Your righteousness is an everlasting righteousness, and Your law is truth (Ps. 119:142); the righteousness of Your testimonies is everlasting (Ps. 119:144). Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom

Christ, glorify His name forevermore (Ps. 86:12), in His glorified name we lift up you and your entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to the Father (Math. 6:9), all of your family (Acts 13:26), all of your blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all your natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of your spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2). In the mighty and awesome name of <u>Jesus Christ</u>, in His name we rejoice all day long (Ps. 89:16), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for you, your posterity (Prov. 11:21) and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21). The words that <u>Christ</u>, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to you and your family (Acts 13:26) are spirit, and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives you the victory through our <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)!

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the <u>Lord Jesus Christ</u>. We are bound to thank God always for you (2 Thess. 1:2-3). Blessed be the name of the Lord from this time forth and forevermore; from the rising of the sun to its going down; the Lord's name is to be praised (Ps. 113:2-6)!

In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) we ask the Lord God Almighty to fill you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship (Ex. 31:3). Give ear to our prayer, O God, and do not hide Yourself from our supplication. Attend to us, and hear us (Ps. 55:1). According to the faith of God's elect (Titus 1:1) now may the God of patience and comfort (Rom. 15:5) put wisdom in your hearts, exceedingly great understanding, and largeness of heart (1 Kin. 4:29). In <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that you all may excel in wisdom (1 Kin. 4:30). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) eat the bread of wisdom and the wine of understanding (Prov. 9:5). God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) bestow on you and your people (Ps. 148:14) God-given wisdom (Ezra 7:25), strength, counsel and understanding (Job 12:13) and may you receive double in prudence (Job 11:6). In <u>Christ</u> (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that your hearts retain God's words, and you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) keep His commands, getting wisdom

and understanding (Prov. 4:4-5), crying out for discernment, and lifting up your voices for understanding (Prov. 2:3). You, who get wisdom, love your own souls; you, who keep understanding, will find good (Prov. 19:8). Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) embrace wisdom; and may you and yours receive honor, a crown of glory (Prov. 4:8-9), a prolonged life (Duet. 6:10); walk the path of the just (Prov. 4:18), and go in the way of understanding (Prov. 9:6). Let your steps not be hindered, nor will you or your people (Ps. 148:14) stumble (Prov. 4:12), for your lives shall shine ever brighter unto the perfect day (Prov. 4:18), your sleep being sweet (Prov. 3:24). Blessing and glory and wisdom, thanksgiving and honor and power and might, be to our God forever and ever (Rev. 7:12)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), His name is Prince of Peace (Is. 9:6), God grant that you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) dwell safely, and be secure without fear of evil (Prov. 1:33), for the Lord will be your confidence, and will keep your feet from being caught (Prov. 3:26). May you and your family (Acts 13:26) find the word of God and keep it in the midst of your hearts, receiving life and health to all your flesh (Prov. 4:21-22), happiness (Prov. 3:13), riches and honor (Prov. 8:28), pleasantness and peace (Prov. 3:17), obtaining favor from the Lord (Prov. 8:35). Let God cause you to inherit wealth (Prov. 8:21), enduring riches and righteousness (Prov. 8:18), and fill your treasuries (Prov. 8:21). In *Christ* (John 15:4), we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will keep sound wisdom and discretion, so it will be life to your souls and grace to your necks. You and your family (Acts 13:26) shall walk safely in your way and you will not stumble (Prov. 3:21-23). God grant, according to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7), that you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall manifest the fruit of wisdom (Prov. 8:19) and traverse the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of justice (Prov. 8:20). May God, He who turns the shadow of death into morning and makes the day dark as night (Amos 5:8), be a shield to you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), guard your paths and preserve your way (Prov. 2:7-8). The God of our *Lord Jesus Christ*, the Father of glory, give to you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the spirit of wisdom and revelation in knowledge of Him, the eyes of your understanding being enlightened; that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, and what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward you who believe, according to the working of His mighty power (Eph. 1:17-19). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that God will count you and your family (Acts 13:26) worthy of this calling (2 Thess. 1:11); that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may be filled with the knowledge of His will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may walk worthy of the

