



A Prayer for the Leaders of the World

Purpose

A Prayer for President and First Lady of the Republic of the United States of America, and all the leaders of the world, from the least to the greatest, taken from the collection of Prayers for the Precious. As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29), we lift the leaders of the world up. God is good. His mercy endures forever. God is good to all your people for the Lord God is faithful, who will establish you and guard *you* from the evil one. Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom comes into their heart. Your will be done in their life on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), **Jesus Christ**, we give thanks to the Lord, the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), for the leaders that God has raised up and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that **Christ** might make known to you the riches of His glory, we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall for you and your bloodline and all your house (Ezek. 13:5). In the name of **Jesus Christ**, we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2). The words that **Christ** through us speak are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our Lord **Jesus Christ** (1 Cor. 15:57)!

As a fellow worker in **Christ Jesus** (Rom. 16:3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we lift up you and your bloodline and your entire house to the Father, all of your family, all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time, all those by adoption, and all those by marriage, all your natural seed and all of your spiritual seed. In the name of **Jesus Christ** of Nazareth (John 14:13,16:23), by the precious blood of **Christ**, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray that you will clearly hear the call that God has on your lives. May the God of all grace who has called you to His eternal glory by **Christ Jesus** (1 Pet. 5:10) help you know who you are in **Christ** (John 15:4); and give you certainty that you were created for a high purpose being called with a holy calling, not according to your works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given to you in **Christ Jesus** before time began (2 Tim. 1:9); the Lord has called you in righteousness (Is. 42:6) from the womb; from the matrix of your Mother He has made mention of your name (Is. 49:1). The Lord has called you by name; and you belong to the Lord (Is. 43:1). You have been

called by God's name, and have been created for God's glory, and made by God (Is. 43:7); the very hairs of your head are all numbered (Luke 12:7). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16::23), the horn of your salvation (Ps. 18:2), may the God of hope fill you with all joy and faith in believing, that you may abound in hope by the power of the Holy Spirit (Rom. 15:13); and strike down discouragement (Num. 32:9,11) so that it will not defeat you (Num. 14:42), and let you be certain that God will never leave you or forsake you (Num. 31:6), nor forget you and your house, but that God has inscribed your names on the palm of His hand (Is. 49-55:16). Being confident of this very thing, that God who has begun a good work in you will complete it until the day of **Jesus Christ** (Phil. 1:6). The God of our Lord **Jesus Christ**, the Father of glory, give to you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you may know what is the hope of your calling, what is the riches of the glory of **Jesus'** inheritance in you, the Saints of God, and what are the exceeding greatness of God's power toward you and your house, who believes, according to the working of His mighty power (Eph. 1:17-19). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16::23), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask that you be filled with the knowledge of God's will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of the Lord fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy, giving thanks to the Father who has qualified you to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light (Col. 1:9:12). May you and your house be filled with the assurance that the mission you are on is under the eye of the Lord and may the presence of the Lord be with you on your way (Judg. 18:6). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16::23), may you be diligent to make your call and election sure, you will never stumble; for so an entrance will be supplied to you abundantly into the everlasting kingdom of our Lord and Savior **Jesus Christ** (2 Pet. 1:10-11). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray God would count you worthy of this calling, and fulfill all the good pleasure of His goodness and the work of faith with power, that the name of our **Lord Jesus Christ** may be glorified in you and your house, and you in Him, according to the grace of our God and the **Lord Jesus Christ** (2 Thess. 1:11-12). May the Lord make you increase and abound in love to one another and to all, so that He may establish your hearts blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** with all His saints (1 Thess. 3:12-13). And this in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray, that your love may abound still more and more in knowledge and all discernment, that you may approve the things that are excellent, that you may be sincere and without offense till the day of **Christ**, being filled with the fruits of righteousness which are by

