He will fulfill the desire of those who fear Him; He also will hear their cry and save them (Ps. 145:4). Blessed is the glory of the Lord from His place! (Ezek. 3:12). Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name.

Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9). In the mighty and awesome name of **Jesus Christ** our savior (Titus 1:4) we speak words of life over you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of your family on every side (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2), your land and your nation. According to the eternal purpose (Eph 3:1), and in the exceedingly great name of **Jesus Christ**, as the truth is in Him (Eph. 4:21), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for your entire family, your friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2), for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all the leaders throughout the world and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). The words that **Christ**, through us speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), Lord even of the Sabbath (Matt.12:8), the Father in heaven bless you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and keep you (Num. 6:24). We are called by Your name (Jer. 14:9), O Lord; You are our God, we are the people of Your pasture and the sheep of Your hand (Ps. 95:7, 79:13); save Your people, and bless Your inheritance; Shepherd us also, and bear us up forever (Ps. 28:9). Hear, O Lord, our voice, O God, in your meditation; preserve our life from fear of the enemy (Ps. 64:1). We seek the Lord, and He hears us, and delivers us from all our fears (Ps. 34:4). Fear not, for you and your people (Ps. 148:14) have been redeemed; you have been called by name; you belong to the Lord. When you pass through the waters, God will be with you; and through the rivers, they shall not overflow you. When you walk through the fire, you shall not be burned, nor shall the flame scorch you. For the Lord, our God, the Holy One of Israel, our Savior (Is. 43:1-3) is with you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). God will never leave you nor forsake you (Duet. 31:6, Heb. 13:5). The Lord is your rock and your salvation; God is your defense; you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall not be moved. In God

is your salvation and your glory; the rock of your strength, and your refuge is in God (Ps. 62:6-7). Yes, the Lord is your rock and your fortress and your deliverer; your God, your strength, in whom you and your family (Acts 13:26) will trust; your shield and the horn of your salvation, your stronghold (Ps. 18:2). Neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, nor height nor depth, nor any other created thing, shall be able to separate you and your family (Acts 13:26) from the love of God which is in **Christ Jesus our Lord** (Rom. 8:38). God shall redeem your souls from the power of the grave, for He shall receive you (Ps. 49:15) and your people (Ps. 148:14). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) sanctify the Lord God in your hearts (1 Pet. 3:15), knowing that you are redeemed (1 Pet. 1:18) with the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19). Most certainly you and your people (Ps. 148:14) have been released from the fear of death which brought you subject to bondage (Heb. 2:15). For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8). For you and your people (Ps. 148:14) did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear, but you received the Spirit of adoption by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father" (Rom. 8:15), for you and yours are children of God (Rom. 8:16) and joint heirs with **Christ**, that you may also be glorified together with **Christ** (Rom. 8:17). For it is our Father's good pleasure to give you and your family (Acts 13:26) the kingdom (Luke 12:32) which cannot be shaken (Heb. 12:28). The Lord God will ever be mindful of His covenant (Ps. 111:5). He has commanded His covenant forever: Holy and awesome is His name (Ps. 111:9)!

God has not given you and your family (Acts 13:26) a spirit of fear, but of power and love and of a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7). **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16:23), He who has the keys of Hades and of Death (Rev. 1:18), in His mighty name (Jer. 32:18) you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall be secure in the fact that **Jesus Christ** has given you authority to trample on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy, and nothing shall by any means hurt you (Luke 10:19). You and yours are complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10). You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall bind the kings of evil with chains, and the nobles with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment - this honor have all His saints (Ps. 149:8-9), having strong confidence (Prov. 14:26) that whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven (Matt. 18:18). No weapon formed against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall prosper, and every tongue which rises against you in judgment, shall be condemned (Is. 54:17). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people

