A Prayer for the Children of the Nations Binding & Loosing

To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood, and has made us kings and priests to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:5-6). As a king (Rev. 5:10)

abiding in (1 John 2:29) and one with (John 17:11) the King of Kings (Rev. 17:14), in the authority given to us (Luke 10:19) in the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Philp. 2:10) we speak words of life (John 6:63) over the children of the Nations. We call all those the Lord God chose before the foundation of the world, that they should be holy and without blame before Him in love, having predestined them to adoption as sons by <u>Jesus Christ</u> to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will, to the praise of the glory of His grace, by which He has made them accepted in the Beloved (Eph. 1:4-6). They are the inheritance of our <u>Lord</u> <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Ps. 2:8) and we are joint heirs with <u>Jesus Christ</u> (Rom. 8:17) so we call them Our Children.

Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name. Your kingdom come into the heart of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21). Your will be done in the life of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their bloodline (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21) on earth as it is in heaven (Matt. 6:9-10). As an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 6:56, John 15:5), we come into agreement (Math. 18:19) with our Father in heaven (Matt. 6:9), the Spirit of Truth (John 14:17) and the Word of Life (1 John 1:1). In Him who is true (1 John 5:20), in His Son Jesus Christ (1 John 5:20), we give thanks to the Lord (1 Thess. 5:18), the living God, the true God, the everlasting King (Jer. 10:10), our righteous Father (John 17:25), for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21), their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), their entire family (Acts 13:26), and their nation (Math. 21:43) for the saints (Eph. 6:18), for the leaders that God has raised up on their behalf and for all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2). As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23) so that *Christ* might make known to them the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we go up into the gaps to stand in battle on the day of the Lord, to build a wall (Ezek. 13:5) for Our Children (Is. 61:9), their posterity (Prov. 11:21) their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), for their entire family (Acts 13:26), their friends, neighbors and countrymen (1 Tim. 2:1-2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43); for all the brethren (Eph. 6:18), all those called by the name of the Lord (Deut. 28:10); for the leaders of their nation, and all the leaders throughout the world, all those that influence the wellbeing of God's people; and all the people of their nation, and all men (1 Tim. 2:1-2), so

that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) may lead a quiet and peaceable life in all godliness and reverence (1 Tim. 2:1-2). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), we proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord, and the day of vengeance of our God (Is. 61:2)! We stand, and rejoice in the hope of the glory of God (Rom. 5:2)! It is written (Matt. 4:4), the things that we speak (Jer. 1:7) and pray (James 5:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (James 5:16) their family (Acts 13:26) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for these words are true and faithful (Rev. 21:5), and they are the true sayings of God (Rev. 19:9). The word of God is true (John 3:33), pure (Prov. 30:5, Ps. 119:140), proven (Ps. 18:30), and eternal, for heaven and earth will pass away, but God's word will by no means pass away (Matt. 24:35); it is living, and powerful (Heb. 4:12); it searches the hearts of man (Rev. 2:23), like a two edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (Heb. 4:12), and nothing is hidden from His sight (Heb. 4:13), the Mighty One (Ps. 45:3), the Ancient of Days (Dan. 7:9), the Holy one of Israel (Is. 5:24). The words that *Christ*, through us, speaks (Math. 10:19) to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their nation (Math. 21:43) are spirit and they are life (John 6:63). Thanks be to God, who gives them the victory through our *Lord Jesus Christ* (1 Cor. 15:57)!

We don't come to the Father in Heaven (Math. 6:9) based on our own worthiness (Is. 64:6), or on the worthiness (Is. 64:6) of Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), we come to God's throne of grace (Heb. 4:16) on the merits of His Son (Eph. 4:13), *Jesus Christ of Nazareth* (Acts 3:6), and the blood that He shed (Rev. 7:14). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), who upholds all things by the word of His power (Heb. 1:3), as a fellow worker in *Christ Jesus* (Rom. 16;3), abiding in Him, and born of Him (1 John 2:29) we come boldly to the throne of grace and obtain mercy and find grace (Heb. 4:16) for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their entire house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21), all of their people (Ps. 148:14), on every side (Job 1:10), all of their family (Acts 13:26), all of their blood from the beginning of time until the end of time (Gen. 17:7, Prov. 11:21), all those by adoption (Gal. 4:5), and all those by marriage (Judge 12:9, 2 Chr. 18:1), all their natural seed (2 Sam. 7:12) and all of their spiritual seed (1 Tim. 1:2) and their entire nation (Math. 21:43).

