A Prayer for the Children of Israel Fear

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10) abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of **Jesus Christ** (Philp. 2:10)

we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children Israel. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with their Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that Christ might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so

that Our Children (is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), We proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on their own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), **Jesus Christ** of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their nation (Math. 21:43). The Lord **Jesus Christ** be with their spirit, grace be with them (2 Tim. 4:11).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of <u>Christ</u>, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and keep them (Num. 6:24). Our children (Is. 61:9) are called by Your name (Jer. 14:9), O Lord; You are their God, they are the people of Your pasture and the sheep of Your hand

(Ps. 95:7, 79:13); save Your people, and bless Your inheritance; Shepherd them also, and bear them up forever (Ps. 28:9). Hear, O Lord, their voice, O God, in their meditation; preserve their life from fear of the enemy (Ps. 64:1). When they seek the Lord, He hears them, and deliveries them from all their fears (Ps. 34:4). Our children (Is. 61:9) shall fear not, for they have been redeemed; they have been called by name; they belong to the Lord. When they pass through the waters, God will be with them; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow them. When they walk through the fire, they shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch them. For the Lord, their God, the Holy One of Israel, their Savior (Is. 43:1-3) is with them. God will never leave Our children (Is. 61:9) nor forsake them (Duet. 31:6, Heb. 13:5). The Lord is their rock and their salvation; God is their defense; they shall not be moved. In God is their salvation and their glory; the rock of their strength, and their refuge is in God (Ps. 62:6-7). Yes, the Lord is their rock and their fortress and their deliverer; their God, their strength, in whom they will trust; their shield and the horn of their salvation, their stronghold (Ps. 18:2). Neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) from the love of God which is in **Christ Jesus their Lord** (Rom. 8:38). God shall redeem their souls from the power of the grave, for He shall receive Our children (ls. 61:9) (Ps. 49:15) and their people (Ps. 148:14). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) sanctify the Lord God in their hearts (1 Pet. 3:15), knowing that they are redeemed (1 Pet. 1:18) with the precious blood of *Christ*, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19). Most certainly Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) have been released from the fear of death which brought them subject to bondage (Heb. 2:15). For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8). For Our children (Is. 61:9) did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but they received the Spirit of adoption by whom they cry out, "Abba, Father" (Rom. 8:15), for they are children of God (Rom. 8:16) and joint heirs with *Christ*, that they may also be glorified together with *Christ* (Rom. 8:17). For it is their Father's good pleasure to give Our children (Is. 61:9) the kingdom (Luke 12:32) which cannot be shaken (Heb. 12:28). The Lord God will ever be mindful of His covenant (Ps. 111:5). He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name (Ps. 111:9)!

God has not given Our children (Is. 61:9) a spirit of fear, but of power and love and of a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7). *Jesus Christ* (John 14:13,16:23), He who has the keys of Hades and of Death (Rev. 1:18), in His mighty name (Jer. 32:18) Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14)

shall be secure in the fact that **Jesus Christ** has given them authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt them. They are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power (col. 2:10). They shall bind the kings of evil with chains, and the nobles with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment - this honor have all His saints (Ps. 149:8-9), having strong confidence (Prov. 14:26) that whatever they bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever they loose on earth will be loosed in heaven (Matt. 18:18). No weapon formed against Our children (Is. 61:9) shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against them in judgment, shall be condemned (Is. 54:17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will seek the Lord, and He will hear them, and deliver them from all of their fears (Ps. 34:4). May they have no fear but be secure in the knowledge that the Lord is their helper (Heb. 13:6). By the blood of **Jesus**, in righteousness, they shall be established; they shall be far from oppression, for they shall not fear, and from terror, for it shall not come near them (ls. 54:14). Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You! Oh, let the nations be glad and sing for joy! For You shall judge the people righteously, and govern the nations on earth! Selah! Let the peoples praise You, O God; let all the peoples praise You! Then the earth shall yield their increase; God, their own God, shall bless Our children (Is. 61:9). God shall bless Our children (ls. 61:9) and their children after them, and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him (Ps. 67:3-7)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), He who lives, and was dead, and behold, He lives forevermore (Rev. 1:18), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps. 72:4) shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at their side, and ten thousand at their right hand; but it shall not come near Our children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 91:5-7). They shall not fear, nor be dismayed, for the Lord their God is with them. He will strengthen Our children (Is. 61:9), yes, He will help them, He will uphold them with His righteous right hand (Is. 41:10); and if their foot slips may the mercy of God Comfort Our children (Is. 61:9) and delight their soul (Ps. 94:18-19). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), may the peace of <u>Jesus Christ</u> be with Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and let not their hearts be troubled, neither let them be afraid (John 14:27); for He who is in Our children (Is. 61:9) is greater than He who is in the world (1 John 4:4); and