Lord, fully pleasing Him, being fruitful in every good work and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might, according to His glorious power, for all patience and longsuffering with joy (Col. 1: 9-11). Worthy is the lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)! HOLINESS TO THE LORD (Ex. 39:30)! Glory to God in the Highest, our Father (Luke 2:14)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), whom is the covenant of the people (Is. 42:6), in Christ (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that the Spirit of God is in you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), and that light and understanding and excellent wisdom are found in you (Dan. 5:14) and your people (Ps. 148:14). May you and yours receive wisdom from above, wisdom that is pure, peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy (James 3:17). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we petition the Lord God to give you and your family (Acts 13:26) wisdom and counsel night and day (Ps. 16:7), lead you and guide your every thought and every decision (Ps. 31:3), and grant you and your people (Ps. 148:14) wisdom and success (Eccl. 10:10) in all decisions and choices you make (Prov. 16:33), teaching you and your family (Acts 13:26) to profit (Is. 48:17), instructing you and teaching you and your people (Ps. 148:14) in the way you should go. God, He will guide you with His eye (Ps. 32:8). May the God of love and peace (2 Cor. 13:11) teach you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to listen and increase learning and your understanding (Prov. 1:5). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) come to the knowledge of the truth (1 Tim. 2:4), receiving the Spirit of Truth from the God and Father of our *Lord Jesus Christ* (John 14:17). In *Christ* (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we plead with you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to guard yourselves against seeing yourselves as being wise in your own eyes, but fear the Lord and depart from evil (Prov. 3:7). The fear of the Lord is the instruction of wisdom (Prov. 15:33). In *Christ* (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that you and yours will not limit wisdom to yourself, but hear the counsel of God (Job 15:8), and seek diligently (Prov. 1:28) to know wisdom and instruction, to perceive the words of understanding, to receive the instruction of wisdom, justice, judgment, and equity; to receive prudence, knowledge and discretion, to hear and increase learning (Prov. 1:2-6); to turn any disobedience to the wisdom of the just (Luke 1:17). In *Christ* (John 15:4) we petition the God and Father of all (Eph. 4:6) to give you and your family (Acts 13:26) an ear to hear the rebukes of life and gain wisdom (Prov. 15:31), understanding (Prov. 1:5-6), humility and honor (Prov. 15:33). Let His counsel stand in your hearts (Prov. 19:21), and may you and your people (Ps. 148:14) not be deceived by the wisdom of this world (1 Cor. 3:18-19); but trust in the

Lord with all of your heart, and lean not on your own understanding; but in all your ways acknowledge God, and allow Him to direct your path (Prov. .3:5). Your hearts may plan your way but the Lord will direct your steps (Prov. 16:9). May the Spirit of wisdom and understanding, the Spirit of counsel and might, the Spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord rest upon you (Is. 11:2) and your people (Ps. 148:14). Blessing and honor and glory and power be to Him who sits on the throne, and to the Lamb, forever and ever (Rev. 5:13)!

