their hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep His commandments (Ps. 78:7). They shall make known His faithfulness to all generations (Ps. 89:1). They shall teach their children to walk in truth (2 John 1:4), and in fear of the Lord (Acts 9:31), to walk in *Christ*, rooted and built up in Him and established in faith (Col. 2:7), to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk humbly with God (Mic. 6:8), to choose their friends carefully (Prov. 12:26), and to flee from sexual immorality (1 Cor. 6:18), allowing the Holy Spirit to direct their steps (Jer. 10:23, Ps. 119:133); their steps being ordered by the Lord (Ps. 37:23), that they may walk in the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31) and manifest the fruits of the Spirit: walking in love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control (Gal. 5:22). Let no one despise their youth for their children shall be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith and in purity (1 Tim. 4:12). They shall exhort their children to be sober-minded, in all things showing themselves to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, sound speech that cannot be condemned, that their opponents may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of them (Titus 2:6-8). All who see them shall acknowledge them, that they are the posterity whom the Lord has blessed (ls. 61:9). Now may the God of peace who brought up our Lord Jesus from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) complete in every good work to do His will, working in them what is well pleasing in His sight, through *Jesus Christ*, to whom be glory forever and ever (Heb. 13:20-21). For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 chr. 16:25)! Oh, give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever (1 Chr. 16:34)

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), by the grace of God (1 Cor. 15:10), Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall instill confidence in their children (Prov. 14:26), teaching their children to trust in the Lord (Ps. 118:8), for the Lord will be their confidence (Prov. 3:26); they can do all things through *Christ* who strengthens them (Phil. 4:13); also stirring up love and good works in them, exhorting them (Heb. 10:24-25), always encouraging them (Acts 11:23), strengthening them (Acts 14:22), and protecting them (Est. 8:11,9:16, Mark 6:20). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will shepherd their children according to the integrity of their heart and guide them by the skillfulness of their hands (Ps. 78:72). God grant (1 Sam. 1:17), Our Children (Is. 61:9), that their guidance (Prov. 11:3) be steadfast and sure, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that their labor is not in vain (1 Cor. 15:58). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) choose life and blessing, that both Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) may live (Duet 30:19); and Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall make known to their children the ways of life, that they will be filled with joy in the presence of the Lord (Acts 2:28). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) be trustworthy (1 Cor. 7:25), faithful (Acts 16:15), a dependable parent bringing health to their children (Prov. 13:17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) will never hide themselves from their own flesh (ls. 58:7), but always be there to uphold their children, seeing that no one renders evil for evil to anyone, but always pursue what is good both for themselves and their children (1 Thess. 5:14-15). Our hope in His mercy (Ps. 33:18) is that their children will be secure in the love of their parents (1 John 4:18), knowing the fervent love their parents have for them, for love covers a multitude of sins (1 Pet. 4:8). God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) grant (1 sam. 1:17) that Our Children (ls. 61:9) are not only parent and child, but also best friends, bearing with one another in love (Eph. 4:2), endeavoring to keep the unity of the Spirit in the bond of peace (Eph. 4:3), pursuing the things which make for peace and the things by which one might edify the other (Rom. 14:19), like-minded toward one another (Rom. 15:5), exhorting one another (Heb. 10:25), and walking together in agreement (Amos 3:3); that they and their family (Acts 13:26) may with one mind and one mouth glorify the God and Father of OUR Lord Jesus Christ (Rom. 15:6). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that their children are never afraid to confide the secrets of their heart to them for there is no fear in love (1 John 4:18); and that they treat their children with respect, compassion, dealing with them with kindness, gentleness, patience and tender mercies (Col. 3:12), and with a meek and humble heart (Ps. 10:17), never provoking their children to wrath, but bringing them up in the training and admonition of the Lord (Eph. 6:4). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their spouse

and their children be joined together in a bond of love and mutual respect; their hearts being encouraged, being knit together in love with God the Father, <u>Christ the Son</u> and the Holy Ghost (Col. 2:2). And may the Lord make Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) increase and abound in love to one another (1 Thess. 3:12:13). For behold, the darkness shall cover the earth, and deep darkness the people; but the Lord will arise over Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26), and His glory will be seen upon them and their children (Is. 60:2). For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:23-25)! Blessed be the Lord God from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:36)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), Lord of all (Acts 10:36), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father of Righteousness (Prov. 23:24), the God of the spirits of all flesh (Num. 16:22), that their children be wise (Prov. 23:24) and give delight to their soul (Prov. 29:17), that Our Children (Is. 61:9) be ever thankful, always remembering that their children are a blessing from God, a heritage from the Lord (Ps. 127:3). All their children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of their children (Is. 54:13). The Lord shall teach them to profit, and lead them by the way they should go (Is. 48:17). Their descendants shall cry to the Lord: "My Father, You are the guide of my youth" (Jer. 3:4). For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! Now, therefore, our God, we give thanks and praise Your glorious name (1 Chr. 29:13)!

