



## Judgment

You, O Lord, love righteousness and justice; the earth is full of all Your goodness (Ps. 33:5). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, He Himself is our peace (Eph. 2:14) so in His all-consuming name we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of **Jesus Christ**, who delivers us from the wrath to come (1 Thess. 1:10), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that **Christ**, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), who is the Messenger of the covenant (Mal. 3:1), we pray (James 5:16) that the Father in heaven (Math. 6:9) bless you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and keep you (Num. 6:24). Glory to God in the Highest, our Father, and on earth peace, good will toward men (Luke 2:14)! O our God, we cry in the daytime, and in the night season, we are not silent. You are holy, who inhabit our praise (Ps. 22:2-3)! For You, O Lord, have not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; nor have You hidden Your face from us; but when we cry to You, You hear (Ps. 22:24). To you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in God the Father and the **Lord Jesus Christ**. Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the **Lord Jesus Christ**. We give thanks to God always for you all, making mention of you in our prayers (1 Thess. 1:1-4).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) for you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to come out of Babylon, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues (Rev. 18:4), and in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Father (Math. 6:9) and our God that He render to her (Babylon) just as she renders to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and repay her double according to her works; in the cup which

she has mixed, mix double for her (Rev 18:6). Worthy is the Lamb that was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom and strength and honor, and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), Lord of both the dead and the living (Rom. 14:9), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) for those among you and your people (Ps. 148:14) that do not know the Lord, and those among you that walk in darkness; yes, in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and all your people (Ps. 148:14) will see a great light, the light of **Jesus Christ**, and those among you who dwell in the land of the shadow of death, upon you and all your people (Ps. 148:14) a light shall shine (Is. 9-2). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord (Luke 4:18). This day in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father (Math. 6:9) that your burden will be taken away from your shoulders and lifted from your hearts, and Satan's yoke from your necks, and the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil (Is. 10:27). Abiding in **Jesus** (John 15:4) and in the love of God (1 John 4:16) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will take **Jesus'** yoke upon you and learn from Him, for He is gentle and lowly in heart, and you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will find rest for your souls. Those of you who have left your first love, may the Lord convict you, so that you may repent and return to your first works (Rev. 2:4-5). May the Lord make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) increase and abound in love to one another and to all, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ**, and may you and your family (Acts 13:26) stand with all His saints in glory (1 Thess. 3:12:13). May God the Father knit you together in love with each other (Col. 2:2), and with God the Father, **Christ** the Son, the Holy Spirit and all the saints (Eph. 1:15). Being knit together in love, in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will attain all riches of the full assurance of understanding, to the knowledge of the mystery of God, both of God the Father and of **Christ** the Son, in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge (Col. 2:2:3). Let wisdom enter your hearts, and knowledge be pleasant to your souls, discretion will preserve you and yours; understanding will keep you and your family (Acts 13:26), and deliver you and your people (Ps. 148:14) from the way of evil (Prov. 2:10-12). Nothing wicked shall cling to you or your people (Ps. 148:14). A perverse heart shall depart from you and your people (Ps. 148:14); you and your family (Acts 13:26) will not know wickedness (Ps. 101:3-4). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) God, our faithful healer (Ex. 15:26), will cleanse you from secret faults (Ps. 19:12). According to His new covenant (Heb. 8:13), may the Lord our God keep back you and your children (Ps. 103:17) from