(Ps. 148:14) will seek the Lord, and He will hear you, and deliver you from all of your fears (Ps. 34:4). May you and your family (Acts 13:26) have no fear but be secure in the knowledge that the Lord is your helper (Heb. 13:6). By the blood of **Jesus**, in righteousness, you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear, and from terror, for it shall not come near you (Is. 54:14). Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You! Oh, let the nations be glad and sing for joy! For You shall judge the people righteously and govern the nations on earth! Selah! Let the peoples praise You, O God; let all the peoples praise You! Then the earth shall yield its increase; God, our own God, shall bless you. God shall bless you and your children after you, and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him (Ps. 67:3-7)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), He who lives, and was dead, and behold, he lives forevermore (Rev. 1:18), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your children (Ps. 72:4) shall not be afraid of the terror by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day, nor of the pestilence that walks in darkness, nor of the destruction that lays waste at noonday. A thousand may fall at your side, and ten thousand at your right hand; but it shall not come near you (Ps. 91:5-7). You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall not fear, nor be dismayed, for the Lord our God is with you. He will strengthen you, yes, He will help you, He will uphold you with His righteous right hand (Is. 41:10); and if your foot slips may the mercy of God comfort you and delight your soul (Ps. 94:18-19). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), may the peace of **Jesus Christ** be with you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and let not your hearts be troubled, neither let you be afraid (John 14:27); for He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world (1 John 4:4); and those who are with you are more than those who are against you (2 Kin. 6:16). Let you be of good cheer, for **Jesus Christ** has overcome the world (John 16:33). Let the heavens declare His righteousness, for God Himself is Judge! Selah (Ps. 50:6)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the fountain of living waters (Jer. 2:13) springing up into everlasting life (John 4:13-14), in His name may the love of God be poured out in your hearts by the Holy Spirit (Rom. 5:5). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that God would grant (1 Sam. 1:17) you, according to the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), to be strengthened with might through His Spirit in the inner man, that **Christ** may dwell in your hearts through faith; that you and your family (Acts 13:26), being rooted and grounded in love, be able to comprehend with all the saints what is the width and length and depth and height - to know the love of **Christ** which passes knowledge; that you and yours may

be filled with all the fullness of God (Eph. 3:16-19). By the perfect love of the Holy Spirit may all fear be cast out (1 John 4:18). Sing to Him a new song; play skillfully with a shout of joy! For the word of the Lord is right, and all His work is done in truth! He loves righteousness and justice; the earth is full of the goodness of the Lord! By the word of the Lord the heavens were made, and all the host of them by the breath of His mouth! He gathers the waters of the sea together as a heap; He lays up the deep in storehouses. Let all the earth fear the Lord; let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of Him. For He spoke, and it was done; He commanded, and it stood fast (Ps. 33:3-9).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), your strength in whom you shall trust (Ps. 18:2), you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall be strong and of good courage, you shall not fear nor be afraid; for the Lord your God, He is the One who goes with you (Deut. 31:6). You shall not fear or be discouraged (Deut. 1:21) for the Lord God Himself fights for you (Deut. 3:22). The Lord will cause your enemies who rise against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to be defeated before your face; they shall come out against you one way and flee before you seven ways (Deut. 28:7). For God, the Judge of all (Heb. 12:23), has struck all your enemies on the cheekbone; He has broken the teeth of the ungodly. Salvation belongs to the Lord. His blessing is upon His people (Ps. 3:7-8). According to the exceeding greatness of His power (Ps. 79:11, Eph. 1:19, 2 Tim. 1:8) the Lord deliver you and yours from every evil work and preserve you and yours for His heavenly kingdom (2 Tim. 4:18). According to all His wonderful works (Jer. 21:2) may the Highest (Luke 6:35) plead your cause with those who strive with you; fight against those who fight against you (Ps. 35:1) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). May God your helper (Ps. 54:4) take hold of the shield and buckler and stand up for you. Also draw out the spear and stop those who pursue you and your people (Ps. 148:14). Say to your soul "I am your salvation." Let those be put to shame and brought to dishonor who seek after your lives; let those be driven back and brought to confusion and dishonor who plot your hurt, who wish you and yours evil (Ps. 35:1-4, Ps. 40:14). Let them be ashamed and brought to mutual confusion who rejoice at your hurt; who seek to destroy your lives; let them be clothed with shame and dishonor who exalt themselves against you (Ps. 35:26, Ps. 40:14) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Let them be like chaff before the wind and let the angel of the Lord chase them. Let their way be dark and slippery and let the angel of the Lord pursue them (Ps. 35:6). Let destruction come upon them unexpectedly, and let the net they have hidden catch themselves; into that very destruction let them fall (Ps. 35:8). And your soul shall be joyful in the Lord; you and your