those who are with Our children (Is. 61:9) are more than those who are against them (2 Kin. 6:16). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) be of good cheer, for <u>Jesus Christ</u> has overcome the world (John 16:33). Let the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is Judge! Selah (Ps. 50:6)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the fountain of living waters (Jer. 2:13) springing up into everlasting life (John 4:13-14), in His name may the love of God be poured out in their hearts by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 5:5). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that our God would grant (1 sam. 1:17) Our children (Is. 61:9), according to the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that Christ may dwell in their hearts through faith; that Our children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26), being rooted and grounded in love, be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height - to know the love of **Christ** which passes knowledge; that they may be filled with all the fullness of God (Eph. 3:16-19). By the perfect love of the Holy Spirit may all fear be cast out (1 John 4:18). Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully with a shout of joy! For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth! He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord! By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth! He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses. Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him. For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast (Ps. 33:3-9).

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), their strength in whom they shall trust (Ps. 18:2), Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) they shall be strong and of good courage, they shall not fear nor be afraid; for the Lord their God, He is the One who goes with them (Deut. 31:6). Our children (Is. 61:9) shall not fear or be discouraged (Deut. 1:21) for the Lord God Himself fights for Our children (Is. 61:9) (Deut. 3:22). The Lord will cause their enemies who rise against them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) to be defeated before their face; they shall come out against Our children (Is. 61:9) one way and flee before them seven ways (Deut. 28:7). For God, the Judge of all (Heb. 12:23), has struck all their enemies on the cheekbone; He has broken the teeth of the ungodly. Salvation belongs to the Lord. His blessing is upon His people (Ps. 3:7-8). According to the exceeding greatness of His power (Ps. 79:11, Eph. 1:19, 2 Tim. 1:8) the Lord deliver Our children (Is. 61:9) from every evil work and preserve them for His heavenly kingdom (2 Tim. 4:18).

with those who strive with Our children (ls. 61:9); fight against those who fight against them (Ps. 35:1) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). May God their helper (Ps. 54:4) take hold of the shield and buckler and stand up for Our children (Is. 61:9). Also draw out the spear and stop those who pursue them. Say to their soul "I am your salvation." Let those be put to shame and brought to dishonor who seek after their lives: let those be driven back and brought to confusion and dishonor who plot their hurt, who wish them and their people (Ps. 148:14) evil (Ps. 35:1-4, Ps. 40:14). Let them be ashamed and brought to mutual confusion who rejoice at their hurt; who seek to destroy their lives; let them be clothed with shame and dishonor who exalt themselves against Our children (Is. 61:9) (Ps. 35:26, Ps. 40:14) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). Let them be like chaff before the wind and let the angel of the Lord chase them. Let their way be dark and slippery and let the angel of the Lord pursue them (Ps. 35:6). Let destruction come upon them unexpectedly, and let the net they have hidden catch themselves; into that very destruction let them fall (Ps. 35:8. Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) shall rejoice in His salvation (Ps. 35:9)!). And their soul shall be joyful in the Lord! You, O Lord, have given a banner to those who fear You, that it may be displayed because of the truth! Selah (Ps. 60:4)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the Great, the Mighty God, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 32:18), who is great in counsel and mighty in work (Jer. 32:19), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) violence shall no longer be heard in their land, neither wasting nor destruction within their borders; but Our children (Is. 61:9) shall call their walls Salvation, and their gates Praise (Is. 60:18). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). Surely, Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall be strong, and not fear! Behold, our God will come with a vengeance, with the recompense of God; He will come and save Our children (Is. 61:9) (Is.35:4). Show Your marvelous loving kindness by Your right hand, O Lord, You who save those who trust in You from those who rise up against them (Ps. 17:7). May God, whose faithfulness has been established in the very heavens (Ps. 89:2), keep Our children (Is. 61:9) as the apple of His eye; hide them under the shadow of His wings, from the wicked who oppress them, from the deadly enemies who surround them (Ps. 17:8-9). Let the wicked be ashamed; let them be silent in the grave; let the lying lips be put to silence that say insolent things, proudly and