In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), the Prince of Life (Acts 3:15), may His God and Father, the God of mercy (Ps. 59:17), teach you and your family (Acts 13:26) to number your days that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may gain a heart of wisdom (Ps. 90:12). In Christ (John 15:4), we pray (James 5:16) that you and your family (Acts 13:26) are wise in heart, are called prudent, and allow the sweetness of your lips to increase your learning. Let understanding be a wellspring of life to you (Prov. 16:21-24). In **Christ** (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that Jehovah-Tsidkenu, the Lord our righteousness (Jer. 23:6), will satisfy you and your family (Acts 13:26) early with His mercy, that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may rejoice and be glad all your days (Ps. 90:14). As a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ (Acts 9:15), to bear His name, we ask in the mighty name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), through whom grace and truth came (John 1:17), that the everlasting God (Gen. 21:33) give you and your people (Ps. 148:14) a heart that is wise that teaches your mouth and adds learning to your lips (Prov. 16:23). In Christ (John 15:4), we pray (James 5:16) that your lips may keep knowledge (Prov. 5:2), and that all the words of your mouths are with righteousness; nothing crooked or perverse is in them (Prov. 8:8). Let you open your mouth with wisdom, and on your tongue be the law of kindness (Prov. 31:26). In Christ (John 15:4) we ask, according to His new covenant (Heb. 8:13), the God of the holy prophets (Rev. 22:6) grant you and your family (Acts 13:26) the wisdom of silence (Job 13:5), to go from the presence of a foolish man, when you do not perceive in him the lips of knowledge (Prov. 14:7), and the wisdom not to speak in the hearing of a fool, for he will despise the wisdom of your words (Prov. 23:9). Let your mouth speak wisdom, and your tongue talk of justice (Ps. 37:30) and the meditation of your heart shall bring understanding (Ps. 49:3). May your meditation be sweet to the Lord; let you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) be glad in the Lord (Ps. 104:34). The mouth of the righteous brings forth wisdom (Prov. 10:31). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who manifested God's name to men (John 17:6), may the words from your mouth be like deep waters; the wellspring of wisdom like a flowing brook (Prov. 18:4). Let your words be pleasant like a honeycomb, sweetness to the soul and health to the bones (Prov. 16:24). In *Christ* (John 15:4) we petition the

Lord to guide you and your family (Acts 13:26) continually, and satisfy your souls in drought, and strengthen your bones; you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall be like a well-watered garden, and like a spring of water, whose waters do not fail (Is. 58:11). May God's wisdom rest quietly in your hearts (Prov. 14:33); and knowledge be pleasant to your souls, discretion will preserve you and your family (Acts 13:26); understanding will keep you and your people (Ps. 148:14), to deliver you and yours from the way of evil, from the man who speaks perverse things, from those who leave the paths of uprightness to walk in the ways of darkness (Prov. 2:10:13). Worthy is the Lamb who was slain to receive power and riches and wisdom, and strength and honor and glory and blessing (Rev. 5:12)!

According to the riches of His glory (Eph. 3:16), may our God and Father (Phil. 4:20) teach you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in the way of wisdom and lead you in right paths (Prov. 4:11). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the living bread which came down from heaven (John 6:51), let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) say to wisdom, "You are my sister," and call understanding your nearest kin, that you and your family (Acts 13:26) may keep away from immorality, from the seductress who flatters with words (Prov.7:4-6). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) pay attention to wisdom; lend your ears to understanding, that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) may preserve discretion, and that your lips may keep knowledge (Prov. 5:1-2). May the Lord God lead you and your family (Acts 13:26) in right paths, so that when you and your people (Ps. 148:14) walk, your steps will not be hindered, and when you run, you will not stumble (Prov. 4:11-12). In **Christ** (John 15:4), we pray (James 5:16) that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) will receive God's words, and treasure His commands within you, so that you incline your ear to wisdom, and apply your heart to understanding (Prov. 2:1-2). For the Lord gives wisdom; from His mouth come knowledge and understanding; He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly; He guards the paths of justice, and preserves the way of His saints (Prov. 2:6-8). The fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, and to depart from evil is understanding (Job 28:28). The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowledge (Prov. 1:7). The fear of the Lord is to hate evil; pride and arrogance and the evil way and the perverse mouth (Prov. 8:13). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) take firm hold of instruction, and do not let go; keep wisdom, for it is your life (Prov. 4:13). Wisdom is a tree of life to those who take hold of her, and happy are all who retain her (Prov. 3:18). Like the honeycomb which is sweet to your taste so shall the knowledge of wisdom be to your souls; and your hope will not be cut off (Prov. 24:13-14). Alleluia! Salvation and glory and honor and power to the Lord our God (Rev. 19:1)!

