Integrity and Reputation



For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth. He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord (Ps. 33:4). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt.

6:9). We are washed, we are sanctified, we are justified in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and by the Spirit of our God (1 cor. 6:11) so in His redeeming name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, we speak words of life over you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your family on every side (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2), your land and your nation. For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is <u>Jesus Christ</u> (1 cor. 3:11) so in the miraculous name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for your entire family, your friends, neighbors and countrymen(1 Tim. 2:1-2), for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all the leaders throughout the world and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

The *Lord Jesus Christ* be with your spirit. Grace be with you (2 Tim. 4:22). Hear a just cause, O Lord, attend to our cry; give ear to our prayer. Let our vindication come from Your presence; let Your eyes look on the things that are upright (Ps. 17:1-2)! In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 14:13,16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), Lord of both the dead and the living (Rom. 14:9), according to His promise (2 Pet. 3:13) may the Lord make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) people of integrity, according to His standards (Is. 49:22). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 14:13,16:23), an everlasting light (Is. 60:19), may God your helper (Ps. 54:4), vindicate you (Ps. 26:1 and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and teach you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to walk in integrity and trust in the Lord, and you shall not slip (Ps. 26:1). God's counsel is your sound wisdom, understanding and strength (Prov. 8:14). According to the hope of eternal life (Titus 3:7), let the Lord help you and your family (Acts 13:26) walk in His spirit of truth at all times (John 16:13) and act on it with confidence (Acts 28:31,), for the Lord will be your confidence, and keep your foot from being caught (Prov. 3:26); in quietness and

confidence shall be your strength (ls. 30:15). For is not your reverence your confidence? And the integrity of your ways your hope (Job 4:6)? May the Lord write mercy and truth in your hearts and let you find favor and high esteem in the sight of God and man (Prov. 3:3-4). According to His name (Ps. 48:10) let the Lord our God (Math. 4:10) give you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 sam. 6:21) a good name and loving favor (Prov. 22:1). With favor, let the Lord surround you and your family (Acts 13:26) as with a shield (Ps. 5:12). Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify our Father in heaven (Matt. 5:16). May the God of peace (Rom. 15:33, Rom. 16:20) create in you and your people (Ps. 148:14) a clean heart and renew a steadfast spirit within you (Ps. 51:10). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) will be known as people walking in truth (2 John 4), walking in *Christ Jesus the Lord*, rooted and built up in Him, and established in the faith, abounding in it with thanksgiving (Col. 2:6-). The God of hope (Rom. 15:13) make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) known as a God fearing people (Ps. 61:5), righteous, (Hos. 14:9), loving (Gal. 5:22), just, (Prov. 3:33, 7:9), peaceful (Gal. 5:22), people of integrity (Prov. 10:9), truthful (Prov. 12:19), wise (Eph. 5:15), filled with the Holy Spirit (John 16:13), steadfast, (Heb. 6:19) grounded (Eph. 3: 17), solid, prudent (Hos. 14:9), diligent (Prov. 7:15, Prov. 11:27), honest and honorable in the sight of the Lord and men (2 Cor. 8:21), brave, strong (1 Cor. 16:13), and humble (Mic. 6:8), diligently seeking good (Prov. 11:27), diligently seeking God's face (Ps. 7:15) and finding favor (Ps. 5:12) in His eyes (Ps. 11:4). God of our salvation (Ps. 25:5) make you and your family (Acts 13:26) blameless and upright people, people who fear God and shun evil. In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you and yours will hold fast to your integrity (Job 2:3). You and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall be known as people who have clean hands, and pure hearts, who have not lifted up your souls into vanity, nor sworn deceitfully (Ps. 24:4), nor taken reward against the innocent (Ps. 15:5). Let you hear, and let you take it to heart, to give glory to His name (Mal. 2:2)! For the Son of Man will come in the glory of His Father with His angels,

and then He will reward each according to his works (Matt. 16:27)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), a precious corner stone (Is. 28:16), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) are grounded (Col. 1:23), steadfast and immovable (1 Cor. 15:58) stable (James 1:8), that the foundation of your faith be built on the rock (Luke 6:48) of <u>Jesus</u> (Luke 20:17), that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) are not double minded (James 1:7-8), but your yes means yes and your no means no (Matt. 5:37). In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) are not conformed to this world (Rom. 12:2), instead you and your people (Ps. 148:14) are being transformed into the image of God from glory to glory (2 Cor. 3:18), your inward person being renewed day by day (2 Cor. 4:16) through *Christ Jesus* for you and your family (Acts 13:26) are partakers of the divine nature of God, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:4), not thinking of yourselves more highly than you ought to think, but to think soberly, for God has dealt to each one a measure of faith (Rom. 12:3). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) not worry about what people think, let no man judge you for your substance is of Christ (Col. 2:16-17). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will serve God acceptably with reverence and godly fear (Heb. 12:28) in sincerity and in truth (Josh. 24:14), being gentle to all, able to teach, patient, in humility correcting those who are in opposition to God (2 Tim. 2:24-25). According to the measure of *Christ's* gift (Eph. 4.7) may you shepherd your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) according to the integrity of your heart, and guide your family (Acts 13:26) by the skillfulness of your hands (Ps. 78:72). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) be self-controlled (Gal. 5:22), not being tossed to and fro and carried about with every wind of doctrine, nor by the trickery of men, in cunning and craftiness of deceitful plotting, but, speaking the truth in love, growing in all things into Him who is the head – *Christ Jesus* (Eph. 4:14-15). The Lord, our God, He shall gather all nations and tongues; and you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall come and see His glory. (Is. 66:18). The Lord lives; in truth, in judgment, and in righteousness; the nations (your family) shall bless themselves in Him, and in Him they shall glory (Jer. 4:2)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) ponder the path of your feet, and let all your ways be established. You shall not turn to the right or the left; but remove your foot from evil (Prov. 4:26-27). May you and your family (Acts 13:26) walk in your integrity (Ps. 26:11), securely (Prov. 10:9), letting your integrity guide you (Prov. 11:3). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) walk before God in integrity of heart and in uprightness (1 Kin. 9:4), that God may know your integrity (Job 31:6). Let integrity and uprightness preserve you (Ps. 25:21) and your family (Acts 13:26) and your children shall be blessed after you (Prov. 20:7). Give God the glory (John 9:24)!