presumptuous sin; let sin not have dominion over you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Then you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall be blameless, and you shall be innocent of great transgression (Ps. 19:13). Let you and yours be joined to the Lord and one spirit with Him (1 Cor. 6:17), entwined in the vine of life, abiding in **Jesus Christ** and Him in you, bearing much fruit (John 15:5). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are blessed, that you will diligently obey the voice of the Lord our God (Duet. 28:1-2), set your hope in God, and not forget the works of God, but keep His commandments (Ps. 78:7) and keep the sayings of the prophecy (Rev. 22:7), so that you may have right to the tree of life, and may enter in through the gates into the city (Rev. 22:14). According to the eternal purpose (Eph. 3:11), may the God of gods and Lord of lords (Deut. 10:17) give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) an ear, that you can hear what the Spirit says, that you will overcome and eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God (Rev. 2:7). Let Him make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) like a tree planted by the rivers of God, that brings forth its fruit in its season, whose leaf also shall not wither; and whatever you do shall prosper (Ps. 1:3). He has sent redemption to His people; our God has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name (Ps. 111:9)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will not tolerate any among you that hold to the doctrine of Balaam, to put stumbling blocks before the children of God, and encourage the worship of idols, and to commit sexual immorality (Rev. 2:14). God grant you and your family (Acts 13:26) repentance to life (Acts 11:18), that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will worship the Lord our God, and Him only shall you serve (Luke 4:8). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask in the name **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), that God grant (Eph. 3:16) you and your family (Acts 13:26) discernment between the holy and the unholy, and cause you to discern between the clean and the unclean (Ezek. 44:23), being convicted by your conscience (John 8:9) into repentance towards God and faith toward our **Lord Jesus Christ** (Acts 20:21). May the God of justice (Is. 30:18) bring you and your family (Acts 13:26) by a way that you did not know; and lead you and your people (Ps. 148:14) in paths you have not known. May the Lord make darkness light before you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and crooked places straight. These things He will do for you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and not forsake you and your family (Acts 13:26). You and yours shall be turned back, you shall be greatly ashamed, who trust in the idols of this world (Is. 42:16-17). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14)

cast off the workings of darkness and put on the armor of light (Rom. 13:12). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will have an ear to hear the voice of the Spirit and that you will repent (Rev. 2:17). According to all that the Lord has bestowed on you and your people (Ps. 148:14), and the great goodness toward your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), which He has bestowed on you according to His mercies, according to the multitude of His loving kindnesses (Is. 63:7), the Lord grant you and your people (Ps. 148:14) (Acts 4:29) the boldness to enter the Holiest by the blood of **Jesus**, by a new and living way which He consecrated for you, through the veil, that is, His flesh, and having a High Priest over the house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) of God, let you and your family (Acts 13:26) draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having your hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and your bodies washed with pure water (Heb. 10:19-22). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will overcome and receive the hidden manna to eat. That you will receive a white stone, and on the stone a new name written which no one knows except you who receive it (Rev. 2:17). God shall bless you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him (Ps. 67:7). The Lord is your strength and song. And He has become your salvation (Ps. 118:14). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) the voice of rejoicing and salvation is in your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); the right hand of the Lord does valiantly (Ps. 118:15). The right hand of the Lord is exalted; the right hand of the Lord does valiantly (Ps. 118:16). Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the Lord our God (Ps. 20:7). O Lord, our Lord, how excellent is Your name in all the earth (Ps. 8:9), You who set Your glory above the heavens (Ps. 8:1)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the King of the saints (Rev. 15:3), where you and your family (Acts 13:26) have allowed that woman Jezebel, who calls herself a prophetess, to teach and seduce God's servants (Rev. 2:20), His children (Phil. 2:14-15), and His friends (Luke 12:4, John 15:14) to commit sexual immorality and to eat things sacrificed to idols (Rev. 2:20). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) for discernment that you shall discern between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him (Mal. 3:18) and for revelation from **Jesus Christ** (Gal. 1:12). May the Holy Spirit bring to you and your family conviction of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgment (John 16:8), if perhaps God will grant repentance, so that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may know the truth; will escape the snares of the devil, and will not be taken captive by him to do his will (2 Tim 2:25). With the spirit and power of Elijah (Luke 1:17, Mark 9:12), in the

power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13.), by the authority of **Jesus Christ** (Matt. 28:18) let you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) arise in the anointing (2 Kin 9:6) and indignation of Jehu (2 Kin. 9:22) and cast Jezebel down (2 Kin. 9:33) also all who eat at her table (1 Kin. 18:19), and trample them beneath your feet (2 Kin. 9:33). For **Jesus Christ**, who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), has given you and your family (Acts 13:26) the authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you (Luke 10:19) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will lift your voices to God with one accord (Acts 4:24), and cast the Spirit of Jezebel from your lives, cast down her evil imaginations from your minds, and tear down and destroy all sympathetic strongholds toward Jezebel and her ways (2 Cor. 10:4-5), bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of **Christ** (2 Cor. 10:5). In the power of **Jesus'** name (Acts 4:12) we loose and release you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14) from her psychic grip on your souls (Matt. 16:19), and we stand against all soul power (Mark 8:37, 36:37) that does not glorify the name of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (John 12:28, Rom. 1:21). Jezebel, in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), He who was ordained by God to be Judge of the living and the dead (Acts 10:42), and by His authority, your captives, Jezebel, are released (delivered) (Luke 4:18) and your slaves set free; therefore, if the son makes you free, you shall be free indeed (John 8:36)! In the power of **Jesus'** name Jezebel's power and her hold over you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) is broken and all of her works destroyed. Likewise, you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are set free from doctrine of Balaam; you and your people (Ps. 148:14) are set free from the stumbling blocks that have been set before you; you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) are set free from worship of idols, the worship of fame, power, and wealth; and you and yours are set free from the desire and temptation to commit sexual immorality (Rev. 2:14). You and your family (Acts 13:26) are set free from the seductress who lies in wait (Prov. 23:28) to snare the righteous (Ex. 34:12). For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8). We bind the kings with chains, and the nobles with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment - this honor have all His saints (Ps. 149:8-9). We call on the name of the Lord; and the God that answers with fire, He is God (1 Kin. 18:24). The Lord gives voice before His army, for His camp is very great; for strong is the One who executes His word (Joel 2:11)! Therefore, since you and your people (Ps. 148:14) are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let you have grace, by which you may serve God acceptably with