In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the true vine (John 15:1), let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) be blessed because you listen to God, watching daily at the gates of wisdom, waiting at the posts of the door of wisdom. For whoever finds wisdom finds life, and obtains favor from the Lord (Prov. 8:34-36)! Through wisdom a house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) is built, and by understanding it is established; by knowledge the rooms are filled with all precious and pleasant riches (Prov. 24:3-4). God has taken you and your people (Ps. 148:14). from the ends of the earth, and called you and your family (Acts 13:26) from its farthest regions, and said to you "You are My servant, I have chosen you and have not cast you away" (ls. 41:9). Our everlasting God, the Lord, the Creator of the ends of the earth (ls. 40:28) has filled you with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship (Ex. 31:3). Your family is gifted in whom the Lord has put wisdom and understanding, to know how to do all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary (Ex. 36::1). We pray (James 5:16) in the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), our Teacher and Lord (John 13:13), that you and your people (Ps. 148:14) shall do according to all that the Lord has commanded (Ex. 36:1). Behold, the Lord desires truth in the inward part, and in the hidden part He will make you and your people (Ps. 148:14) to know wisdom. He will purge you with hyssop, and you and your family (Acts 13:26) shall be clean (Ps. 51:6-7). God Almighty, the faithful One (Deut. 7:9), will wash you and your people (Ps. 148:14), and you shall be whiter than snow (Ps. 51:7). He will make you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) to hear joy and gladness. He will hide His face from your sins, and blot out all your iniquities (Ps. 51:8-9). May Jehovah-Tsidkenu, the LORD our righteousness (Jer. 23:6), create in you and your people (Ps. 148:14) a clean heart, and renew a steadfast spirit within you and yours (Ps. 51:10). In Christ (John 15:4) we pray (James 5:16) that the God of all grace (1 Pet. 5:10) will not cast you and your family (Acts 13:26) away from His presence, and He will not take His Holy Spirit from you. Instead, restore to you and your people (Ps. 148:14) the joy of His salvation, and uphold you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) with His Generous Spirit. Then you and your family (Acts 13:26) will teach transgressors His ways, and sinners shall be converted to Him. Let the God of your salvation, deliver you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) from blood guiltiness and your tongues shall sing aloud of His righteousness. O may the Lord open your lips, and let your mouths show forth His praise (Ps. 51:11-15). Let you and your family (Acts 13:26) give thanks to the Lord, for He is good! For His mercy endures forever! Oh, give thanks to the God of gods! For His mercy endures forever! Oh, give thanks to the Lord of lords! To Him who alone does great wonders! To Him who by wisdom made

the heavens, for His mercy endures forever! To Him who laid out the earth above the waters! For His mercy endures forever! To Him who made great lights! For His mercy endures forever (Ps. 136:5-7)! Who remembered you and your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) in your lowly state! For His mercy endures forever! He rescued you and your family (Acts 13:26) from your enemies. For His mercy endures forever! Who gives food to all flesh! For His mercy endures forever! Oh, give thanks to the God of heaven! For His mercy endures forever (Ps. 136:23-26)! Let you and your people (Ps. 148:14) fear God and give glory to Him, for the hour of His judgment has come; and let you worship Him who made heaven and earth, the sea and springs of water (Rev. 14:7). For His mercy endures forever (Ps. 136:23-26)

Dwelling in the secret place of the Most-High (Ps. 91:1), abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), and one with Them (John 17:22), in truth (John 17:19) and in faith (Acts 26:18) we sanctify (1 John 17:17,19, Heb. 13:12) you and your entire bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), your house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and all of your people (Ps. 148:14); by the blood of the Lamb of God (Rev. 7:14, 12:11); we sanctify your time (Is. 9:7, Is. 59:21) so that you will always be in the will of God (Col. 1:9) through the communion of the Holy Spirit (2 Cor. 13:14); and we sanctify your space (Jos. 7:13, 2 Chr. 29:5) by the overpowering presence of God (Judges 18:6, Ps. 17:1-2), who has made His home in you (John 14:23). Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely: and may your whole spirit, soul, and body be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ (1 Thess. 5:23). In the name of Jesus Christ, glory of our strength (Ps. 89:16), and His love being perfected in us (1 John 4:12), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (ls. 61:2)! In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), as one (John 17:21) we execute the written judgment-- This honor has all His saints. God said it. We believe it. It is settled forever. In <u>Jesus'</u> name (John 16:23) so be it (Mark 11:23)! You, O Lord, shall endure forever, and the remembrance of your name to all generations (Ps. 102:12)! For Yours, O Lord, is the glory and the power and the kingdom forever (Matt. 6:13)! Amen!