According to the faith of God's elect and the acknowledgment of the truth which is according to godliness, in hope of eternal life which God, who cannot lie, promised before time began, to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house: Grace, mercy, and peace from God the Father and the *Lord Jesus Christ* our Savior (Titus 1:1-4). In the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), by the precious blood of *Christ*, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot (1 Pet. 1:19), the Father in heaven bless Our Children (Is. 61:9) and

their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and keep them (Num. 6:24). Glory to God the Father (Luke 2:14)! Grace to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and peace from Him who is and who was and who is to come, and from the seven Spirits who are before His throne, and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved Our Children (Is. 61:9) and washed them from their sins in His own blood, and has made Our Children (Is. 61:9) a king and priest to His God and Father, to Him be glory and dominion forever and ever (Rev. 1:4-6). Grace and peace be multiplied to Our Children (ls. 61:9) in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, as His divine power has given to Our Children (Is. 61:9) all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called Our Children (Is. 61:9) by glory and virtue, by which have been given to them exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these Our Children (Is. 61:9) may be a partaker of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust (2 Pet. 1:2-4). And we know that the Son of God has come and has given Our Children (Is. 61:9) an understanding, that they may know Him who is true; and they are in Him who is true, in *His Son Jesus Christ*. He is the true God and eternal life (1 John 5:20). He is the Rock, His work is perfect; for all His ways are justice, a God of truth and without injustice; righteous and upright is He. (Deut. 32:4)

BIND SATAN AND BREAK CURSES

The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, and delivers them out of all their troubles (Ps. 34:17). Our Children (Is. 61:9) are taught by the Lord and established in righteousness (Is. 54:13). Some trust in chariots, and some in horses; but we will remember the name of the Lord our God (Ps. 20:7). It is written in **Matthew 16:19**: "And I will give you the keys of the kingdom of heaven, and whatever you bind on earth will be bound in heaven, and whatever you loose on earth will be loosed in heaven." In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who sits at the right hand of the Majesty on high (Heb. 1:3), as an ambassador of **Christ**, abiding in **Christ** (John 15:4-5) and Him in us (John 6:56, John 15:5), born of God and One with Him, we bind, Satan (Math. 4:10) and all who follow him whether flesh or spirit, according to **Ephesians 6:12**. In Him who is true, in **His Son Jesus Christ** (1 John 5:20), we break Satan's powers (Luke 10:19) over Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26). In **Christ** (John 15:4), Him who God raised from the dead and seated **Him** at His right hand in the heavenly **places**, far above all principality and power and might and dominion, and every name that is named, not only in this age but also in that which is to come (Eph. 1:20),

and in His name, Jesus Christ (John 16:23), we loose and break off of Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Math. 16:19) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) all principalities, powers, the rulers of the darkness of this age, spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places (Eph.6:12) and all occult activity -- curses (Duet. 23:4-5), spells (Duet. 18:10) witchcraft, soothsaying (Duet. 18:10), divination (Lev. 19:26) and sorcery (Duet. 18:10) and all soul power (Prov. 25:28) that does not glorify our **Lord Jesus Christ** (2 Thess. 1:12). We command (Luke 10:19) every curse sent against Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) to return to its source (Ps. 7:16). Whosoever curses Our children (ls. 61:9), His trouble shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down on his own crown (Ps. 7:16). May the Lord our God turn every curse into a blessing for Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Duet. 23:5) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43), for the Lord our God loves Our Children (Is. 61:9) (1 John 4:19) and their people (Ps. 148:14) (Duet. 23:5). In the precious name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who has authority over all flesh (John 17:2), as an ambassador of *Christ* (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in *Christ* (John 15:4-5) we bind the kings of evil with chains, and the nobles of evil with fetters of iron; to execute on them the written judgment - this honor have all His saints (Ps. 149:8-9). In the name of Jesus Christ (John 16:23), who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), and by the authority of Jesus Christ (Luke 10:19), who is from God and sent by God (John 7:29), as a chosen vessel of Jesus Christ, to bear His name (Acts 9:15), we destroy the works (1 John 3:8) of the enemy over Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26), and come against any soul power (Luke 10:19) or emotional ties that do not glorify our *Lord Jesus Christ* (2 Thess. 1:12). By the word of truth, by the power of God, by the armor of righteousness on the right hand and on the left (2 Cor. 6:7), in the mighty name (Jer. 32:18) of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), and by the blood of His sacrifice (Heb. 13:20), we loose Our Children (Is. 61:9) and break off of them all generational curses (Ex. 34:7), blood curses (Gal. 3:13), rash vows (Num. 30:8), and we sever all unholy alliances (Is. 30:1) that they or their ancestors might have made (Jos. 24:14). By the authority given to us we sever all soul ties to familiar and familial spirits (Luke 10:19), we relieve these spirits of all power over Our Children (Is. 61:9) and loose our children (Math. 16:19) from their hold and all bondage (Gal.5:1). For Our Children (Is. 61:9) are not their own, their body is the temple of the Holy Spirit who is in them, whom they have from God, and they are not their own (1 Cor. 6:19). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23) and by the power of the Highest ,who has authority over all flesh (John 17:2), by the blood of **Jesus Christ** (John 1:29), we close all doors (Luke 13:25) left open to Satan (2 Cor. 2:11) or any demonic influence (Ps. 97:10), for the