In *Jesus'* name, the Branch of the Lord, beautiful and glorious (Is. 4:2), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we petition God, whose faithfulness has been established in the heavens (Ps. 89:2), to grant that their children be to them a restorer of life and a nourisher of their old age (Ruth. 4:15). Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall rejoice in their children's righteousness and delight in their wisdom (Prov. 23:24). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), will turn the hearts of the parents to the children, and the hearts of the children to their parents (Mal. 4:6). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) be the glory of their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) and may their children be the crown of their old age (Prov. 17:6). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and all their descendants after them shall fear the Lord! They who fear the Lord, praise Him! Let all their descendants glorify Him, and all their offspring fear Him (Ps. 22:23)! For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) commemorate, thank, and praise the Lord their God (1 Chr. 16:4)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John14"13,16:23), Everlasting Father (Is. 9:6), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (ls. 61:9) shall rule their own house well, having their children in submission with all reverence (1 Tim. 3:4) and their children shall honor their father and mother (Ex. 20:12). According to His riches in glory by Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:19) may God give to Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) one heart and one way, that they and their family (Acts 13:26) may fear the Lord forever, for the good of themselves and their children after them (Jer. 32:39). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) teach their children and their grandchildren to fear the Lord (Deut. 4:9-10), so that they may drink of the fountain of life and turn away from the snares of death (Prov. 14:27). According to all that the Lord has bestowed on Our Children (Is. 61:9), and the great goodness toward their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21), which He has bestowed on Our Children (ls. 61:9) according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (Is. 63:7), may God, our King from of old (Ps. 74:12), cause their children to walk by the rivers of waters, in a straight way in which they shall not stumble (Jer. 31:9), that they may be called trees of righteousness, the planting of the Lord, that He may be glorified in them (ls. 61:3). May Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their children after them receive the kingdom which cannot be shaken, let them and their children have grace, by which they may serve God acceptable with reverence and godly fear (Heb. 12:28), in sincerity and in truth (Josh. 24:14), with strong confidence; and being God's children they and their family (Acts 13:26) will have a place of refuge (Prov. 14:26). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that together they and their family (Acts 13:26) will ward off all evil (Gen. 48:16), being supportive of each other, helping each other, lifting each other up when they fall (Eccl. 4:9-10), abiding in Jesus Christ and Him in them (John 15:5) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Let us sing of Your power (Ps. 59:16-17), Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10); Yes, we will sing aloud of Your mercy in the morning; for You have been our defense and refuge in the day of our trouble. To You, O our Strength, we will sing praises; for God is our defense, the God of our mercy (Ps. 59:16-17). For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! May our children's sons and their daughters be blessed, they shall do great things and also still prevail (1 Sam. 26:25). Let it please God, He who raised Jesus from the dead (Rom. 8:11), to bless the house of His Servant, that it may continue forever before Him (2 sam. 7:29); and with the blessing of God Almighty, El Shaddai (Gen. 17:1), let their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) be blessed forever (2 Sam. 7:29)! Blessed are

Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children of the Lord (Ruth 3:10); they are blessed in the name of the Lord of Host (2 sam. 6:18)! Praise the Lord (1 Chr. 23:30)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), according to His loving kindness, according to the multitude of His tender mercies, may God blot out their transgressions (Ps. 51:1), reveal and correct any errors Our Children (ls. 61:9) have made (Neh. 13:22), and heal any wounds their children have received (Jer. 30:17). Our children and their children shall not bear the guilt of their parents, nor do they bear the guilt of their children. The righteousness of the righteous shall be upon himself, and the wickedness of the wicked shall be upon himself (Ezek. 18:20). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that if Our Children (Is. 61:9) or their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) should backslide, the Lord will see their ways and heal them; and He will also lead them, and restore comforts to them and their family (Acts 13:26) and all of their descendant (ls. 57:18), whether they be far off or near, from one end of the earth to the other end of the earth (Deut. 13:7). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16::23) and by His blood we revoke and wash our children and our children's children clean (Rev. 1:5), of any curses (James 3:10) that have been spoken over them (Matt. 12:37), either intentionally or unintentionally, for no man can tame the tongue (James 3:8-9). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16::23), the Prince of Life (Acts 3:15), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Great God, mighty and awesome (Deut. 1:17) not to let Our Children (ls. 61:9) or any of their descendant pass through the fire to Molech, nor shall they profane the name of our God (Lev. 18:21). May their children keep their father's command, and not forsake the law of their mother (Prov. 6:20). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children hear the instruction of the Father's good doctrine and give attention to know understanding (Prov. 4:1) and may their hearts retain His words (Prov. 4:4). In the name of <u>Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), who is the brightness of God's glory and the express image of His person (Heb. 1:3), may the Lord reveal the Father's love to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Prov. 11:21), that they may be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and the depth and the height to know the love of *Christ* which passes knowledge (Eph. 3: 17-19); and Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their children, and their children's children (Prov. 11:21), shall be near to the Lord (Gen 45:10). Let them bow their knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, for whom the whole family in heaven (Prov. 11:21) and earth is named (Eph. 3:14-15). For as the new heavens and the new earth which God will make shall remain before Him, so shall their descendants and their name remain (ls. 66:22). Our children and their descendants

(Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) shall love, obey, and know the Lord for He shall manifest Himself to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (John 14:21) and their children (Prov. 11:21); and they and their children after them will be His friend forever (John 15:15). He only is our rock and our salvation; He is our defense; Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) shall not be moved! In God is our salvation and our glory; the rock of our strength, and our refuge, is in God (Ps. 62:6-7)! For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! In that day the Lord magnify Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) in front of all (Josh. 4:14)! He, a consuming fire, even a jealous God (Deut. 4:24), has increased Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26); He has expanded their borders (Is. 26:15). The Lord be glorified (Is. 66:5)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), the Shepherd and Overseer of our souls (1 Pet. 2:25), according to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7) the Lord establish His covenant between Our Children (Is. 61:9) and Himself and their descendants after them in their generations, for an everlasting covenant, to be God to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and to their descendants after them (Gen. 17:7). God, He who blots out their transgressions for His own sake (Is. 43:25), looks on them and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) favorably and makes them fruitful, multiplies them and confirms His covenant with them (Lev. 26:9). And it shall be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants after them a covenant of an everlasting priesthood (Num. 25:13), a covenant of salt forever before the Lord with them and their descendants (Num. 18:19). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) keep His covenant, they and their descendants after them throughout their generations (Gen. 17:10). May the Lord God circumcise their heart (Rom. 2:28:29, Col. 2:11) and the hearts of their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), to love the Lord their God with all their heart and with all their soul and with all their mind (Matt. 22:37), that they may live and receive the blessing of Abraham, they and their descendants with them, that they may inherit the land in which they are a stranger (Gen. 28:4). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) after them remember His covenant always, the Word which He commanded, for a thousand generations (1 chr. 16:15). For God is a faithful God who keeps covenant and mercy for a thousand generations with those who love Him (Deut. 7:9). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord will pour His Spirit on their descendants and His blessing on their offspring (ls. 44:3). May their children (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) continue in the faith (Acts 14:22), and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) be established in truth (2 Pet. 1:12), rooted and built

up in the Lord (Col. 2:7); their descendants shall be justified and shall glory in God (Is. 45:25). Their descendants will be mighty on earth, and they will be blessed (Ps. 112:2); they shall expand to the right and to the left (Is. 54:3), they shall be thousands of ten thousand's (Gen. 24:60); and their descendants will inherit the nations, and make the desolate cities inhabited (Is. 54:3). They shall dwell in prosperity and their descendants shall inherit the earth (Ps. 25:13) and possess the gates of those who hate them (Gen. 24:60). Their peace will be like a river, and their righteousness like the waves of the sea (Is. 48:18). The righteous shall be glad in the Lord, and trust in Him. And all the upright in heart shall glory (Ps. 64:10)! For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! We declare His praise, for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) are of His people (Is. 43:21)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), the true Light (John 1:9), may Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) fear the Lord as long as the sun and the moon endures, throughout all generations (Ps. 72:5), and God's mercy be from everlasting to everlasting, and His righteousness will be forever (Ps. 103:17); His salvation (Is. 51:8), His everlasting kingdom, His dominion (Dan. 4:3), and His throne (Lam. 5:19) from generation to generation. Let the Lord reign in their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to all generations (Ps. 146:10). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16::23), appointed heir of all things (Heb. 1:2), may the Lord give to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the increase, them and their children. May they be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 115:14-15). May the Lord perfect that which concerns Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); Your mercy, O Lord, endures forever; do not forsake the works of Your hands (Ps. 138-8). Forever, Lord, Your word is settled in heaven (Ps. 119:89). Your unfailing love continues forever, and Your faithfulness endures to each generation, You established the earth, and it abides (Ps. 119:90)! For the Lord is great and greatly to be praised (1 Chr. 16:25)! We will bless the Lord from this time forth and forevermore! Praise the Lord (Ps. 115:18)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God

(Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord* Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in Christ (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that Christ might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and *Christ* will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In *Christ* (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God

and Father of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield *belongs* to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29), whose sandal strap we are not worthy to loose (John 1:27), we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ, to bear His name (Acts 9;15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty **Psalms 89:34**. God is watching over His word to perform it **Jerimiah**. 1:12 and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it **Isaiah 55:11**. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word **Joel 2:11**! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms. 33:1.** It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls **Joel 2:32**. "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi. 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory

and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In <u>Jesus</u>' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)!

We will rejoice in our salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners! May the Lord fulfill all our petitions (Ps. 20:5)! By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