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), who became for you wisdom from God and righteousness and sanctification and redemption (1 Cor. 1:30), in <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that your thoughts are right and your mouth is upright (Prov. 12:5-6). Surely, goodness and mercy will follow you and your people (Ps. 148:14) all the days of your lives (Ps. 23:6). Let you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) stand firm against the wiles of the devil (Eph. 6:11) and the lust of the flesh, lusts of the eve, and the pride of life (1 John 2:16). The Lord God, merciful and gracious, longsuffering, and abundant in goodness and truth (Ex. 34:6), help you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be blameless and upright, fear God and shun evil always and hold fast to your integrity (Job 2:3). Your steps are ordered by the Lord, and He delights in your way. Though you fall, you shall not be utterly cast down; for the Lord upholds you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with His hand (Ps. 37:23-24). May the Lord uphold you and your people (Ps. 148:14) in your integrity, and set you before His face forever (Ps. 41:12). Let it be that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are known as a good, gentle, kind, loving, patient, faithful, self-controlled people (Gal. 5:22-23); for a tree is known by its fruit (Matt. 12:33). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) be sober-minded, in all things showing yourselves to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility, sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you (Titus 2:6-8) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). May you be people of good reputation, fearing God, just (Acts 10:22) and full of the Holy Spirit and wisdom (Acts 6:3). Surely you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will be an example to the believers in word, in conduct, in love, in spirit, in faith, in purity (1 Tim. 4:12). May the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17) not remember the sins of your youth, nor your transgressions (Ps. 25:7), but instead remove your transgressions as far as the east is from the west (Ps. 103:12). Let the past be the past, old things have passed away (2 Cor. 5:17), therefore in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) We pray (James 5:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) will forget those things which are behind and reach forward to those things which are ahead, pressing toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus (Phil 3:13-14). To Him, Jesus Christ, was given dominion and glory and a kingdom, that all peoples, nations, and languages should serve Him. His dominion is an everlasting dominion, which shall not pass away, and His kingdom the one which shall not be destroyed (Dan. 7:14).

In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 14:13,16:23), you are washed, you are sanctified, you are justified in the name of the <u>Lord Jesus</u> and by the Spirit of our God (1 Cor. 6:11), therefore let those be driven backward and brought to dishonor who wish you and your house Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) evil (Ps. 40:14). May the God of your defense, the God of your mercy (Ps. 59:17), hide you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) from the secret plots of the wicked, from the rebellion of the workers of iniquity, who sharpen their tongues like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows - bitter words (Ps. 64:2); the Lord make

them stumble over their own tongues and flee away (Ps. 64:8). Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, so a curse without cause shall not alight (Prov. 26-2). God, your Strength (Ps. 59:17), will not let you and your family (Acts 13:26) be ashamed, for in *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we have called upon Him; let the wicked be ashamed; let them be silent in the grave. Let the lying lips be put to silence, which speak insolent things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous (Ps. 31:17-18). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the God of justice (Is. 30:18) will plead your cause with those who strive with you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); fight against those who fight against you (Ps. 35:1) and your people (Ps. 148:14). May the God of your praise (Ps. 109:1) bless those who bless you and curse those who curse you, you and your bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21); and in your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) may your family (Acts 13:26) be blessed (Gen. 12:3). As for you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), you shall serve the Lord (Josh. 24:15), and Him only you shall serve (Luke 4:8). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 14:13,16:23), by His blood we are made near (Eph. 2:13), in Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord God of hosts (2 Sam. 5:10) will deliver you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and honor you (Ps. 91:15), exalt you (Ps. 75:7), and may you and your people (Ps. 148:14) possess a good name (Eccl. 7:1). When the Son of Man comes in His glory, and all the holy angels with Him (Matt. 25:31), we will see the Son of Man coming on the clouds of heaven with power and great glory (Matt. 24:30), then He will sit on the throne of His glory (Matt. 25:31). Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men (Luke 2:14)! Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest (Luke 19:38)!

Abiding in the love of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 15:9), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our <u>Lord Jesus</u> <u>Christ</u> (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, through whom are all things, and through whom we live (1 Cor. 8:6), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who

is our rock (Ps. 18:2), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. Yea, though we walk through the valley of the shadow of death, we will fear no evil; for You are with us; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort us. You prepare a table before us in the presence of our enemies; You anoint our head with oil; our cup runs over (Ps. 23:4-5).

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In Jesus' name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
