Future and Hope



You, O Lord, have established equity; You have executed justice and righteousness (Ps. 99:4). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of *Jesus Christ*, to those who are sanctified in *Christ Jesus*

(1 Cor. 1:2) we speak words of life over you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your family on every side (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2), your land and your nation. Our gift from God is eternal life in <u>Christ Jesus</u> our Lord (Rom. 6:23), so in His fantabulous name, <u>Jesus Christ</u>, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for your entire family, your friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2), for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all the leaders throughout the world and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23, John 14:12) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls (1 Pet. 2:25), may the God of hope (Rom. 15:13) give you and your family (Acts 13:26) a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11), a future of peace (Ps. 37:37). According to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which is according to godliness, in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began, to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21): Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ our Savior* (Titus 1:1-4). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the living bread which came down from heaven (John 6:41,51), may God fill you and your people (Ps. 148:14) with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may have a walk worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God (Col. 1:9-10), sharing in the inheritance of the saints in the light (Col. 1:12). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers (Col. 1:16); in His mighty name God grant you and yours to live with leading from the Holy Spirit (1 John 4:13), and not walk in

doubt (Matt. 21:21) and fear (Luke 1:74) of what may happen. Let Jesus Christ, the author and finisher of your faith (Heb. 12:2), keep you and yours from losing your sense of purpose and fill you and your people (Ps. 148:14) with hope for your future as an anchor of the soul, both sure and steadfast (Heb. 6:19); you and your family (Acts 13:26) being confident of this very thing, that He who has begun a good work in you and your family (Acts 13:26) will complete it until the day of Jesus Christ (Phil. 1:6). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the true Light (John 1:9), the Lord grant to you and your family (Acts 13:26) according to your heart's desire and fulfill all of your purpose (Ps. 20:4). May the Lord plant you and your family (Acts 13:26) firmly in His house and you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall flourish in the courts of our God and He will keep you fresh and flourishing and bearing fruit into old age (Ps. 92:13-14). He will be with you in trouble; He will deliver you and your family (Acts 13:26) and honor you (Ps. 91:15) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). With long life He will satisfy you and your people (Ps. 148:14) and show you His salvation (Ps. 91:6). In *Christ* (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may dwell in the house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) of the Lord all the days of your lives (Ps. 27:4); enter the Presence behind the veil (Heb. 6:19), and enter into that which God has prepared for those who love Him (1 Cor. 2:9). Eye has not seen, nor ear heard, nor have entered into the heart of man the things which God has prepared for those who love Him (1 Cor. 2:9). May Jesus Christ prepare a place for you and your family (Acts 13:26) and receive you and yours into Himself; so that where He is, there you and your family (Acts 13:26) may be also (John 14:3). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Jesus Christ will set you and your family (Acts 13:26) on His right hand, blessed by the Father, that you might inherit the kingdom prepared for you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) from the foundation of the world (Matt. 25:34); the kingdom that cannot be shaken (Heb. 12:28). For Jesus Christ has delivered your souls from death, your eyes from tears, and your feet from falling that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may walk before the Lord in the land of the living (Ps. 116:8-9). God's abundant mercy has begotten you and your family (Acts 13:26) again to a living hope; to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), who is kept by the power of God through faith for salvation (1 Pet. 1:3-5). May the genuineness of your faith, being much more precious than gold that perishes, be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of *Jesus Christ* (1 Pet. 1:7), believing, rejoicing with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith the salvation of your souls (1 Pet. 1:8-9). Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come (Rev 4:8)!

