A Prayer for the Children of the Nations Future and Hope

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Philp. 2:10) we

speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children of the Nations. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that *Christ* might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in

all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ*, through us speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

Do not abhor Our Children (Is. 61:9), for Your name's sake; do not disgrace the throne of Your glory. Remember, do not break Your covenant with Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Jer. 14:21). You are their God; hear the voice of our supplications, O Lord (Ps. 140:6). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23, John 14:12) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), the Shepherd and Overseer of our souls (1 Pet. 2:25), may the God of hope (Rom. 15:13) give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), a future of peace (Ps. 37:37). According to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which is

according to godliness, in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began, to Our Children (Is. 61:9)): Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ our Savior (Titus 1:1-4). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the living bread which came down from heaven (John 6:41,51), may God fill Our Children (Is. 61:9) with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that they and their family (Acts 13:26) may have a walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God (Col. 1:9-10), sharing; in the inheritance of the saints in the light (Col. 1:12). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers (col. 1:16); in His mighty name God grant Our Children (ls. 61:9) to live with leading from the Holy Spirit (1 John 4:13), and not walk in doubt (Matt. 21:21) and fear (Luke 1:74) of what may happen. Let Jesus Christ, the author and finisher of their faith (Heb. 12:2), keep them from losing their sense of purpose and fill them with hope for their future as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast (Heb. 6:19); being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in them will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ (Phil. 1:6). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the true Light (John 1:9), the Lord grant to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) according to their heart's desire, and fulfill all of their purpose (Ps. 20:4). May the Lord plant Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) firmly in His house and they shall flourish in the courts of their God and He will keep them fresh and flourishing and bearing fruit into old age (Ps. 92:13-14). He will be with them in trouble; He will deliver them and honor them (Ps. 91:15). With long life He will satisfy them and show them His salvation (Ps. 91:6). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that they may dwell in the house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) of the Lord all the days of their lives (Ps. 27:4); enter the Presence behind the veil (Heb. 6:19), and enter into that which God has prepared for those who love Him (1 Cor. 2:9). Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him (1 cor. 2:9). May **Jesus Christ** prepare a place for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) and receive them into Himself; so that where He is, there they and their family (Acts 13:26) may be also (John 14:3). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Jesus Christ will set them on His right hand, blessed by the Father, that they might inherit the kingdom prepared for them from the foundation of the world (Matt. 25:34); the kingdom that cannot be shaken (Heb. 12:28). For Jesus Christ has delivered their souls from death, their eyes from tears, and their feet from falling that they may walk before the

Lord in the land of the living (Ps. 116:8-9). God's abundant mercy has begotten Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) again to a living hope; to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for them, who is kept by the power of God through faith for salvation (1 Pet. 1:3-5). May the genuineness of their faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (1 Pet. 1:7), believing, rejoicing with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of their faith the salvation of their souls (1 Pet. 1:8-9). Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come (Rev 4:8)!

In the name of our great High Priest, who has passed through the heavens, **Jesus** Christ, the son of God (Heb. 4:14), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will ask of God, and He will give them the nations for their inheritance, and the ends of the earth for their possession (Ps. 2:8); cause Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) to hear His loving kindness in the morning, trust in Him; and cause them and their family (Acts 13:26) to know the way they should walk and lift up their souls to Him (Ps. 143:8). May God, whose faithfulness has been established in the heavens (Ps. 89:2), visit them. For He has made them a little lower than the angels, and He has crowned them with glory and honor (Ps. 8:4-5). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will seek the Lord, in the hope that they might grope for Him and find Him (Acts 17:27). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) seek His face (Ps. 27:8), and they and their family (Acts 13:26) shall see His face in righteousness; they shall be satisfied to awake in His likeness (Ps. 17:15). Our Children (Is. 61:9) shall see the Lord always before their face, for He is at their right hand, that they may not be shaken; that their hearts may rejoice, that their tongues be glad; moreover, that their flesh will also rest in hope (Acts 2:25-26). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God will make known to them the ways of life; and make them full of joy in His presence (Acts 2:28). According to His new covenant (Heb. 8:13) the Lord fulfill all their petitions (Ps. 20:5). May He send them help from the sanctuary, and strengthen them (Ps. 20:2) and their people (Ps. 148:14). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) God, the Spirit of Him who raised *Jesus* from the dead (Rom, 8:11), will give to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their heart's desire, and not withhold the request of their lips (Ps. 21:2). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that God, their refuge and strength (Ps. 46:1), to prepare a table before Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) in the presence of their enemies; anoint their heads with oil; and let their cup run over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7,