family (Acts 13:26) shall rejoice in His salvation (Ps. 35:9)! You, O Lord, have given a banner to those who fear You, that it may be displayed because of the truth! Selah (Ps. 60:4)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Great, the Mighty God, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 32:18), who is great in counsel and mighty in work (Jer. 32:19), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) violence shall no longer be heard in your land, neither wasting nor destruction within your borders; but you shall call your walls Salvation, and your gates Praise (Is. 60:18). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). Surely, you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall be strong, and not fear! Behold, our God will come with a vengeance, with the recompense of God; He will come and save you (Is.35:4) and your people (Ps. 148:14). Show Your marvelous loving kindness by Your right hand, O Lord, You who save those who trust in You from those who rise up against them (Ps. 17:7). May God, whose faithfulness has been established in the very heavens (Ps. 89:2), keep you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) as the apple of His eye; hide you and your people (Ps. 148:14) under the shadow of His wings, from the wicked who oppress you, from the deadly enemies who surround you (Ps. 17:8-9). Let the wicked be ashamed; let them be silent in the grave; let the lying lips be put to silence that say insolent things, proudly and contemptuously against you (Ps. 31:17-18) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). Fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water" (Rev. 14:7)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the King, whose name is the Lord of hosts (Jer. 46:18), hear our voice, O God, in your meditation; let the God of our strength (Ps. 43:2) preserve your life (Ps. 64:1) from fear of the enemy (Ps. 64:1). May the Lord hide you and your family (Acts 13:26) from the secret counsel of the wicked, from the insurrection of the workers of iniquity, who sharpen their tongues like a sword, and bend their bows to shoot their arrows of bitter words, that they may shoot in secret at the blameless (Ps. 64:1-4). For those who are incensed against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall be ashamed and disgraced; they shall be as nothing, and those who strive with you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall perish (Is. 41:11). The Lord preserves all who love Him, but all the wicked He will destroy (Ps. 145:20). The Lord is righteous in all His ways, gracious in all His works (Ps. 145:17). We shall speak of the glory of Your kingdom, O Lord, and talk of Your power, to make known to the sons of men Your mighty acts, and the glorious majesty of Your kingdom. Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and Your dominion endures throughout all

generations (Ps. 145:11-13). The Lord is gracious and full of compassion, slow to anger and great in mercy. The Lord is good to all, and His tender mercies are over all His works (Ps. 145:8-9). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), praise the name of the Lord our God, who has dealt wondrously with you (Joel 2:26), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that in His name the Lord bless those who bless you and curse those who curse you (Gen. 12:3). Truly, your soul silently waits for God; from Him comes your salvation. He only is your rock and your salvation; He is your defense; you shall not be greatly moved (Ps. 62:1-2).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), His name Immanuel, which is translated, "God with us" (Matt. 1:23), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we proclaim that God has not given you a spirit of fear but of power and of love and of a sound mind (2 Tim. 1:7), the mind of **Jesus Christ** (1 Cor. 2:16). You and your people (Ps. 148:14) will not entertain confusion (Ps. 40:14), but the breath of the Almighty will give you understanding (Job 32:8); and you and yours shall walk in the light as **Jesus** is in the light (1 John 1:7). You and your children shall not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good (Rom. 12:21). May you and all of your family (Acts 13:26) commit your way to the Lord, trust also in Him, and He shall bring it to pass. He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, and your justice as the noonday (Ps. 37:5-6). Therefore, let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) submit to God, resist the devil and he will flee from you (James 4:7). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), as the truth is in Him (Eph. 4:21), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that all things covered be revealed and all things hidden be known (Matt. 10:26). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will not doubt (Matt. 14:31) but know the peace of God (Phil. 4:7), and be comforted by the knowledge that God is for you and if God is for you who can be against you (Rom. 8:31); and in all things you and your children (Ps. 102:28) are more than conquerors through Him who loves you (Rom. 8:37) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The God of our **Lord Jesus Christ**, the Father of glory, give to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) the spirit of wisdom and revelation in knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in you and your family (Acts 13:26), and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward you and your family (Acts 13:26) who believe, according to the working of His mighty power (Eph. 1:17-19). You shall fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun (Is. 59:19). The Lord will be to you an everlasting light, and our God your glory (Is. 60:19)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars (Rev. 3:1), in His name may the Spirit of the Lord rest upon you (Is. 11:2) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), the Spirit of truth (John 14:17), the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the Lord (Is. 11:2). According to His name, may God (Ps. 48:10), the habitation of justice (Jer. 50:7), teach you and your people (Ps. 148:14) humility and the fear of the Lord and give you riches and honor and life (Prov. 22:4). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) will not fear man (Prov. 29:25), but you will fear the Lord and gain wisdom (Ps. 111:10). Surely you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall not lack for any good thing (Ps.34:9-10) for the fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever, the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether (Ps. 19:9). The fear of man brings a snare, but whoever trusts in the Lord shall be safe (Prov. 29:25). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall not fear the reproach of men, nor be afraid of their reviling (Is. 51:7). And you and your children Ps. 72:4 shall not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell (Matt. 10:28). Oh, how great is Your goodness, which You have laid up for those who fear You, O Lord, which You have prepared for those who trust in You in the presence of the sons of men (Ps. 31:19)! You shall hide us in the secret place of Your Presence from the plots of man; You shall keep us secretly in a pavilion from the strife of tongues (Ps. 31:20). Blessed be the Lord, for He shows us His marvelous kindness (Ps. 31:21)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the true Light which gives light to every man who comes into the world (John 1:9), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father (Math. 6:9), God of truth and without injustice, righteous and upright is He (Deut. 32:4), to shine in your hearts to give the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of **Jesus Christ your Savior** (2 Cor. 4:6). The Lord is your light and your salvation; whom shall you fear? The Lord is the strength of your life; of whom shall you be afraid? When the wicked come against you to eat up your flesh, your enemies and foes, they stumble and fall. Though an army should encamp against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), your heart shall not fear. Though war should rise against you (Ps. 72:4) and your children (Ps 103:17), in this you will be confident, that you and your children (Ps 103:17) may dwell in the house of the Lord all the days of your life. For in the time of trouble God shall hide you and your family (Acts 13:26) in His pavilion; in the secret place of His Tabernacle He shall hide you and yours; He shall set you and your people (Ps. 148:14) high upon a rock. And then your heads