In the name of your great High Priest, who has passed through the heavens, Jesus Christ, the son of God (Heb. 4:14), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will ask of God, and He will give you the nations for your inheritance, and the ends of the earth for your possession (Ps. 2:8); cause you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to hear His loving kindness in the morning, trust in Him; and cause you and your family (Acts 13:26) to know the way you should walk and lift up your souls to Him (Ps. 143:8). May God, whose faithfulness has been established in the heavens (Ps. 89:2), visit you and your family (Acts 2:25-26). For He has made you a little lower than the angels, and He has crowned you with glory and honor (Ps. 8:4-5). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will seek the Lord, in the hope that you might grope for Him and find Him (Acts 17:27). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) seek His face (Ps. 27:8), and you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall see His face in righteousness; you and yours shall be satisfied to awake in His likeness (Ps. 17:15). You and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall see the Lord always before your face, for He is at your right hand, that you may not be shaken; that your hearts may rejoice, that your tongues be glad; moreover, that your flesh will also rest in hope (Acts 2:25-26). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God will make known to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the ways of life; and make you and your family (Acts 13:26) full of joy in His presence (Acts 2:28). According to His new covenant (Heb. 8:13) the Lord fulfill all your petitions (Ps. 20:5). May He send you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) help from the sanctuary, and strengthen you (Ps. 20:2) and your people (Ps. 148:14). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) God, the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead (Rom. 8:11), will give to you your heart's desire, and not withhold the request of your lips (Ps. 21:2). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that God, your refuge and strength (Ps. 46:1), to prepare a table before you and your family (Acts 13:26) in the presence of your enemies; anoint your heads with oil; and let your cup run over. Surely goodness and mercy shall follow you and your bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and your people (Ps. 148:14) all the days of your life; and you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall dwell in the house of the Lord forever (Ps. 23:5-6). According to the multitude of His tender mercies (Ps. 69:16, Lam. 3:32) in Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God's favor will cover you and your people (Ps. 148:14) for life (Ps. 30:5). Now may the God of hope fill you and your family (Acts 13:26) with all joy and peace in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) purify your souls in obeying the truth through the Spirit in sincere love with a pure heart, having been born again, not of corruptible seed but

incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever (1 Pet. 1:22-23). May you and your family (Acts 13:26) sanctify the Lord God in your hearts (1 Pet. 3:15) and prepare your hearts for the Lord (1 Sam. 7:3). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will gird up the loin of your minds, be sober, and rest your hope fully upon the grace of God, not conforming yourselves to the former lusts, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, living soberly, righteously, and godly (Titus 2:12), being holy in all your conduct. (1 Pet. 1:15), putting on the breastplate of faith and love, and as a helmet the hope of salvation (1 Thess. 5:8); setting your minds on things above, not on the things on the earth (Col. 3:2), bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of *Christ* (2 Cor. 10:5). Let you and your bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and your people (Ps. 148:14) do good, that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) be rich in good works, ready to give, willing to share, storing up for yourselves a good foundation for the time to come, that you may lay hold on eternal life (1 Tim. 6:18), receiving the unsearchable riches of *Christ* (Eph. 3:8). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) receive the gift of God which is eternal life in *Christ Jesus our Lord* (Rom. 6:23). Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev 5:12)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the true vine (John 15:1), in Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we call upon our Father (Rom. 1:7) and God (Phil. 4:20), and in Christ (, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that He would bless you and your family (Acts 13:26) indeed, and enlarge your territory, that His Hand would be with you, and that He would keep you and your people (Ps. 148:14) from evil, that you and yours may not cause pain. May the Lord God bless you and your family (Acts 13:26) indeed (1 Chr. 4:10)! In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), there is no other Rock (Is. 44:8), let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) lay aside every weight, and the sin which so easily ensnares you, and let you run with endurance the race that is set before you, looking unto Jesus, the author and finisher of your faith (Heb. 12:1-2). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) fight the good fight of faith, laying hold on eternal life (1 Tim. 6:12). Let your future be rooted and grounded in love (Eph. 3:17), filled with joy (Eccl. 2:26), your mouths filled with laughing, and your lips with rejoicing (Job 8:21), your speech always be with grace, seasoned with salt (Col. 4:6). May your future be free of affliction (2 Cor. 4:17); let you and your bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and your people (Ps. 148:14) stand fast in the liberty by which *Christ* has set you free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage (Gal. 5:1); nor be lead into temptation (Matt. 6:13), but instead, by the tender mercies of God, be delivered from darkness (Luke 1:78-79), destruction, misery