Prov. 11:21) and their people (Ps. 148:14) all the days of their life; and they shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever (Ps. 23:5-6). According to the multitude of His tender mercies (Ps. 69:16, Lam. 3:32) in Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God's favor will cover Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) for life (Ps. 30:5). Now may the God of hope fill them with all joy and peace in believing, that they may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) purify their souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love with a pure heart, having been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:22-23). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) sanctify the Lord God in their hearts (1 Pet. 3:15) and prepare their hearts for the Lord (1 Sam. 7:3). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will gird up the loin of their minds, be sober, and rest their hope fully upon the grace of God, not conforming themselves to the former lusts, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, living soberly, righteously, and godly (Titus 2:12), being holy in all their conduct. (1 Pet. 1:15), putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation (1 Thess. 5:8); setting their minds on things above, not on the things on the earth (Col. 3:2), bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of Christ (2 Cor. 10:5). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their people (Ps. 148:14) do good, that they and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, storing up for themselves a good foundation for the time to come, that they may lay hold on eternal life (1 Tim. 6:18), receiving the unsearchable riches of *Christ* (Eph. 3:8). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) receive the gift of God which is eternal life in *Christ Jesus* our Lord (Rom. 6:23). Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev 5:12)

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the true vine (John 15:1), in <u>Christ</u> (1 Cor. 1:30) we call upon our Father (Rom. 1:7) and God (Phil. 4:20), and in <u>Christ</u> (, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that He would bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) indeed, and enlarge their territory, that His Hand would be with them, and that He would keep them from evil, that they may not cause pain. May the Lord God bless them indeed (1 Chr. 4:10)! In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), there is no other Rock (Is. 44:8), let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares them, and let them run with endurance the race that is set before them, looking unto **Jesus**, the

author and finisher of their faith (Heb. 12:1-2). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) fight the good fight of faith, laying hold on eternal life (1 Tim. 6:12). Let their future be rooted and grounded in love (Eph. 3:17), filled with joy (Eccl. 2:26), their mouths filled with laughing, and their lips with rejoicing (Job 8:21), their speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt (Col. 4:6). May their future be free of affliction (2 Cor. 4:17); let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their people (Ps. 148:14) stand fast in the liberty by which Christ has set them free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage (Gal. 5:1); nor be lead into temptation (Matt. 6:13), but instead, by the tender mercies of God, be delivered from darkness (Luke 1:78-79), destruction, misery (Rom. 3:16), and death (1 Cor. 15:26); and set free from bondage (Gal. 5:1) and curses (Rev. 22:3); receiving the Spirit of adoption by whom they shall cry "Abba Father" (Rom. 8:15); following Jesus (John 10:4,27); secure in righteousness (Gal. 5:5); sure of the inheritance reserved in heaven for them (1 Pet. 1:4); marked for salvation on their foreheads (Rev. 22:4); and appointed to eternal life (Acts 13:48). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) will walk by faith, not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7); in the light (1 John 1:7) and truth (2 Cor. 4:2), trusting God (Prov. 3:5), being guided by the Holy Spirit (Rev. 2:7, Rev. 2:17, Rev. 3:6), surrounded by kindness (Eph. 2:7) and covered in grace (Eph. 4:7); having redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sin (Col. 1:14); being holy, and blameless and irreproachable in God's sight (Col. 1:22); purified and zealous for good works (Titus 2:14); called to His eternal glory by *Christ Jesus* (1 Pet. 5:10). By the grace of God let Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) be perfected in holiness (1 Pet. 5:10), rooted and build up in *Christ* and established in faith (Col. 2:7), strengthened, and settled (1 Pet. 5;10), grounded and steadfast (Col. 1:23), surrounded by God's favor (Ps. 5:12), walking in authority (Matt. 28:18), and established in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:17), being bold and confident (2 Cor. 10:2, Eph. 3:12), secure in the blood covenant of God Almighty (Heb. 7:22). Let their path drip with abundance (Ps. 65:11). May all God's blessing come upon Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and overtake them (Deut. 28:2) that they shall not lack any good thing (Ps. 34:10). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) prosper in all things and be of good health, as their souls prosper (3 John 2), having a long (Ps. 91:16) fruitful life (Ps. 92:14), being rich in experiences (Rom. 10:12), wise in judgments (John 7:24) and choices (Deut. 30:19), behaving wisely and in a perfect way (Ps. 101:2), filled with wisdom (Luke 2:40,Col. 1:9), not lacking in knowledge (Hos. 4:6), but given understanding (1 John 5:20), that they may know Him who is true: and be in Him who is true,