shall be lifted up above your enemies all around you (Ps. 27:1-6). No man shall be able to stand against you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21); the Lord our God will put the dread of you and your people (Ps. 148:14) and the fear of you and your family (Acts 13:26) upon all the land where you should tread (Deut. 11:25). This day God will begin to put the dread and fear of you and your family (Acts 13:26) upon the nations under the whole heaven, who shall hear the report of you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and shall tremble and be in anguish because of you (Deut. 2:25) and your people (Ps. 148:14). And the fear of you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and the dread of you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall be on every beast of the earth, on every bird of the air, on all that moves on the earth, and on all the fish of the sea. They are given into your hands (Gen. 9:2). God will send His fear before you, and cause confusion and will make all your enemies turn their backs to you (Ex. 23:27). Little by little God will drive them out from before you, until you and your people (Ps. 148:14) have increased, and you inherit the land (Ex. 23:30). Fear not, for God is with you and your family (Acts 13:26); God will bring your descendants from the east, and gather them from the west; He will say to the north, 'Give them up!' And to the south, 'Do not keep them back!' God will bring your sons from afar, and your daughters from the ends of the earth for you and your family (Acts 13:26) are called by His name, whom He has created for His glory (Is. 43:5-8). God, righteous and upright is He (Deut. 32:4); He will set His glory among the nations; all the nations shall see His judgment which He has executed, and His hand which He has laid on them. You shall know that He is your Lord your God from that day forward (Ezek.39:21-22).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), those who know His name will put their trust in Him (Ps.9:10), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask God, who does wonders (Ps. 77:14), to make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and your descendants (Prov. 11:21) after you, be like a tree planted by the waters, which spreads out its roots by the river, and will not fear when heat comes; but your leaves will be green, and will not be anxious in the year of drought, nor will cease from yielding fruit (Jer. 17:8). You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall have rest and be at ease; no one shall make you afraid (Jer. 46:27). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) keep your minds on the Lord and also trust in Him and the Lord will keep you and yours in perfect peace (Is. 26:3). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will be faithful until death, and receive the crown of life. God grant that you and your family (Acts 13:26) have an ear to hear what the Spirit says. In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask God, He who has declared His strength among the peoples (Ps. 77:14), that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall overcome and not be