Jesus Christ, to the glory and praise of God (Phil. 1:9-11). Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You! Oh, let the nations be glad and sing for joy! For You shall judge the people righteously and govern the nations on earth. Selah. Let the peoples praise You, O God; Let all the peoples praise You! Then the earth shall yield her increase; God, our own God, shall bless you. God shall bless you, and all the ends of the earth shall fear Him (Ps. 67:3-7)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16:23), may the Lord grant to you according to your heart's desire, and fulfill all your purpose (Ps. 20:4). May the Lord fulfill all your petitions (Ps. 20:5); and let all things work together for good to you, who are called according to God's purpose (Rom. 8:28). Now may the God of patience and comfort (Rom. 15:5) make all grace abound toward you and your house, that you and yours, always having all sufficiency in all things, have an abundance for every good work (2 Cor. 9:8). At all times, in all things may He surround you and your house with His favor as with a shield (Ps. 5:12), and help you to bear much fruit (John 15:5). According to His own purpose and grace which was given to you in **Christ Jesus** before time began (2 Tim. 1:9) the Lord will raise you up for Himself as faithful priests who shall do according to what is in His heart and in His mind (1 Sam. 2:35). God, He who declares to man what his thoughts are (Amos 4:13), will build you a sure house, and you shall walk before God anointed forever (1 Sam. 2:35), therefore prepare to meet your God (Amos 4:12). Let you follow **Jesus Christ** and living light flood your path (John 8:12). Oh, bless our God, you people! And make the voice of His praise to be heard. Who keeps your soul among the living, and does not allow your feet to be moved (Ps. 66:8-9). For You, O God, according to the Your judgments (Ps. 119:156) have proved us; You have refined us as silver is refined (Ps. 66:10). According to the eternal purpose (Eph. 3:11) You brought us into the net; You laid affliction on our backs. You have caused men to ride over our heads; we went through fire and through water; but You brought us out to rich fulfillment (Ps. 66:11-12).

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16:23), our crown of glory (Is. 28:5), in **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask the Father of glory (Eph. 1:17) that He grant to you to be named the priests of the Lord, and you shall be called the servants of God (Is. 61:6). Instead of shame you and your house shall have double honor, and instead of confusion you shall rejoice in your portion. In your land you shall possess double; everlasting joy shall be yours (Is. 61:7). Thanks be to God for doing all of these things: for loving you (John 15:12); and choosing you and your house; and appointing you that you should go and bear fruit, and that your fruit should remain (John 15:16); and giving you victory through **Jesus Christ**, His son (1 Cor. 15:57). In **Christ** (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30)

we pray that you shall cleanse yourselves of dishonor and you will be vessels for honor, sanctified and useful for the Master, prepared for every good work (2 Tim. 2:21). Let you flee from youthful lusts; but instead pursue righteousness, faith, love, peace and possess pure hearts before God (2 Tim. 2:22). The Lord shall go before you and make the crooked places straight; He will break in pieces the gates of bronze and cut the bars of iron. He will give you the treasures of darkness and hidden riches of secret places. So that you may know that God, the Lord, who calls you by name, is your God (Is. 45:2-3). The Lord will go before you, and the God of Israel will be your rear guard (Is. 52:12). Clouds and darkness surround Him; righteousness and justice are the foundation of the Lord's throne, a fire goes before Him and burns up His enemies round about (Ps. 97:2-3). Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the Lord our God (Ps. 20:7). We who trust in **Christ** should be to the praise of His glory (Eph. 1:12). For behold, He who forms mountains, and creates the wind, who declares to man what His thought is, and makes the morning darkness, who treads the high places of the earth the Lord God of Hosts is His name (Amos 4:13). To Him be glory in the church by **Christ Jesus** throughout all ages, world without end (Eph. 3:21)!

“Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood and His name is called The Word of God” (Rev. 19:11-13). Let it be, in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 14:13,16::23), called Faithful and True (Rev. 19:11), that you, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, follow Him on white horses (Rev 19:14). ***“And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: King of Kings and Lord of Lords”*** (Rev. 19:16). Glory to our God and Father that is in heaven! Glory and honor and thanks to Him who sits on the throne, who lives forever and ever (Rev. 4:9)! Holy, holy, holy, Lord God Almighty, who was and is and is to come (Rev. 4:8)!

As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline, your house and all of your people; by the blood of the lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space by the overpowering presence of God, who has made his home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be

preserved blameless at the coming of our **Lord Jesus Christ** (1 Thess. 5:23). As a vessel of honor (Rom. 9:21), we continue petitioning (1 John 5:15) fervently (James 5:16) the Lord to let it be to you according to His word (Luke 1:38) and what we have asked shall be given to you (Luke 11:9). In **Jesus'** (John 16:23) name so be it! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever!
