A Prayer for Our Children: Peace

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of *Jesus Christ* (Philp. 2:10) we speak words

of life (John 6:63) over the children of the United States of America. Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name, Your kingdom come into the heart of Our children (ls. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). Out of the depths of our heart we have cried to You, O Lord; Lord, hear our voice! Let Your ears be attentive to the voice of our supplications (Ps. 130:1-2). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4) and one with Him (John 17:22), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our children (Is. 61:9), for their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house and for their entire family (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their nation (Math. 21:43), for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that *Christ* might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) and their house, for their entire family (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2); nation (Math. 21:43), for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation (Math. 21:43), and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16), for

these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30),), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ* through us speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our children (Is. 61:9) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), as a fellow worker in <u>Christ Jesus</u> (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our children (Is. 61:9), their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). To Our children (Is. 61:9) and their entire family, their nation (Math. 21:43), the saints and faithful brethren in *Christ:* Grace to them and peace from God our Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ*. We give thanks to the God and Father of our *Lord* Jesus Christ, praying for Our children (Is. 61:9) (Col. 1:2-3); giving thanks because of the hope which is laid up for them in heaven (Col. 1:5). The Lord make His face shine upon them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and be gracious to them (Ps. 148:14); the Lord lift up His countenance upon them, and give them peace. The Lord put His name on Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) and bless them (Num. 6:25-27) and their family (Acts 13:26). Peace be to Our children (Is. 61:9) and all of their people (Ps. 148:14), peace to their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), peace to their nation (Math. 21:43) and peace to all that they have (1 Sam. 25:6), peace on every side and all around them (1 Kin. 4:24) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Peace be within their walls, prosperity within their house (Ps. 122:7) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for God has strengthened the bars of their gates; He has blessed them and their children. He makes peace in their borders (Ps. 147:13-14). Our children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) shall dwell in a peaceful habitation, in secure dwellings, and in quiet resting places (Is. 32:18). The Lord's kindness shall not depart from

Our children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43), nor shall His covenant of peace be removed (Is. 54:10). They shall enter into peace; they shall rest in their beds, each one of them walking in their uprightness (Is. 57:2). The Lord will bring Our children (Is. 61:9) health and healing; He will heal them and reveal to them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) the abundance of peace and truth (Jer. 33:6). It shall come to pass in that day (Is. 10:27) that the Lord of Hosts (Jer. 32:18) shall break Satan's yoke from their neck and burst their bonds (Jer. 30:8); for the chastisement for their peace was upon Him and by His stripes they are healed (Is. 53:5). His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace, of the increase of His peace there will be no end (Is. 9:6-7). Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest (Luke 19:38)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who is great to the ends of the earth (Mic. 5:4), Our children (ls. 61:9) shall dwell in the land that the Lord has given them, their children and their children's children forever. The Lord will make a covenant of peace with Our children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and it shall be an everlasting covenant with them and their family (Acts 13:26); He will establish them and their people (Ps. 148:14) and multiply them, and He will set His sanctuary in their midst forevermore (Ezek. 37:25-27). The Lord will fight for them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and Our children (Is. 61:9) shall hold their peace (Ex. 14:14). He will give peace in their land, and none will make them or their family (Acts 13:26) afraid; He will rid the land of evil beasts, and the sword will not go through their land (Lev. 26:6). He shall give to them His covenant of peace; and it shall be to them and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) a covenant of an everlasting priesthood (Num. 25:12-13). Upon their house there shall be peace forever from the Lord (1 Kin. 2:33). Holy, Holy, Holy is the Lord of hosts; the whole earth is full of His glory (ls. 6:3)! His praise endures forever (Ps. 111:10)! The Lord God is our Father; our Redeemer from Everlasting is His name (Is. 63:16). There is none holy like the Lord, for there is none besides Him, nor is there any rock like our God (1 Sam. 2:2). Blessed be the Lord God of Israel from everlasting to everlasting (1 Chr. 16:36)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), from the rising of the sun, even to its going down, His name shall be great among the nations (Mal. 1:11); therefore, let the peace of God rule in their hearts and be thankful (Col. 3:15). For it pleased the Father that in <u>Jesus</u> all the fullness should dwell, and by Him to reconcile all things to Himself, by Him, whether things on earth or things in heaven, having made peace through the blood of His cross.

