A Prayer for the Children of Israel Integrity and Reputation



To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him *be* glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of **Jesus Christ** (Philp. 2:10)

we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children Israel. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that Christ might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so

that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their nation (Math. 21:43). The *Lord Jesus Christ* be with their spirit. Grace be with Our children (Is. 61:9) (2 Tim. 4:22).

Hear a just cause, O Lord, attend to our cry; give ear to our prayer. Let Our Children's (Is. 61:9) vindication come from Your presence; let Your eyes look on the things that are upright (Ps. 17:1-2)! In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), according to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13) may the Lord make Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) (Math. 21:43) people of integrity, according to His standards (Is. 49:22). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), an everlasting light (ls. 60:19), may God their helper (Ps. 54:4), vindicate Our children (ls. 61:9) (Ps. 26:1 and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), and teach them and their people (Ps. 148:14) to walk in integrity and trust in the Lord, and they shall not slip (Ps. 26:1). God's counsel is their sound wisdom, understanding and strength (Prov. 8:14). According to the hope of eternal life (Titus 3:7), let the Lord help Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) walk in His spirit of truth at all times (John 16:13) and act on it with confidence (Acts 28:31,), for the Lord will be their confidence, and keep their foot from being caught (Prov. 3:26); in quietness and confidence shall be their strength (Is. 30:15). For is not their reverence their confidence? And the integrity of their ways their hope (Job 4:6)? May the Lord write mercy and truth in their hearts and let them find favor and high esteem in the sight of God and man (Prov. 3:3-4). According to His name (Ps. 48:10) let the Lord our God (Math. 4:10) give Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) a good name and loving favor (Prov. 22:1). With favor, let the Lord surround Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) as with a shield (Ps. 5:12). Let Our Children's (ls. 61:9) light so shine before men, that they may see their good works and glorify our Father in heaven (Matt. 5:16). May the God of peace (Rom. 15:33, Rom. 16:20) create in Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) a clean heart, and renew a steadfast spirit within them (Ps. 51:10). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will be known as people walking in truth (2 John 4), walking in *Christ Jesus the Lord*, rooted and built up in Him, and established in the faith, abounding in it with thanksgiving (Col. 2:6-). The God of hope (Rom. 15:13) make Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) known as a God fearing people (Ps. 61:5), righteous, (Hos. 14:9), loving (Gal. 5:22), just, (Prov. 3:33, 7:9), peaceful (Gal. 5:22), people of integrity (Prov. 10:9), truthful (Prov. 12:19), wise (Eph. 5:15), filled with the Holy Spirit (John 16:13), steadfast, (Heb. 6:19) grounded (Eph. 3: 17), solid, prudent (Hos. 14:9), diligent (Prov. 7:15, Prov. 11:27), honest and honorable in the sight of the Lord and men (2 Cor. 8:21), brave, strong (1 Cor. 16:13), and humble (Mic. 6:8), diligently seeking good (Prov. 11:27), diligently seeking God's face (Ps. 7:15) and finding favor (Ps. 5:12) in His eyes (Ps. 11:4). God of their salvation (Ps. 25:5) make Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) blameless and upright people, people who fear God and shun evil. In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will hold fast to their integrity (Job 2:3). Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation

(Math. 21:43) shall be known as people who have clean hands, and pure hearts, who have not lifted up their souls into vanity, nor sworn deceitfully (Ps. 24:4), nor taken reward against the innocent (Ps. 15:5). Let them hear, and let them take it to heart, to give glory to His name, <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Mal. 2:2)! For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels, and then He will reward each according to their works (Matt. 16:27)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), a precious corner stone (Is. 28:16), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) are grounded (Col. 1:23), steadfast and immovable (1 Cor. 15:58) stable (James 1:8), that the foundation of their faith be built on the rock (Luke 6:48) of <u>Jesus</u> (Luke 20:17), that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) are not double minded (James 1:7-8), but their yes means yes and their no means no (Matt. 5:37). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) are not conformed to this world (Rom. 12:2), instead Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) are being transformed into the image of God from glory to glory (2 Cor. 3:18), their inward person being renewed day by day (2 Cor. 4:16) through *Christ Jesus* for they are partakers of the divine nature of God, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:4), not thinking of themselves more highly than they ought to think, but to think soberly, for God has dealt to each one a measure of faith (Rom. 12:3). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) not worry about what people think, let no man judge Our children (ls. 61:9) for their substance is of Christ (Col. 2:16-17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) will serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear (Heb. 12:28) in sincerity and in truth (Josh. 24:14), being gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition to God (2 Tim. 2:24-25). According to the measure of *Christ's* gift (Eph. 4:7) may Our children (ls. 61:9) shepherd their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) according to the integrity of their heart, and guide their family (Acts 13:26) by the skillfulness of their hands (Ps. 78:72). Let Our children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) be self-controlled (Gal. 5:22), not being tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, nor by the trickery of men, in cunning and craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, growing in all things into Him who is the head – Christ Jesus (Eph. 4:14-15). The Lord, our God, He shall gather all nations and tongues; and Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) shall come and see His glory. (Is. 66:18). The Lord lives; in truth, in judgment, and in