reverence and godly fear. For our God is a consuming fire (Heb. 12:28-29)! In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14) will overcome the spirit of Jezebel and the doctrine of Balaam, and keep God's works until the end, that you will receive God's power, and the "morning star" will rise in your hearts (Rev. 2:26-28). Holy, Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty, who was, and is, and is to come (Rev. 4:8)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), King of glory (Ps. 24:7), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Father that is in heaven (Math. 6:9) to keep you and your people (Ps. 148:14) from defiling your garments so that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may walk with Him in white. That you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) will be worthy in His eyes (Rev. 3:4). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your people (Ps. 148:14) will be blessed for you will watch, and keep your garments, lest you walk naked (Rev. 16:15). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will have an ear to hear the Spirit (Rev. 3:6) and that you will overcome, and shall be clothed in white garments and that God will not blot out your names out of the Book of Life (Rev. 3:5), but our **Lord Jesus Christ** will confess your names before God the Father and before His angels (Rev 3:4-6). You are worthy, **O Lord Jesus**, to take the book, and to open the seals thereof: for You was slain, and You have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every kindred, and tongue, and people, and nation, and have made us unto our God kings and priests (Rev. 5:9-10). Now to the King eternal, immortal, invisible, to God who alone is wise, be honor and glory forever and ever (1 Tim. 1:17)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the righteous Judge (2 Tim. 4:8), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the Lord our God will set before you and your people (Ps. 148:14) an open door, and no one can shut it (Rev. 3:8); and you and your family (Acts 13:26) will awake and put on strength, and be the arm of the Lord, as in the ancient days (Is. 51:9). May you and your family (Acts 13:26) keep His Word in all things and not deny His name (Rev. 3:8), and may the Father of mercies and the God of all comfort (2 Cor. 1:3) keep you and your people (Ps. 148:14) from the hour of trial which shall come upon the whole world (Rev. 3:10). According to His own purpose and grace which was given to you and your family (Acts 13:26) in **Christ Jesus** before time began (2 Tim. 1:9), may God, your helper (Ps. 54:4), help you and your family (Acts 13:26) to hold fast to what you have, that no one may take your crown (Rev. 3:11). Let the God of peace, Himself (1 Thess. 5:23), give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) an ear to hear the Spirit so that you will overcome, that you and yours will become pillars in the