And Our children (Is. 61:9) who once was alienated and an enemy in their mind by wicked works, He has reconciled in the body of His flesh through death, to present them holy, and blameless, and irreproachable in His sight (Col. 1:19-22). May Our children (Is. 61:9) continue in the faith, grounded and steadfast (Col. 1:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify Our children (Is. 61:9) completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Thess. 5:23). Let them and their family (Acts 13:26) lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:2). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) will flee youthful lusts; but pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace with those who call on the Lord out of a pure heart (2 Tim. 2:22); that they will pursue peace with all men, and holiness (Heb. 12:14). Grace and peace be multiplied to Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in the knowledge of God and of *Jesus* our Lord. (2 Pet. 1:2).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), for at the name of **Jesus** every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and those on earth, and of those under the earth, and every tongue should confess that **Jesus Christ** is Lord, to the glory of God the Father (Phil. 2:10-11); therefore, in **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) now may the God of hope fill Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) with all joy and peace in believing, that they may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). May Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) acquaint themselves with **Jesus Christ** and be at peace; thereby good will come to them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) receive instruction from God's mouth, and lay up His words in their heart so that they will be built up; they will remove iniquity far from their house (Job 22:21-23) and their nation (Math. 21:43). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will not forget His law, but let their hearts keep His commands; for length of days and long life and peace will be added to them. Let not mercy and truth forsake them; bind them around their neck, write them on the tablet of their heart, so they will find favor and high esteem in the sight of God and man (Prov. 3:1-4). Let them be complete. Be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace will be with them (2 Cor. 13:11). Yes, the Lord will give what is good; and their land will yield its increase. Righteousness will go before Him, and shall make His footsteps their pathway (Ps. 85:12-13). May the Lord make a covenant of peace with Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and

cause wild beasts to cease from the land; and they and their family (Acts 13:26) will dwell safely in the wilderness and sleep in the woods (Ezek. 34:25). Through the tender mercy of our God, with which the Dayspring (the dawn of the morning) from on high visited them; to give light to those who sit in darkness and the shadow of death, to guide their feet into the way of peace (Luke 1:78). In His name, <u>Jesus Christ</u>, in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that the God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) make Our children (Is. 61:9) and the places all around them (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) a blessing; may He cause showers to come down in their season; there shall be showers of blessing (Ezek. 34:26). Their land shall be quiet, and peaceful, for the Lord will give peace and quietness, rest from all their enemies all around (1 Chr. 22:9). The God of peace (Rom. 16:20), the Great, the Mighty God, whose name is the Lord of Hosts (Jer. 32:18), will crush Satan under their feet (Rom. 16:20). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) will wait on the Lord, and keep His way, and He shall exalt them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to inherit the land (Ps. 37:34) and Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace (Ps. 37:11). They shall know that their house and their nation (Math. 21:43) is in peace; and also that their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) shall be many, and their offspring like the grass of the earth. They shall come to the grave at a full age, as a sheaf of grain ripens in its season (Job 5:24-26). Our children (Is. 61:9) shall be gathered to their grave in peace and their eyes shall not see all the calamity of the earth (2 Kin. 22:20). The Lord will deliver Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) from this present evil age (Gal. 1:4). Our children (Is. 61:9) shall flourish like a palm tree, they shall grow like a cedar in Lebanon. For Our children (ls. 61:9) are planted in the house of the Lord and they shall flourish in the courts of their God. Our children (ls. 61:9) shall still bear fruit in old age; they shall be fresh and flourishing, to declare that the Lord is upright; he is their rock, and there is no unrighteousness in Him (Ps. 92:12-15). Our children (Is. 61:9) shall go to the Father in peace; they shall be buried at a good old age (Gen. 15:15). Now the God of peace be with them (Rom. 15:33) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). Surely, the Lord their God has shown Our children (Is. 61:9) His glory and His greatness (Deut. 5:24)! He raises the poor from the dust and lifts the beggar from the ash heap, to set them among princes and make them inherit the throne of glory. For the pillars of the earth are the Lord's, and He has set the world upon them (1 Sam. 2:8).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), according to the Way (Acts 24:14), the Lord has redeemed their soul in peace from the battle which was against them (Ps. 55:18). He