promise of God is He will make justice the measuring line in the life of Our children (Is. 61:9), and righteousness the plummet in the heart of Our children (Is. 61:9); the hail will sweep away the refuge of lies they have believed, and the waters will overflow the hiding place (Is. 28:17), the secret sins (Ps. 19:12) and the hidden bitter roots in their heart (James 3:14). Their covenant with death will be annulled, and their agreement with Sheol will not stand (Is. 28:18). So by the power of the Word of God (2 cor. 6:7) we annul any rash vow (Num. 30:8), agreement with evil (Luke 13:25), or unholy alliance (Is. 30:1) that they have made and we close the door (Luke 13:25) of their heart (Math. 6:21) and their life (James 4:7) to Satan (Math. 4:10) and all demonic beings (Is. 28:17-18). We possess the gates of those who hate us (Gen. 24:60), and we close those gates by the blood of our everlasting covenant (Heb. 13:20) with God Almighty For this purpose, the Son of God was manifested, that He might destroy the works of the devil (1 John 3:8). He, Jesus Our Lord, has been given the keys to Hades and of death (Rev. 1:18) and together we lock the gates of Hell and block all access to Our Children (Is. 61:9).

UNDER YOUR FEET

It is written: "The LORD said to my Lord, "Sit at My right hand, till I make Your Enemies Your footstool" (Math. 22:44). Being complete in Him, who is the head of all principality and power (Col. 2:10), in His name, *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), we command all demonic (James 3:15), wicked (Ps. 97:10), evil (Luke 7:21) and unclean spirits (Luke 8:29) to take their rightful place in the footstool of *Jesus Christ* (Math. 22:44). God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved Our Children (Is. 61:9), even when they were dead in trespasses, made them alive together with **Christ**, and raised Our Children (Is. 61:9) up together, and made them sit together in the heavenly places in **Christ Jesus** (Eph. 2:4-6). In the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), who sits with Our Children (Is. 61:9) on the right hand of the power of God (Luke 22:69), we command Satan (Math. 4:10) and all those who answer to him, flesh or spirit, to get under their feet (Ps. 8:6). It is written: "And the God of peace will crush Satan under your feet shortly" (Rom. 16:20). The grace of our **Lord Jesus Christ** be with Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Rom. 16:24) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43). Amen.

As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we loose (Matt. 16:19) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) from Satan's hold and destroy his works (1 John 3:8-9) and his assignments (Job 36:23) in the name of **Jesus Christ** (John 16:23), the Son of Man which has come to seek and to save that which was lost (Luke 19:10). As an ambassador of **Christ** (2 Cor. 5:20), abiding in Christ (John 15:4-5) and one with Him (John 17:22) we speak (Jer. 1:7) to you, Satan (Math. 4:10), in the mighty and precious (Eccl. 7:1) name of <u>Jesus</u> (John 16:23) of Nazareth (Acts 3:6), declared to be the Son of God with power according to the Spirit of holiness (Rom. 1:3). "Get behind Our Children (ls. 61:9) Satan, for you are an offense to them (Math. 16:23)". Our Children (ls. 61:9) shall worship the Lord their God, and Him only they shall serve (Luke 4:8). Abiding in the Son and the Father (John 2:24), in the precious name (Job 36:23) of our savior (Luke 2:11), **Jesus** Christ, we take authority (Luke 10:19) and bind (Matt. 16:19) all demonic spirits (James 3:15) assigned to Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) and we relieve them of their assignments (Job 36:23). In Him who is true, in *His Son Jesus Christ* (1 John 5:20), in His mighty name (Jer. 32:18), we take authority over all the power of the enemy over Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Luke 10:19) and their house (Gen 14:14, 2 Sam. 6:21) and their nation (Math. 21:43) and command (Luke 10:10) that nothing shall grow from it ever again, it shall wither away just as the fig tree withered away when **Jesus** cursed it in Matt. 21:19.