(Rom. 3:16), and death (1 Cor. 15:26); and set free from bondage (Gal. 5:1) and curses (Rev. 22:3); receiving the Spirit of adoption by whom we shall cry "Abba Father" (Rom. 8:15); following Jesus (John 10:4,27); secure in righteousness (Gal. 5:5); sure of the inheritance reserved in heaven for you (1 Pet. 1:4); marked for salvation on your foreheads (Rev. 22:4); and appointed to eternal life (Acts 13:48). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and yours will walk by faith, not by sight (2 cor. 5:7); in the light (1 John 1:7) and truth (2 cor. 4:2), trusting God (Prov. 3:5), being guided by the Holy Spirit (Rev. 2:7, Rev. 2:17, Rev. 3:6 etc.), surrounded by kindness (Eph. 2:7) and covered in grace (Eph. 4:7); having redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sin (Col. 1:14); being holy, and blameless and irreproachable in God's sight (Col. 1:22); purified and zealous for good works (Titus 2:14); called to His eternal glory by Christ Jesus (1 Pet. 5:10). By the grace of God let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be perfected in holiness (1 Pet. 5:10), rooted and build up in *Christ* and established in faith (Col. 2:7), strengthened, and settled (1 Pet. 5;10), grounded and steadfast (Col. 1:23), surrounded by God's favor (Ps. 5:12), walking in authority (Matt. 28:18), and established in every good word and work (2 Thess. 2:17), being bold and confident (2 Cor. 10:2, Eph. 3:12), secure in the blood covenant of God Almighty (Heb. 7:22). Let your path drip with abundance (Ps. 65:11). May all God's blessing come upon you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and overtake you (Deut. 28:2) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall not lack any good thing (Ps. 34:10). May you and your family (Acts 13:26) prosper in all things and be of good health, as your souls prosper (3 John 2), having a long (Ps. 91:16) fruitful life (Ps. 92:14), being rich in experiences (Rom. 10:12), wise in judgments (John 7:24) and choices (Deut. 30:19), behaving wisely and in a perfect way (Ps. 101:2), filled with wisdom (Luke 2:40,Col. 1:9), not lacking in knowledge (Hos. 4:6), but given understanding (1 John 5:20), that you may know Him who is true: and be in Him who is true, in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), enjoying the fruits of your labor (Eccl. 3:13). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) be diligent until the end (Heb. 6:11), finish the race and receive the prize, an imperishable crown (1 Cor. 9:24-25). May God make you and your family (Acts 13:26) an eternal excellence, a joy of many generations (Is. 60:15). So shall your descendants be (Rom. 4:18)! O Father, Lord of heaven and earth (Matt. 11:25) establish you and your seed forever, and build up your throne to all generations (Ps. 89:4). Wealth and riches will be in your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and your righteousness shall endure forever. Unto your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) arises light in the darkness (Ps. 112:4). Your hearts are steadfast, trusting in the Lord. Your hearts are established (Ps. 112:7-8). Surely you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will never be shaken. You and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will be an everlasting