contemptuously against them. Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water" (Rev. 14:7)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the King, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 46:18), hear their voice, O God, in their meditation; let the God of their strength (Ps. 43:2) preserve their life (Ps. 64:1) from fear of the enemy (Ps. 64:1). May the Lord hide Our children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) from the secret counsel of the wicked, from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity, who sharpen their tongues like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows of bitter words, that they may shoot in secret at the blameless (Ps. 64:1-4). For those who are incensed against Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall be ashamed and disgraced; they shall be as nothing, and those who strive with Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall perish (ls. 41:11). The Lord preserves all who love Him, but all the wicked He will destroy (Ps. 145:20). The Lord is righteous in all His ways, gracious in all His works (Ps. 145:17). We shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, O Lord, and talk of Your power, to make known to the sons of men Your mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of Your kingdom. Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all generations (Ps. 145:11-13). The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy. The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works (Ps. 145:8-9). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), praise the name of the Lord our God, who has dealt wondrously with Our children (Is. 61:9) (Joel 2:26), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that in His name the Lord bless those who bless Our children (Is. 61:9) and curse those who curse them (Gen. 12:3). Truly, their soul silently waits for God; from Him comes their salvation. He only is their rock and their salvation; He is their defense; Our children (Is. 61:9) shall not be greatly moved (Ps. 62:1-2).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), His name Immanuel, which is translated, "God with us" (Matt. 1:23), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we proclaim that God has not given Our children (Is. 61:9) a spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7), the mind of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 2:16). They will not entertain confusion (Ps. 40:14), but the breath of the Almighty will give Our children (Is. 61:9) understanding (Job 32:8); and they and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall walk in the light as <u>Jesus</u> is in the light (1 John 1:7). They shall not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good (Rom. 12:21). May Our children (Is. 61:9) and all of their family (Acts 13:26) commit their way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring

it to pass. He shall bring forth their righteousness as the light, and their justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:5-6). Therefore, let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from them (James 4:7). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), as the truth is in Him (Eph. 4:21), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that all things covered be revealed and all things hidden be known (Matt. 10:26). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) will not doubt (Matt. 14:31) but know the peace of God (Phil. 4:7), and be comforted by the knowledge that God is for them and if God is for them who can be against them (Rom. 8:31); and in all things Our children (Is. 61:9) and their children (Ps. 102:28) are more than conquerors through Him who loves them (Rom. 8:37) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). The God of our *Lord Jesus Christ*, the Father of glory, give to Our children (ls. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) the spirit of wisdom and revelation in knowledge of Him, the eyes of their understanding being enlightened; that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in Our children (ls. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26), and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward Our children (is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) who believe, according to the working of His mighty power (Eph. 1:17 -19). They shall fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun (Is. 59:19). The Lord will be to Our children (Is. 61:9) an everlasting light, and their God their glory (ls. 60:19)!

In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars (Rev. 3:1), in His name may the Spirit of the Lord rest upon Our children (Is. 61:9) (Is. 11:2), the Spirit of truth (John 14:17), the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord (Is. 11:2).