STRONGHOLDS AND MIND SETS

In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask Father God (Math. 6:9), in the name of His beloved Son (Math. 3:17), <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the author and finisher of their faith (Heb. 12:2), to loose (Math. 16:19) the weapons of Heaven to help Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) tear down all strongholds that empower (2 Cor. 10:4) wicked (Ps. 12:8), unclean (Luke 8:29) or evil spirits (Luke 7:21), casting down arguments, imaginations, and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God, bringing every thought into captivity to the obedience of <u>Christ</u>, and being ready to punish all disobedience when their obedience is fulfilled (2 Cor. 10:4-6). For the weapons of our warfare *are* not carnal but mighty in God for pulling down strongholds, casting down arguments and every high thing that exalts itself against the knowledge of God (2 Cor. 10:4-6), therefore, we lose (Math. 16:19) all the weapons of heaven to pull down the strongholds of the enemy in their life and cast down the lies of enemy which they have believed, casting down belief systems and imaginations that exalt themselves against the knowledge of God and <u>Jesus Christ</u>, their Lord (2 Cor. 10:4-5).

In <u>Christ</u> (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we pray (James 5:16) that Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) will turn to the Lord, that the veil is taken away from their hearts (2 Cor. 3:16); and Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14) are given an ear to hear what the spirit says (Rev. 2:7); and their eyes are anointed with eye salve so that they may see clearly (Rev. 3:18). Our Lord, the Lord of hosts, is a crown of glory and a diadem of beauty! He is a spirit of justice to them who sits in judgment, and He is strength to those who turn back the battle at the gate (Is. 28:5-6). Lift up your heads, O you Gates! And be lifted up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord strong and mighty, the Lord mighty in battle. Lift up your heads, O you Gates! And lift them up, you everlasting doors! And the King of glory shall come in. Who is this King of glory? The Lord of hosts, He is the King of glory. Selah (Ps. 24:7-10)

COMMAND SATAN TO LOOSE OUR CHILDREN

As a vessel of mercy (Rom. 9:23), so that *Christ* might make known to Our Children (Is. 61:9) the riches of His glory (Rom. 9:23), we command Satan (Math. 4:10) to loose (Matt. 16:19) Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) and let them go free (Rom. 6:18) in the name of *Jesus Christ* (John 16:23), the Mediator of the new covenant (Heb. 12:24). In Him who is true, in His Son *Jesus Christ* (1 John 5:20), we demand that Satan (Math. 4:10) and his demonic hoard stop (Luke 10:17) their maneuvers and schemes (2 Cor. 2:11), their tricks and snares (2 Tim. 2:25), their designs (2 Cor. 2:11), their devices (2 Cor. 2:11) and their wiles (Eph. 6:11) against Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their people (Ps. 148:14), for Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) are the children of God (1 John 3:1). Our Children (Is. 61:9) and their family (Acts 13:26) are covered by the blood of *Jesus Christ* (1 Pet. 1:19), the precious Lamb slain for them (John 1:29), the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world (John 1:29). For the temple of God is holy, which temple Our children (ls. 61:9). are (1 Cor. 3:17). **Christ**, in us, takes authority and commands all demons be gone and do not defile this temple, which Our children (Is. 61:9) are, in any manner or by any means (Mark 7:23). In Christ (Rom. 9:1, 1 Cor. 1:30) we ask our Father (Math. 6:9), in the name of the son of His love (Col. 1:13), Jesus Christ (John 16:23), to fill this temple, which are Our children (Is. 61:9), with His Holy Spirit (Luke 11:13) and make them Holy ground (1 Cor. 3:17). Now hope does not disappoint, because the love of God has been poured out in their hearts by the Holy Spirit who was given to Our Children (Is. 61:9) (Rom. 5:5). May the fruits of the Spirit, which are love, joy, peace, patience, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control be manifested (Gal. 5:22) in their daily life (Luke 9:23). In the name of <u>Jesus Christ</u> (John 16:23), the great High Priest (Heb. 10:21), abiding in Him (John 15:4-5), and one with Him (John 17:22) we bind (Math 16:19) the spirits of doubt (Matt. 14:31), deception (Rom. 1:29), control (2 Tim. 2:26) and seduction (Rev. 2:20), manipulation and deceiving (Titus 3:5), intimidation (Math. 10:28, Heb. 13:6), domination (2 Cor. 1:24), bondage (Rom. 8:15), destruction (Rom. 3:16), idleness, laziness and gossip (1 Tim. 5:13), revelry, drunkenness or drug addictions, lewdness (Rom. 13:13), unrighteousness, sexual immorality, vile (Rom. 1:26) passion (Col. 3:5), wickedness, strife, evil-mindedness, violence, boasting, disobedience (Rom. 1:29-31), finger pointing, fault finding, critical, judgmental, religious spirits (Acts 26:5, Col. 2:23), anger, bitterness, wrath, clamor, resentment, malice, evil speaking (Eph. 4:31), filthy language (Col. 3:8) jealousy, envy (Gal. 5:21), possessiveness (Num. 5:14), perceived injury (Math. 18:21), indignation (Rom. 2:8), guilt (Heb. 10:22), condemnation (Rom. 5:16, 8:1), division (Rom. 16:17), lies (Acts