hurt by the second death (Rev. 2:10-11), rather seek the mercy of our **Lord Jesus Christ** unto eternal life (Jude 20-21). We believe we will see the glory of God (John 11:40)! Therefore, we have reason to glory in **Christ Jesus** in the things which pertain to God (Rom. 15:17). Let us rejoice in hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! To God, alone wise, be glory through **Jesus Christ** forever (Rom. 16:27)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who is the way, the truth, and the life (John 14:6), may the everlasting God (Gen. 21:33) teach you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) His way, so that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will walk in His truth; and unite your hearts to fear His name (Ps. 86:11); and to hope in His word (Ps. 119-74). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) shall walk in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit (Acts 9:31). Wisdom and knowledge will be the stability of your times, and the strength of salvation; the fear of the Lord is His treasure (Is. 33:6). Let wisdom enter your hearts, and knowledge be pleasant to your souls, let discretion preserve you and your people (Ps. 148:14); understanding will keep you and your family (Acts 13:26), to deliver you and yours from the way of evil (Prov. 2:10-12). Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man; O Lord, seek out his wickedness until You find none (Ps. 10:15). Let nothing wicked cling to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). A perverse heart shall depart from you and your people (Ps. 148:14) and you will not know wickedness (Ps. 101:3-4). The Lord shall preserve your going out and your coming in from this time forth, and even forevermore (Ps. 121:8). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16), in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the resurrection and the life (John 11:25), that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will take captive those captives you were, and rule over your oppressors (Is. 14:2). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that you will rule your own spirit and not be like a city broken down without walls (Prov. 25:28). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), His name will be called Wonderful, Counselor, Mighty God, Everlasting Father, Prince of Peace (Is. 9:6), let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God; and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through **Christ Jesus** (Phil 4: 6). May the God of heaven and the God of earth (Gen. 24:3) bring you and your people (Ps. 148:14) out of the darkness and the shadows of death and break your chains in pieces (Ps. 107:14). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) cast off the works of darkness, and put on the armor of light (Rom. 13:12). May the Lord our God teach you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to stand fast therefore in the liberty by which **Christ** has

made you free, and do not be entangled again with a yoke of bondage (Gal. 5:1). High and Lofty One Who inhabits eternity, whose name is Holy (Is. 57:15), our God, Master in heaven (Col. 4:1), give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the assurance that with God all things are possible” (Matt. 19:26); and you can do all things through **Christ** who strengthens you (Phil 4:13). Surely His rod and His staff will comfort you and your family (Acts 13:26) (Ps.23:4). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) put on the whole armor of God and stand against the wiles of the devil (Eph. 6:11). May you and yours stand therefore having girded your waist with truth, having put on the breastplate of righteousness, and having shod your feet with the gospel of peace; above all, taking the shield of faith with which you will be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God; praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, being watchful to this end with all perseverance and supplication for all the saints (Eph. 6:14-18). If you are reproached for the name of **Christ**, blessed are you, for the Spirit of glory and of God rests upon you. On their part He is blasphemed, but on your part He is glorified (1 Pet. 4:14). Therefore, in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) you will grow in the grace and knowledge of our **Lord and Savior Jesus Christ**. To Him be the glory both now and forever (2 Pet. 3:18)! The Lord be magnified (Ps. 40:16)! Glory to God in the Highest (Luke 2:14)!

Bless the Lord, O your souls; and all that is within you, bless His holy name! Bless the Lord, O your souls; and forget not all His benefits: who forgives all your inequities, who heals all your diseases, who redeems your lives from destruction. Who crowns you and your children (Ps. 102:28) with loving kindness and tender mercies (Ps. 103:1-4). The Lord executes righteousness and justice for all who are oppressed (Ps. 103:6). Like a flitting sparrow, like a flying swallow, a curse without cause will not alight on you (Prov. 26:2) or your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). There is no cause because as far as the east is from the west, so far has He removed your transgressions from you and your children (Ps. 103:12). So shall they fear the name of the Lord from the west, and His glory from the rising of the sun; when the enemy comes in, like a flood the Spirit of the Lord will lift up a standard against him (Is. 59:19). To God our Savior, who alone is wise, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and forever (Jude 1:25)!

Abiding in the anointing of **Jesus Christ** (1 John 2:27) and abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house

(Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, by His blood we are made near (Eph. 2:13), abiding in His name and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2 In Him who is our deliverer (Ps. 18:2), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints (Ps. 149:9). Inasmuch as there is none like You, O Lord, (You are great, and Your name is great in might), who would not fear You, O King of the nations? For this is Your rightful due, for among all the wise men of the nations, and in all their kingdoms, there is none like You (Jer. 10:6-7).

God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In **Jesus'** name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