According to His name, may God (Ps. 48:10), the habitation of justice (Jer. 50:7), teach Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) humility and the fear of the Lord and give them riches and honor and life (Prov. 22:4). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will not fear man (Prov. 29:25), but they will fear the Lord and gain wisdom (Ps. 111:10). Surely Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall not lack for any good thing (Ps. 34:9-10) for the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever, the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether (Ps. 19:9). The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe (Prov. 29:25). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) and

their family (Acts 13:26) shall not fear the reproach of men, nor be afraid of their reviling (Is. 51:7). And they and their children Ps. 72:4 shall not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell (Matt. 10:28). Oh, how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for those who fear You, O Lord, which You have prepared for those who trust in You in the presence of the sons of men (Ps. 31:19)! You shall hide us in the secret place of Your Presence from the plots of man; You shall keep us secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues (Ps. 31:20). Blessed be the Lord, for He shows us His marvelous kindness (Ps. 31:21)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the true Light which gives light to every man who comes into the world (John 1:9), in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father (Math. 6:9), God of truth and without injustice, righteous and upright is He (Deut. 32:4), to shine in their hearts to give the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of **Jesus Christ their Savior** (2 Cor. 4:6). The Lord is their light and their salvation; whom shall they fear? The Lord is the strength of their life; of whom shall they be afraid? When the wicked come against Our children (ls. 61:9) to eat up their flesh, their enemies and foes, they stumble and fall. Though an army should encamp against them, their heart shall not fear. Though war should rise against them (Ps. 72:4), in this they will be confident, that they and their children (Ps 103:17) may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of their life. For in the time of trouble God shall hide Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) in His pavilion; in the secret place of His Tabernacle He shall hide them); He shall set them high upon a rock. And then their heads shall be lifted up above their enemies all around them (Ps. 27:1-6). No man shall be able to stand against Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); the Lord their God will put the dread of them and the fear of them upon all the land where they should tread (Deut. 11:25). This day God will begin to put the dread and fear of Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) upon the nations under the whole heaven, who shall hear the report of them and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and shall tremble and be in anguish because of Our children (Is. 61:9) (Deut. 2:25) and their people (Ps. 148:14). And the fear of Our children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and the dread of them and their people (Ps. 148:14) shall be on every beast of the earth, on every bird of the air, on all that moves on the earth, and on all the fish of the sea. They are given into their hands (Gen. 9:2). God will send His fear before Our children (Is. 61:9), and cause confusion and will make all their enemies turn their backs to them (Ex. 23:27). Little by little God will drive them out from before Our children (ls. 61:9), until they and their people (Ps. 148:14) have increased,

and they inherit the land (Ex. 23:30). Fear not, for God is with Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26); God will bring their descendants from the east, and gather them from the west; He will say to the north, `Give them up!' And to the south, `Do not keep them back!' God will bring their sons from afar, and their daughters from the ends of the earth for Our children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) are called by His name, whom He has created for His glory (Is. 43:5-8). God, righteous and upright is He (Deut. 32:4); He will set His glory among the nations; all the nations shall see His judgment which He has executed, and His hand which He has laid on them. They shall know that He is their Lord their God from that day forward (Ezek.39:21-22).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), those who know His name will put their trust in Him (Ps.9:10), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask God, who does wonders (Ps. 77:14), to make Our children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Prov. 11:21) after them, be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; but their leaves will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit (Jer. 17:8). They shall have rest and be at ease; no one shall make them afraid (Jer. 46:27). Let Our children (Is. 61:9) keep their minds on the Lord and also trust in Him and the Lord will keep them in perfect peace (Is. 26:3). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our children (Is. 61:9) will be faithful until death, and receive the crown of life. God grant that Our children (Is. 61:9) have an ear to hear what the Spirit says. In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask God, He who has declared His strength among the peoples (Ps. 77:14), that Our children (Is. 61:9) shall overcome and not be hurt by the second death (Rev. 2:10-11), rather seek the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ unto eternal life (Jude 20-21). Our children (Is. 61:9) believe they will see the glory of God (John 11:40)! Therefore, they have reason to glory in *Christ Jesus* in the things which pertain to God (Rom. 15:17). Let them rejoice in hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! To God, alone wise, be glory through Jesus Christ forever (Rom. 16:27)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), may the everlasting God (Gen. 21:33) teach Our children (Is. 61:9) His way, so that they will walk in His truth; and unite their hearts to fear His name (Ps. 86:11); and to hope in His word (Ps. 119-74). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), Our children (Is. 61:9) shall walk in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31). Wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of their times, and the strength of salvation; the fear of the Lord is His treasure (Is. 33:6). Let wisdom enter their hearts, and knowledge be pleasant to their souls,