5:3, Eph. 4:24), self-righteousness (false humility) (Col. 2:23), fear (Rom. 8:15), mockery (Mark 10:34), abuse (Math. 20:10), meanness (Math. 5:39, Math. 5:11) unkindness (1 Cor. 13:4), discouragement (Math. 18:10, Rom 14:13), depression (1 Sam. 16:14, James 4:9, Rev. 18:11), suicide (Math. 27:5), insanity (Rom. 1:28), conceit, rudeness, self-seeking (1 Cor. 13:5), (James 3:14) Selfishness (2 Cor. 12:20, 2 Tim. 3:2), mammon (Luke 16:11), loving money (2 Tim. 3:2), idolatry (1 Cor. 10:14), evil desires (Col. 3:5) boasting, disobedience, blasphemy, un-thankfulness, slander, brutality, treachery, pleasure seeking (2 Tim. 3:3-4), foolishness (Rom. 1:22), futile thoughts (Rom. 1:21), dreamers (Jer. 27:29, Jude 1:8), pride (Rom. 1:30), covetous (James 4:2), greed (Luke 11:30), gluttony (Prov. 23:21), adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lewdness, idolatry, sorcery and divination, hatred, contentions, jealousy, outbursts of wrath, selfish ambitions, backbiting, whispering, conceit, tumult (2 Cor. 12:20) dissension's, heresies, murder, kidnapping, perjury, sodomy (1 Tim 1:10), drunkenness and addictions, revelries (Gal. 5:19-21) stealing (Eph. 4:28), corrupting (Eph. 4:29), foolish talking (Eph. 5:4), coarse jesting (Eph. 5:4), stubborn, prideful, know it all (1 cor. 3:20), lawlessness, insubordination, profanity (1 Tim. 1:9), flattery, licentiousness (2 Pet. 2:18) and lusts of the flesh (2 Peter 2:18), the lust of the eye and the pride of life (1 John 2:16) and all unnamed evil (Luke 7:21), wicked (Ps. 12:8) or unclean spirits (Luke 8:29). As God's fellow worker (1 Cor. 3:9), in *Christ* (John 15:4) we bind (Math 16:19) the arrogant, pompous (1 Cor. 13:4), busy body (1 Tim. 5:13), provoking, evil thinking (1 cor. 13:5), undiscerning, untrustworthy, unloving, unforgiving, unmerciful (Rom. 1:31), unholy (2 Tim. 3:3-4) critical (Luke 6:37), judgmental (Rom. 2:1), defiling (Rev. 21:27) headstrong, and haughty spirits (2 Tim. 3:3-4) as well. As a fellow worker for the Truth (3 John 1:8), in **Christ** (John 15:4) we bind all spirits that cause Our Children (Is. 61:9) to lack self-control (2 Tim. 3:3-4) or be haters of God, inventors of evil things (Rom. 1:29-31), or despisers of good (2 Tim. 3:3-4). Abiding in God and abiding in His love (1 John 4:16), in the mighty name (Jer. 32:18) of **Jesus** Christ (John 16:23), Christ (John 15:4), Him being in us and we being in Christ (John 15:4), we bind (Math 16:19) the religious spirit (self-imposed religion) (Col. 2:23), having a form of godliness but denying its power (2 Tim. 3:5), as well as the antichrist spirit (1 John 2:18) and all unnamed demonic spirits that causes an abomination or a lie (Rev. 21:27). All Your garments are scented with myrrh and aloes and cassia, out of the ivory palaces, by which they made You glad. (Ps. 45:2-8). The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our refuge. Selah (Ps. 46:7). Thanks be to God, who gives Our Children (Is. 61:9) the victory through our Lord Christ Jesus Christ (1 Cor. 15:57)! Yours, O Lord, is the greatness, the power and the glory, the victory and the majesty; for all that is in heaven and in earth is Yours's; Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and You are exalted as head over all. (1 Chr. 29:11)

(2 Cor. 1:20)! Amen and Amen!