remembrance (Ps. 112:6). In <u>Christ</u> (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God of all comfort (2 Cor. 1:3) will give you increase more and more, you and your children. May you be blessed by the Lord, who made heaven and earth (Ps. 115:14-15)! Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be satisfied from above (Prov. 14:14). In <u>Christ</u> (1 Cor. 1:30) we petition God to open to you and your family (Acts 13:26) the gates of righteousness; that you may go through them (Ps. 118:19). His faithfulness endures to all generations (Ps. 119:90). Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the lamb, forever and ever (Rev. 5:13)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who is a sure foundation (Is. 28:16), in His name may our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) give you and your family (Acts 13:26) ears to hear what the Spirit says; so that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will overcome and eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God (Rev. 2:7). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) be faithful until death (Rev. 2:10); that *Christ* will be magnified in your bodies, whether by life or death (Phil. 1:20); and in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord God give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the crown of life (Rev. 2:10). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9), in the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the door to your salvation (John 10:9), that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will overcome and not be hurt by the second death (Rev. 2:11). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) hold fast to His name, and not deny His faith (Rev. 2:13). Let you and yours overcome and receive the hidden manna to eat. May God give you a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except the one who receives it (Rev. 2:17). The Lord knows your works, love, service, faith, and patience; and as for your works, let the last be more than the first (Rev. 2:19). Our hope is that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) overcome, and keep His works until the end; to you and your family (Acts 13:26) may God give power over the nations (Rev. 2:26), and give to you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the morning star (Rev. 2:28). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) will not defile your garments; and may you walk with God in white, for you are worthy (Rev. 3:4). May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) overcome and be clothed in white garments (Rev 3:5). Your gift from God is eternal life in *Christ Jesus our Lord* (Rom. 6:23), we ask in Jesus' name (John 16:23) that God not blot out your names from the Book of Life; and that Jesus, himself, will confess your names before His Father and before His angels (Rev. 3:5). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we petition the Lord, God of your salvation (Ps. 65:5), to set before you and your family (Acts 13:26) an open door, that no one can shut; and give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) strength, to keep His word, and not deny His name (Rev 3:8). According to

His promise (2 Pet. 3:13), the Lord, who became for you wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), keep you and your family (Acts 13:26) from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole earth (Rev. 3:10). May you and your people (Ps. 148:14) hold fast to what you have so that no one can take your crown (Rev. 3:11). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the Lord our God will make you and your family (Acts 13:26) a pillar in the temple of God (Rev 3:12). As a vessel of mercy, so that **Christ** might make known to you the saints (Rom. 9:23), we ask that the Lord Jesus will write on you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the name of His God and the name of the city of His God, and write on you His new name (Rev 3:11-12). Let the Lord sell to you and your family (Acts 13:26) gold refined in the fire; that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may be rich; and white garments, that you and yours may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed; and anoint your eyes with eye salve, that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may see (Rev. 3:18). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) hear His voice and open the door that He will come in to you and dine with you (Rev. 3:20). The Lord grant to you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to sit with Him on His throne, as He also overcame and sat down with His Father on His throne (Rev. 3:20-21). May the Lord leave a door standing open in heaven for you (Rev. 4:1) and your family (Acts 13:26) and seal you and yours, as servants of our God, upon your foreheads (Rev. 7:3). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will wash your robes and make yourselves white in the blood of the Lamb (Rev. 7:14). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) overcome him (Satan) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of your testimony, and may you and your family (Acts 13:26) not love your lives to death (Rev. 12:11). In Christ (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord will make you and your family (Acts 13:26) new (Rev. 21:5) and give to you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the fountain of the water of life freely (Rev. 21:6). May the God of your salvation (Ps. 65:5) help you and your family (Acts 13:26) overcome that you shall inherit all things (Rev. 21:7). There shall be no more curse (Rev. 22:3), you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall see His face, and His name shall be on your foreheads (Rev. 22:4), for you are called by His name (2 Chr. 7:14). In <u>Christ</u> (1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God will remember you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with the favor He has toward His people; Oh, may the Lord visit you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with His salvation (Ps. 106:4), that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may see the benefit of His chosen ones, that you may rejoice in the gladness of His nation, that you may glory with His inheritance (Ps. 106:4-5). To Him who loved you and washed you from your sins in

His own blood, and has made you kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6).

As a Priest of God (Rev. 5:10), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17.19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of Jesus Christ, who became for us wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30) and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In the beloved Son (Pet. 1:17), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. In Your name we rejoice all day long, and in Your righteousness we are exalted. For You are the glory of our strength, and in Your favor our horn is exalted. For our shield belongs to the Lord, and we belong to the Holy One of Israel (Ps. 89:16-18).

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