has lovingly delivered their soul from the pit of corruption, for He has cast all their sins behind His back (Is. 38:17) and Our children (Is. 61:9) are a new creation (2 Cor. 5:17). Having been justified by faith, they have peace with God through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (Rom. 5:1). Let them take hold of His strength, that Our children (Is. 61:9) shall make peace with God. May they all come to the *Lord Jesus* and He shall cause them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to take root; they shall blossom and bud, and fill the face of the world with fruit (Is. 27:5-6). May Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) elect according to the foreknowledge of God the Father, in sanctification of the Spirit, for obedience and sprinkling of the blood of *Jesus Christ*: Grace to Our children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and peace be multiplied (1 Pet. 1:2)! Both riches and honor come from You, O God, and You reign over all! In Your hand is power and might; in Your hand it is to make great and to give strength to all! Now therefore, our God, we thank You and praise Your glorious name (1 Chr. 29:12-13)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), in Him all things exist (Col. 1:17), therefore let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) receive the wisdom that is from above which is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. May the fruit of righteousness be sown in peace by them (James 3:17-18) and their nation (Math. 21:43). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) be a person of understanding (Prov. 11:12), counselor of peace, with joy (Prov. 12:20) and gladness in their heart (Ps. 4:7), being among the peaceable and the faithful (2 Sam. 20:19) loving truth and peace (Zech. 8:19), a peacemaker (Matt. 5:9). May the God of peace who brought up our **Lord Jesus** from the dead, that great Shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, make them complete in every good work to do His will, working in them and their nation (Math. 21:43) what is well pleasing in His sight, through **Jesus Christ**, to whom be glory forever and ever (Heb. 13:20-21). Glory, honor, and peace to Our children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43), everyone who works what is good (Rom. 2:10). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that they and their nation (Math. 21:43) will not guarrel but be gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition to God (2 Tim. 2:24-25), subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one, to be peaceable, gentle, showing all humility to all men (Titus 3:1-2). May the Lord God establish peace for them, for He has also done all their works in them (Is. 26:12). In **Jesus** Our children (Is. 61:9) shall have peace. In the world they will have tribulations; but they shall be of good cheer for through Jesus they shall overcome (John

16:33) and yield the peaceable fruit of righteousness (Heb. 12:11). Our Sons and Daughters shall have righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit and serve *Christ* in these things and be acceptable to God and approved by men (Rom. 14:17-18). The kingdom of God has come near to them (Luke 10-9)! The work of their righteousness will be peace, and the effect of their righteousness, quietness and assurance forever (Is. 32:17). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) keep their mind on the Lord and also trust in him and the Lord will keep them in perfect peace (Is. 26:3). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that their ways will please the Lord and he will make even their enemies to be at peace with them (Prov. 16:7) and their nation (Math. 21:43). Peace to their house and their nation (Math. 21:43), peace will rest upon it (Luke 10:5-6). God, the Holy One, His glory covers the heavens, and the earth is full of His praise (Hab. 3:3).