in His Son <u>Jesus Christ</u> (1 John 5:20), enjoying the fruits of their labor (Eccl. 3:13). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) be diligent until the end (Heb. 6:11), finish the race and receive the prize, an imperishable crown (1 Cor. 9:24-25). May God make Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) an eternal excellence, a joy of many generations (Is. 60:15). So shall their descendants be (Rom. 4:18)! O Father, Lord of heaven and earth (Matt. 11:25) establish Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their seed forever, and build up their throne to all generations (Ps. 89:4). Wealth and riches will be in their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and their righteousness shall endure forever. Unto their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) arise light in the darkness (Ps. 112:4). Their hearts are steadfast, trusting in the Lord. Their hearts are established (Ps. 112:7-8). Surely Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will never be shaken. Our Children (Is. 61:9) will be an everlasting remembrance (Ps. 112:6). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God of all comfort (2 Cor. 1:3) will give Our Children (Is. 61:9) increase more and more, they and their children. May they be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 115:14-15)! Let them be satisfied from above (Prov. 14:14). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we petition God to open to Our Children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) the gates of righteousness; that they may go through them (Ps. 118:19). His faithfulness endures to all generations (Ps. 119:90). Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the lamb, forever and ever (Rev. 5:13)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who is a sure foundation (Is. 28:16), in His name may our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) ears to hear what the Spirit says; so that they and their people (Ps. 148:14) will overcome and eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God (Rev. 2:7). Let them be faithful until death (Rev. 2:10); that **Christ** will be magnified in their bodies, whether by life or death (Phil. 1:20); and in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord God give Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) the crown of life (Rev. 2:10). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9), in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the door to their salvation (John 10:9), that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will overcome and not be hurt by the second death (Rev. 2:11). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) hold fast to His name, and not deny His faith (Rev. 2:13). Let them overcome and receive the hidden manna to eat. May God give Our Children (Is. 61:9) a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except the one who receives it (Rev. 2:17). The Lord knows their works, love, service,

faith, and patience; and as for their works, let the last be more than the first (Rev. 2:19). Our hope is that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) overcome, and keep His works until the end; to them may God give power over the nations (Rev. 2:26), and give to them the morning star (Rev. 2:28). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will not defile their garments; and may they walk with God in white, for they are worthy (Rev. 3:4). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) overcome and be clothed in white garments (Rev 3:5). Our gift from God is eternal life in *Christ Jesus our Lord* (Rom. 6:23), we ask in Jesus' name (John 16:23) that God not blot out their names from the Book of Life; and that **Jesus**, himself, will confess their names before His Father and before His angels (Rev. 3:5). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we petition the Lord, God of their salvation (Ps. 65:5), to set before Our Children (ls. 61:9) an open door, that no one can shut; and give them strength, to keep His word, and not deny His name (Rev 3:8). According to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13), the Lord, who became for Our Children (ls. 61:9) wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), keep them from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole earth (Rev. 3:10). May Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) hold fast to what they have so that no one can take their crown (Rev. 3:11). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord their God will make them a pillar in the temple of God (Rev 3:12). As a vessel of mercy, so that *Christ* might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9), who are the saints of God (Rom. 9:23), we ask that the Lord Jesus will write on them the name of His God and the name of the city of His God, and write on them His new name (Rev 3:11-12). Let the Lord sell to them gold refined in the fire; that they may be rich; and white garments, that they may be clothed, that the shame of their nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint their eyes with eye salve, that they may see (Rev. 3:18). Let Our Children (Is. 61:9) hear His voice and open the door that He will come in to them and dine with them (Rev. 3:20). The Lord grant to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) to sit with Him on His throne, as He also overcame and sat down with His Father on His throne (Rev. 3:20-21). May the Lord leave a door standing open in heaven for them and seal them, as servants of our God, upon their foreheads (Rev. 7:3). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will wash their robes and make themselves white in the blood of the Lamb (Rev. 7:14). Let them overcome (Satan and all of the wicked) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and may they not love their lives to death (Rev. 12:11). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord will make Our Children (Is. 61:9) new (Rev. 21:5) and give to them the fountain of the water of life freely (Rev.

21:6). May the God of their salvation (Ps. 65:5) help Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) overcome that they shall inherit all things (Rev. 21:7). There shall be no more curse (Rev. 22:3), they shall see His face, and His name shall be on their foreheads (Rev. 22:4), for they are called by His name (2 Chr. 7:14). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God will remember them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with the favor He has toward His people; Oh, may the Lord visit Our Children (Is. 61:9) with His salvation (Ps. 106:4), that they may see the benefit of His chosen ones, that they may rejoice in the gladness of His nation, that they may glory with His inheritance (Ps. 106:4-5). To Him who loved them and washed them from their sins in His own blood, and has made them kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6).

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord* Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness. He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in Christ (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might

make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our **Lord Jesus Christ** (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and **Christ** will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In Christ (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield belongs to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars (Rev. 3:1) we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of *Jesus Christ*, to bear His name (Acts 9:15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment—This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty Psalms 89:34. God is watching over His word to perform it Jerimiah. 1:12 and it shall

not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it Isaiah 55:11. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word Joel 2:11! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations Psalms 33:1. It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls Joel 2:32. "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)!

In Your name we rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness we are exalted. For You are the glory of our strength, and in Your favor our horn is exalted. For our shield belongs to the Lord, and we belong to the Holy One of Israel (Ps. 89:16-18)! By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of <u>Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