righteousness; the nations (their family and their friends) shall bless themselves in Him, and in Him they shall glory (Jer. 4:2)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) ponder the path of their feet, and let all their ways be established. They shall not turn to the right or the left; but remove their foot from evil (Prov. 4:26-27). May Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) walk in their integrity (Ps. 26:11), securely (Prov. 10:9), letting their integrity guide them (Prov. 11:3). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) walk before God in integrity of heart and in uprightness (1 Kin. 9:4), that God may know their integrity (Job 31:6). Let integrity and uprightness preserve them (Ps. 25:21) and their family (Acts 13:26) and their children shall be blessed after them (Prov. 20:7). Give God the glory (John 9:24)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), who became for Our children (Is. 61:9) wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that their thoughts are right and their mouth is upright (Prov. 12:5-6). Surely, goodness and mercy will follow Our children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) all the days of their lives (Ps. 23:6). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) stand firm against the wiles of the devil (Eph. 6:11) and the lust of the flesh, lusts of the eye, and the pride of life (1 John 2:16). The Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth (Ex. 34:6), help Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) be blameless and upright, fear God and shun evil always and hold fast to their integrity (Job 2:3). Their steps are ordered by the Lord, and He delights in their way. Though they fall, they shall not be utterly cast down; for the Lord upholds Our children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 37:23-24). May the Lord uphold Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) in their integrity, and set them before His face forever (Ps. 41:12). Let it be that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are known as a good, gentle, kind, loving, patient, faithful, self-controlled people (Gal. 5:22-23); for a tree is known by its fruit (Matt. 12:33). Let Our children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) be sober-minded, in all things showing themselves to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of Our children (Is. 61:9) (Titus 2:6-8) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). May they be people of good reputation, fearing God, just (Acts 10:22) and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom (Acts 6:3). Surely Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) will be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity (1 Tim. 4:12). May the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17) not remember the sins of their youth, nor their transgressions (Ps. 25:7), but instead remove their transgressions as far as the east is from the west (Ps. 103:12). Let the past be the past, old things have passed away (2 Cor. 5:17), therefore in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will forget those things which are behind and reach forward to those things which are ahead, pressing toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in **Christ Jesus** (Phil 3:13-14). To Him, **Jesus Christ**, was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14).

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), Our children (Is. 61:9) are washed, they are sanctified, they are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11), therefore let those be driven backward and brought to dishonor who wish them and their house Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) evil (Ps. 40:14). May the God of their defense, the God of their mercy (Ps. 59:17), hide Our children (ls. 61:9) from the secret plots of the wicked, from the rebellion of the workers of iniquity, who sharpen their tongues like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows - bitter words (Ps. 64:2); the Lord make them stumble over their own tongues and flee away (Ps. 64:8). Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, so a curse without cause shall not alight (Prov. 26-2). God, their Strength (Ps. 59:17), will not let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) be ashamed, for in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we have called upon Him; let the wicked be ashamed; let them be silent in the grave. Let the lying lips be put to silence, which speak insolent things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous (Ps. 31:17-18). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the God of justice (Is. 30:18) will plead their cause with those who strive with Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43); fight against those who fight against them (Ps. 35:1) and their people (Ps. 148:14). May the God of their praise (Ps. 109:1) bless those who bless them and curse those who curse them, they shall serve the Lord (Josh. 24:15), and Him only they shall serve (Luke 4:8). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16:23), by His blood they are made near (Eph. 2:13), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord God of hosts (2 sam. 5:10) will deliver Our children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) and honor them (Ps. 91:15), exalt them (Ps. 75:7), and may Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) possess a good name (Eccl. 7:1). When the Son of Man comes in His glory,

and all the holy angels with Him (Matt. 25:31), we will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory (Matt. 24:30), then He will sit on the throne of His glory (Matt. 25:31). Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men (Luke 2:14)! Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest (Luke 19:38)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord* Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in *Christ* (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that Christ might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam, 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen, 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as our joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with our Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days,

judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and <u>Christ</u> will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In <u>Christ</u> (John 16:23) We pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield *belongs* to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

In the name of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), High Priest forever according to the order of Melchizedek (Heb. 6:20), we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ, to bear His name (Acts 9:15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (PS. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty Psalms 89:34. God is watching over His word to perform it Jerimiah. 1:12 and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it **Isaiah 55:11**. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word Joel 2:11! The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms**. **33:1**. It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved.

By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!