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the firstborn of all creation (Col. 1:15), the Lord grant (2 Tim. 1:18) Our children (ls. 61:9) the peace of **Jesus** and let not their heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid (John 14:27). In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23) because His judgment is righteous (John 5:30) let them and their nation (Math. 21:43) be diligent to be found by Him in peace, without spot and blameless (2 Pet. 3:14). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that they and their nation (Math. 21:43) will depart from evil, and do good; seek peace, and pursue it (Ps. 34:14); let them and their family (Acts 13:26) pursue the things which make for peace and the things by which one may edify another (Rom. 14:19). As much as depends on them, may they live peaceably with all men (Rom. 12:18): being spiritually minded, receiving life and peace (Rom. 8:6); being edified, walking in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit; being multiplied (Acts 9:31). May the Lord of peace Himself give them and their nation (Math. 21:43) peace always in every way. The Lord be with Our children (ls. 61:9) (2 Thess. 3:16) and their nation (Math. 21:43). Let them and the people (Ps. 148:14) of their nation (Math. 21:43) be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let their request be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard their hearts and minds through *Christ Jesus* (Phil. 4:6-7). Go in peace; and the God of Israel grant them and their people (Ps. 148:14) the petitions which they have asked of Him (1 Sam. 1:17) and guide their feet into the way of peace (Luke 1:79). Grace, mercy, love and peace be with them and their nation (Math. 21:43) from God the Father and from the Lord Jesus Christ, the Son of the Father, in truth and love (2 John 1:3). Let us hear, and let us take it to heart, to give glory to His name (Mal. 2:2)!

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), for by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers (Col. 1:16); in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) will fear the Lord their God as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. The Lord shall come down like rain upon the mown grass, like showers that water the earth. Our Sons and Daughters and their family (Acts 13:26) shall flourish, and have an abundance of peace, until the moon is no more (Ps. 72:5-7). The thoughts the Lord thinks towards them and their nation (Math. 21:43) are thoughts of peace and not of evil, to give them and their nation (Math. 21:43) a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), for God is the author of peace (1 Cor. 14:33). The Lord has seen their ways; and will heal Our children (ls. 61:9); He will also lead them and their nation (Math. 21:43), and restore comforts to them. Peace, peace to him who is far off and to him who is near. Peace to them and their nation (Math. 21:43) says the Lord (Is. 57:18-19). All their children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of their children. In righteousness they and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall be established; they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall be far from oppression, for they shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near them (ls. 54:13-14) and their nation (Math. 21:43). They shall laugh at destruction and famine, and Our children (Is. 61:9) shall not be afraid of the beasts of the earth (Job 5:22). For the Lord has set them and their people (Ps. 148:14) apart for Himself (Ps. 4:3). Our children (Is. 61:9) shall walk in the wisdom (Col. 4:5) of the Lord on the path of peace (Prov. 3:17). Our children (Is. 61:9) shall speak the truth and give judgment in their gates for truth, justice, and peace (Zech. 8:16). Their peace is like a river and their righteousness like the waves of the sea (Is. 48:18). May the presence of the Lord be with Our children (Is. 61:9) on their way (Judg. 18:6). Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward Our children (Is. 61:9) (Luke 2:14) and their nation (Math. 21:43)! For the earth will be filled with the knowledge of the glory of the Lord, as the waters cover the sea (Hab. 2:14).

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home

in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord* Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in *Christ* (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our **Lord Jesus Christ** (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and **Christ** will give them light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In *Christ* (John 16:23) We pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of Almighty God (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr.

11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield *belongs* to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23), who has authority over all flesh (John 17:2) all the things, we pray (James 5:16) for Our children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), and with confidence (1 John 5:14) we ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Prince of Life (Acts 3:15), believing that they and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20) we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty (Ps 89:34). God is watching over His word to perform it (Jer. 1:12) and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it. (ls. 55:11). The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word (Joel 2:11)! In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! Let us praise the name of God with a song, and let us magnify Him with thanksgiving (Ps. 69:30)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt 6:13)! Amen!

By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9).