temple of our God (Rev. 3:12). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the **Lord Jesus Christ**, O King of the nations (Jer. 10:7), will write upon you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the name of His God, and the name of the city of His God, and he will write upon you and yours His new name (Rev. 3:12). You are worthy, O God, to receive glory and honor and power: for you have created all things, and for your pleasure, they are and were created (Rev. 4:11)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the true Light which gives light to every man who comes into the world (John 1:9), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that the North Gate of heaven will open and the glory of the Lord (Ezek. 8:3-4) shall pass over you and your family (Acts 13:26) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and be filled with the brightness of the Lord's glory (Ezek. 10:4). For the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea (Is. 11:9). May the Father of mercies (2 Cor. 1:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your people (Ps. 148:14), His mercy seat (Heb. 9:5), and let His fire stretch across your land (Luke 12:49); the fire of God shall set upon each of you (Acts 2:3); having the glory of God your light is like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal (Rev. 21:11). The Glory of God shall illuminate you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), the Lamb is your light (Rev. 21:23). Let His fire fall upon you and your people (Ps. 148:14), may tongues of heavenly fire rest on your heads (Acts 2:3). May the God of the holy prophets (Rev. 22:6) kindle the fire of **Jesus** in your hearts (Luke 12:49) and hold you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) back from becoming lukewarm and being spit out of His mouth (Rev. 3:16). May the God of the living (Mark 12:27) sell to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the gold refined in fire, that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may be rich; and white garments, that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed (Rev. 3:18). Let the God of all grace (1 Pet. 5:10) anoint your eyes with eye salve that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may see (Rev. 3:18). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will hear His voice and open the door, that He will come in to you and dine with you and your family (Acts 13:26), and be with you (Rev. 3:20) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Blessed is your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and all of your people (Ps. 148:14), who are called to the marriage supper of the Lamb (Rev. 19:9)! In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you, your people (Ps. 148:14) and your descendants after you (Prov. 11:21) will have an ear to hear the Spirit, that you all will overcome and **Jesus** will grant you to sit with Him on His Throne, as He also overcame, and sat down with His Father on His throne (Rev. 3:21).

Blessing and honor, and glory, and power, be unto Him that sits upon the throne, and unto the Lamb forever and ever (Rev. 5:13)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), Lord of the harvest (Matt. 9:38), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your people (Ps. 148:14) will be sealed with the seal of the living God (Rev. 7:2), as the servants of our God on your foreheads (Rev. 7:3); and that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will come out of all your tribulation, and wash your robes and make them white in the blood of the lamb (Rev. 7:14). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that as you and your people (Ps. 148:14) are tested, that you and yours are faithful until death (Rev. 2:10); that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will endure all temptation, be proven (James 1:12), and receive the crown of life (Rev. 2:10), which the Lord has promised to those who love Him (James 1:12). Let all your names be found written in the Lamb's book of life (Rev. 20:15) from the foundation of the world (Rev. 17:8). The gates of New Jerusalem shall not be shut to you (Rev. 21:25), for you are written in the Lamb's Book of Life (Rev. 21:27). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will overcome by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of your testimony, and you will not love your lives to the death (Rev. 12:11). By the grace of God (1 Cor. 15:10), you and yours shall die in the Lord and be blessed (Rev. 14:13); God grant mercy to your household (2 Tim. 1:16), according to the hope of eternal life (Titus 3:7), that you and your family (Acts 13:26) rest from your labors and your works shall follow you (Rev. 14:13). Each one of you will receive his own reward according to his own labor (1 Cor. 3:8). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) fear the Lord, walk in His ways; then when you eat the labor of your hands, you shall be happy, and it shall be well with you (Ps. 128:1-2) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God will make you and your people (Ps. 148:14) new (Rev. 21:5), new creations, old things have passed away, all things have become new (2 Cor. 5:17); so that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall drink from the pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding from the throne of God and of the Lamb (Rev. 22:1). For **Jesus Christ**, the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, will give of the fountain of the water of life freely to him who thirsts (Rev 21:6). Therefore, with joy, you and your family (Acts 13:26) will draw water from the wells of salvation (Is. 12:3), and out of your hearts shall flow rivers of living water (John 7:38). According to the eternal purpose which He accomplished in **Christ Jesus**, our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through faith in Him (Eph. 3:11), you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall overcome and not be hurt by the second death (Rev. 2:11). Blessed and holy is your



house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), you and all of your people (Ps. 148:14), for you shall take part in the first resurrection: over such the second death has no power, but you and yours shall be priests of God and of **Christ**, and shall reign with Him a thousand years (Rev. 20:6). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will overcome and inherit all things (Rev. 21:7). His Name is called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Is. 9:6), He will be your God and you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will be His sons and daughters (Rev. 21:7). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will come out from among them and be separate; and that you will not touch anything unclean, and God will receive you. "I will be a Father to you, and you shall be My sons and daughters", says the Lord Almighty (2 Cor. 6:17-18). In the name of **Jesus** (John 16:23) and by His authority let it be so (Mark 11:23). Blessing and glory, and wisdom, and thanksgiving, and honor, and power, and might, be unto our God forever and ever (Rev. 7:12)!

Abiding in the doctrine of **Christ** (2 John 1:9), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Thess. 5:23). There is none holy like the Lord, for there is none besides Him, nor is there any rock like our God (1 Sam. 2:2) so in the name of **Jesus Christ** and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