let discretion preserve Our children (ls. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14); understanding will keep them and their family (Acts 13:26), to deliver them and their people (Ps. 148:14) from the way of evil (Prov. 2:10-12). Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man; O Lord, seek out their wickedness until You find none (Ps. 10:15). Let nothing wicked cling to Our children (Is. 61:9). A perverse heart shall depart from Our children (Is. 61:9) and they will not know wickedness (Ps. 101:3-4). The Lord shall preserve their going out and their coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore (Ps. 121:8). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), that Our children (ls. 61:9) will take captive whose captives they were, and rule over their oppressors (ls. 14:2). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) that Our children (ls. 61:9) will rule their own spirit and not be like a city broken down without walls (Prov. 25:28). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Is. 9:6), let Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let their requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard their hearts and minds through Christ Jesus (Phil 4: 6). May the God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) bring Our children (Is. 61:9) out of the darkness and the shadows of death and break their chains in pieces (Ps. 107:14). Let them cast off the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light (Rom. 13:12). May the Lord our God teach Our children (ls. 61:9)) to stand fast therefore in the liberty by which Christ has made them free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage (Gal. 5:1). High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy (ls. 57:15), our God, Master in heaven (Col. 4:1), give Our children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) the assurance that with God all things are possible" (Matt. 19:26); they can do all things through Christ who strengthens them (Phil 4:13). Surely His rod and His staff will comfort them. Let them put on the whole armor of God and stand against the wiles of the devil (Eph. 6:11). May Our children (ls. 61:9) stand therefore having girded their waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod their feet with the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which they will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints (Eph. 6:14-18). If Our children (Is. 61:9) are reproached for the name of *Christ*, blessed are they, for the

Spirit of glory and of God rests upon them. On their part He is blasphemed, but on the part of our children He is glorified (1 Pet. 4:14). Therefore, in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) Our children (Is. 61:9) will grow in the grace and knowledge of their <u>Lord and Savior Jesus Christ</u>. To Him be the glory both now and forever (2 Pet. 3:18)! The Lord be magnified (Ps. 40:16)! Glory to God in the Highest (Luke 2:14)!

Bless the Lord, O their souls; and all that is within Our children (Is. 61:9), bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O their souls; and forget not all His benefits: who forgives all their inequities, who heals all their diseases, who redeems their lives from destruction. Who crowns them with loving kindness and tender mercies (Ps. 103:1-4). The Lord executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed (Ps. 103:6). Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, a curse without cause will not alight on Our children (Is. 61:9) (Prov. 26:2) or their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). There is no cause because as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed their transgressions from them. So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun; when the enemy comes in, like a flood the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him (Is. 59:19). To God their Savior, who alone is wise, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever (Jude 1:25)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), their nation (Math. 21:43) and all of their people (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify their time (ls. 9:7, ls. 59:21) so that they will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify their space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in them (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify them completely; and may their whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our *Lord* Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). Our Lord and Savior (2 Pet. 1:11), Jesus Christ, to Him was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14). The earth is the Lords, and all its fullness, the world and those who dwell therein (Ps. 24:1). The heavens are His, the earth also is His; the world and all its fullness, He has founded it. The north and the south, the east and the west, He has created it (Ps. 10:11). For by Him all things were created that are

in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him (Col. 1:16). You are worthy, O Lord, to receive glory and honor and power; for You created all things, and by Your will they exist and were created (Rev. 4:11)! As a fellow worker in **Christ** (Rom. 16:3), a fellow-worker of God (1 Cor. 3:9), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that **Christ** might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), and their nation (Math. 21:43) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23, Eph. 1:18), we claim Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), their family (Acts 13:26), their children and their children's children (Prov. 11:21) as ur joint inheritance (Eph. 1:18) with their Lord Jesus Christ (Gal. 4:7). By the Ancient of Days, judgment was made in favor of the saints of the Most-High, and the time has come for the saints to possess the kingdom (Dan. 7:22). Awake, you who sleep, arise from the dead, and **Christ** will give you light; awake to righteousness, and do not sin! And do this, knowing the time, that now it is high time to awake out of sleep; for now, our salvation is near (Rom. 13:11)! Come near, you nations, to hear; and heed, you people! Let the earth hear, and all that is in it, the world and all things that come forth from it (Is. 34:1)! In *Christ* (John 16:23) we pray that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) in one accord (Acts 1:14) will pray for the peace of Jerusalem for it is written: "May they prosper who love you" (Ps. 122:6). The LORD bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) out of Zion, and may they see the good of Jerusalem all the days of their life (Ps. 128:5). As kings and priests of the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (Rev. 1:6), we decree Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) shall stand (2 Chr. 11:13) with Israel against the ungodly nations (Ezek. 13:5) for their shield belongs to the LORD, and their king to the Holy One of Israel (Psalm 89:18).

Thank You Lord for all of Your blessings and in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23) and by His name and His authority and by the grace of God, in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we declare it so (Mark 11:23). In the name of our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), He who has the keys of Hades and of Death (Rev. 1:18) we ask and receive all these things (Math. 7:7). Concerning this prayer of faith (James 5:15) that we pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with them (Matt. 18:19), with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). Being of one accord in prayer (Acts 1:14), we pray (James 5:16) with confidence (1 John 5:14) for

God's thoughts towards Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are thoughts of peace, to give them a future and a hope (Jer. 29:11). As a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ, to bear His name (Acts 9;15), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to them (Luke 11:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Praise the LORD (Ps. 149:9)! It is written: "My covenant I will not break, nor alter the word that has gone out of My lips." says the Lord God Almighty **Psalms 89:34**. God is watching over His word to perform it Jerimiah. 1:12 and it shall not return to Him void; but it shall accomplish His purpose and succeed in the thing for which He sent it **Isaiah** 55:11. The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word **Joel 2:11!** The counsel of the Lord stands forever, the plans of His heart to all generations **Psalms**. **33:1**. It shall come to pass that whoever calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved. For in Mount Zion and in Jerusalem there shall be deliverance, as the Lord has said, among the remnant whom the Lord calls Joel 2:32. "For My name shall be great among the nations," says the Lord of hosts Malachi. 1:11. We ask our Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) in the name of their *Lord Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who gave Himself for us, that He might purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works (Titus 2:14), believing that Our Children (Is. 61:9), their descendants (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) receive all we ask for them (Mark 11:24), knowing that it is the will of God and He hears us (1 John 5:14 You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of Your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! In <u>Jesus'</u> (John 16:23) name so be it (Mark 11:23). Amen

Inasmuch as there is none like You, O Lord, (You are great, and Your name is great in might), who would not fear You, O King of the nations? For this is Your rightful due, for among all the wise men of the nations, and in all their kingdoms, there is none like You (Jer. 10:6-7). Blessed be the name of God forever and ever, for wisdom and might are His (Dan. 2:20). By the blood of the everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20), in the awesome name (Deut. 28:58) of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 14:11), the mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24), we activate (Math 16:19) these Prophetic Scriptures (Rom. 16:25-27) in the lives of Our Children (Is. 61:9). These things says the Amen, the Faithful and True Witness, the Beginning of the

creation of God: Amen! (Rev. 3:14). For all the promises of God in Him are Yes, and in Him Amen, to the glory of God! (2 Cor. 1:20)!In *Jesus*' (John 16:23) name so be it (Mark 11:23). Amen
